RACE 1: WEST END / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1800 metres

Ms. L. Conlon, the Trainer of HE'S A REAL BIGBOY, advised Stewards she would instruct Jockey T. Zanker, if possible, to take up a more forward position today, preferably in the first three, in an attempt to allow the gelding to finish the race off better.

Shortly after jumping NOW YOU'RE FLYING (E. Boyd) and OUR BELIEF (T. Pannell) came together and brushed.

In the vicinity of the 1400 metres the saddle on IMAGINARIUM (T. O'Donnell) shifted forward, placing that rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

In the middle stages DON'T THINK DO (D. Stra) raced three wide without cover.

GIMME SOME SAVINGS (J. Frew) laid out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

From in the vicinity of the 200 metres DON'T THINK DO (D. Stra) laid in under pressure.

OUR BELIEF lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 2: 5CS / MAGIC FM / SABOIS COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres

D. Stra, the rider of THE SECRET BUZZ, who was dislodged en route to the barriers, was examined by the on-course Ambulance personnel and ruled fit to fulfil her riding engagements.

THE SECRET BUZZ (D. Stra) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 900 metres THE SECRET BUZZ (D. Stra) raced keenly for a short distance when racing in restricted room inside SMARTY WELLS (T. O'Donnell).

In the early and middle stages ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD (T. Pannell) raced wide without cover.

RACE 2:5CS / MAGIC FM / SABOIS COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 200 metres DUKE OF THE CASTLE (D. Tootell), which was inclined to lay out, brushed with ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD (T. Pannell) on a number of occasions, turning that gelding's hindquarters.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres RANDI (E. Boyd) shifted in abruptly under pressure, tightening ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD (T. Pannell) onto DUKE OF THE CASTLE (D. Tootell). As a result ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD was obliged to steady. RANDI hung in severely for the remainder of the race despite the efforts of its rider. RANDI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. P. Cole, the Trainer of RANDI, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners and similar behaviour in future may result in stronger action being taken against the gelding.

RACE 3: UNIBET RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

On arrival at the barriers TONI'S CONNECTION required resaddling.

OUT DO ME (T. O'Donnell) was slow to begin and hung in throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres RETAIN BELIEF (E. Boyd) laid out at the same time as KING RODNEY (J. Frew) laid in, resulting in KANGAROO JACK (T. Pannell) becoming tightened between these runners and being obliged to check, losing its position.

- T. O'Donnell, the rider of OUT DO ME, reported the mare was inclined to hang in throughout the event. OUT DO ME was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
- D. Stra, the rider of ALICE LONGING, reported the mare was obliged to lay in throughout the event.

KING RODNEY, which got its near hind leg caught on a gate on return to Scale, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

T. Pannell, the rider of KANGAROO JACK, explained the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages, however, after being tightened in the vicinity of the 200 metres, KANGAROO JACK came off the bridle and lost momentum and did not finish the race off as normal.

RACE 4 : GOOD WINE GOOD FRIENDS GRAND TIMES AT GREG COOLEY WINES / SABOIS F&M MAIDEN - 1100 metres

On jumping away WICKED KISS (T. O'Donnell) shifted out at the same time as TWILIGHT POINT (J. Frew) shifted in onto LA CARAMBA (M. Henderson), which was taken in onto CALL ME PENNY (T. Zanker), which was tightened and lost its position.

TWILIGHT POINT (J. Frew) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres MISS PARNASSUS (E. Boyd) made the turn awkwardly and shifted out wider on the track.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres ARIEL (D. Tootell) laid in under pressure.

ARIEL, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : JIM BARRY WINES RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1700 metres

MISS ARTICULATE (D. Stra) jumped away awkwardly.

In the vicinity of the 1200 metres THE CATCHER (J. Frew) threw its head up when being restrained.

MISS ARTICULATE (D. Stra) raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

Correct Weight for this race was delayed in accordance with ARR.155 to allow the Judges to confirm their numbers with the use of the official video image as the photo finish failed to operate.

J. Frew, the rider of THE CATCHER, pleaded guilty to a charge under ARR.137(c) in that he made a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post and was fined \$100.

RACE 6: ENERGY AUSTRALIA RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

ELEGIDO (T. Zanker) and BRACKEN BLUE (M. Henderson) were slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres BRING THEM ON (D. Stra) and KHALAH ROSE (E. Boyd) brushed.

KHALAH ROSE (E. Boyd) laid in under pressure in the straight.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to view the official footage of the start.

RACE 7: KIRRIHILL WINES RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

SPINNING NUTS was withdrawn by Stewards at 8.45 am when there was no rider available.

BON CHERIE was withdrawn by Stewards at 10.15 am when there was no rider available.

MIME (D. Stra) was slow to begin.

WAIKIKI GIRL (M. Henderson) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Over the final 100 metres MIME (D. Stra) laid in under pressure resulting in D. Stra being obliged to stop riding and straighten the gelding on two occasions.
