**Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse**

**RACE 1 : KIMBA COMMUNITY HOTEL / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

DELAWAY BROM (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly.

DELAWAY BROM (L. Hopwood) raced keenly and ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

At the entrance to the straight DELAWAY BROM (L. Hopwood) shifted wider on the track inconveniencing MISTAKEN VALUE (E. Boyd) and SNIP IN TIME (T. Pannell), which were taken wider.

DELAWAY BROM (L. Hopwood) laid in under pressure in the straight.

**RACE 2 : LASER ELECTRICAL RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

On jumping away MASTER PICKLES (T. Pannell) and MEMORY COVE (T. Baker) came together and brushed.

**RACE 3 : PT HUGHES TAVERN / DARKE PEAK / WUDINNA & COWELL COMMERCIAL HOTELS 0-59 HANDICAP - 1000 metres**

HOLD THE ACES (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride.

On jumping away ROCHIRL (P. Roff) and LOVERS ROCKS (M. Pegus) came together and brushed.

**RACE 4 : MARINA HOTEL PORT LINCOLN / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1250 metres**

RAVE IN VAIN proved difficult to proceed to the start. Mr. T. Dawson, the Trainer of RAVE IN VAIN, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to it proving difficult en route to the barriers.

BOLINDA VALE (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing LUNAR RED (A. Patterson).

In the vicinity of the 300 metres MUNGO MERLOT (P. Roff) had to be steadied and lost its position when FREE RANGE (S. Price) shifted in and away from JAWANNA (M. Pegus), which was shifting in and away from MR KARGER (S. Cahill).

JAWANNA (M. Pegus) laid in under pressure in the straight. JAWANNA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MUNGO MERLOT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 5 : TRAFFORD RESOURCES RATING 0-64 HANDICAP - 1750 metres**

SHE'SMISUNDERSTOOD (T. Pannell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, inconveniencing LOW CUT (T. O'Donnell), which lost its position.

**RACE 6 : IRONCLAD MINING FLYING - 1200 metres**

DIRE WARNING (D. Tourneur), TESTAGOLD (E. Boyd) and ZIADIE (L. Hopwood) were all slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres ZIADIE (L. Hopwood) rolled out under pressure resulting in DIRE WARNING (D. Tourneur) being taken out onto HIGHTOM (P. Roff), resulting in DIRE WARNING and HIGHTOM making heavy contact on a number of occasions.

CLUB HA HA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 7 : NRI / SABOIS + KIMBA CUP - 1950 metres**

OCSMEPOP (A. Herrmann) and MISS ABERDEEN (P. Roff) were slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1500 metres HASTEIN (NZ) (M. Pegus) dipped for no apparent reason.

In the vicinity of the 50 metres MIGHTY MOMENT (T. Pannell) brushed with MISS ABERDEEN (P. Roff) on a number of occasions.

HASTEIN (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Mr. D. Carrison, the Trainer of HASTEIN (NZ), was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

**RACE 8 : ELDERS INSURANCE CLEVE, KIMBA & PORT LINCOLN RATING 0-61 HANDICAP - 1350 metres**

MYKONOS SUNSET (K. Bishop) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, bumping DESTONY HAWK (L. Hopwood).

DESTONY HAWK (L. Hopwood) laid in under pressure in the straight.
