Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 3 April 2013

RACE 1 : JACOBS CREEK / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2100 metres

REGAL JASMINE (NZ) (T. Zanker) was slow to begin.

Shortly after the start NEPHTHYS (J. Bowditch) and SHARPAY MAGIC (A. Herrmann) came together and bumped.

THIDWICK THE MOOSE (B. Claridge) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

SEDUCTION COUNSEL (V. Colgan) raced keenly in the early stages.

NEPHTHYS (J. Bowditch) laid in under pressure in the straight. NEPHTHYS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

T. Zanker, the rider of REGAL JASMINE (NZ), reported she was concerned with the mare's action on pulling up. REGAL JASMINE (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in both hind legs. Mr. C. Graves, the Trainer of REGAL JASMINE (NZ), was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

SEDUCTION COUNSEL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to the off hind cannon. First Aid was administered.

RACE 2 : THE TERRACE / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

WHITE ROE (C. Lindop) shifted in on jumping away and brushed REAL FINNISS (A. Herrmann).

SILVER SEBRING (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto MY MATE ROCKY (J. Potter), which was taken in, contacting ALERT BERT (C. Lever), which was hampered and knuckled. Shortly after MY MATE ROCKY was taken back out slightly by ALERT BERT and had to be steadied off the heels of SILVER SEBRING.

<u>RACE 2 : THE TERRACE / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE</u> - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

Shortly after the start TIKITOUR (V. Colgan) shifted in onto VIVI VELOCE (P. Gatt), which had to be momentarily steadied when taken in onto SMACKWATER JACK (S. Price). V. Colgan was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

ALERT BERT (C. Lever) raced greenly in the early stages and inside the 1000 metres, shifted in and away from WALKA COUNTRY MILE (J. Matthews) onto VIVI VELOCE (P. Gatt), which was forced to take hold and lost its position. Shortly after ALERT BERT shifted out and had to be steadied off the heels of WALKA COUNTRY MILE.

Approaching the 800 metres BELLWETHER (S. Cahill) shifted in onto TIKITOUR (V. Colgan), which was forced to steady momentarily. In being steadied TIKITOUR got its head up and over-reacted, losing ground. S. Cahill was advised of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

BELLWETHER (S. Cahill) rolled out rounding the home turn and shortly after shifted back in slightly onto TIKITOUR (V. Colgan), which had commenced to improve to that gelding's inside, resulting in TIKITOUR having to alter course to the outside of BELLWETHER. Shortly after BELLWETHER shifted out slightly onto TIKITOUR, which was taken out contacting REAL FINNISS (A. Herrmann), which became unbalanced when taken wider and had to be steadied off the heels of WHITE ROE (C. Lindop).

Approaching the 100 metres TIKITOUR (V. Colgan) shifted out and away from BELLWETHER (S. Cahill), which rolled out slightly, onto WHITE ROE (C. Lindop), which became momentarily unbalanced when taken wider.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow C. Lindop, the rider of the second placegetter WHITE ROE, to view the official footage in the straight.

J. Bowditch, the rider of POUND THE ALARM, reported the gelding laid out from the vicinity of the 800 metres. POUND THE ALARM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

BELLWETHER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Mr. M. Minervini, the Trainer of BELLWETHER, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 3 : PD EXCAVATIONS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

LA BELLA BAROSSA (T. Baker) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres JANICE MAY (J. Potter) was held up for a short distance when racing behind EXALTED OMEGA (L. Hopwood) and inside LA BELLA BAROSSA (T. Baker).

At the entrance to the straight JETMAKER (C. Lindop) was momentarily held up when racing behind LUCKY STRATEGY (J. Holder) and inside PANTHER'S RUN (S. Cahill).

In the vicinity of the 300 metres HIDDEN'S SISTER (S. Price) laid in onto TOAST THE HOST (T. O'Donnell), which had rolled out slightly.

RACE 4 : KINGSFORD HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 metres

Mr. L. Macdonald, the Co-Trainer of WEEKEND AT BERNIES, advised Stewards he would instruct jockey J. Holder to attempt to settle more forward in today's event than the gelding had at its most recent starts as WEEKEND AT BERNIES had not been finishing its races off.

LURCH (M. Neilson) and DOWN THE MIDDLE (J. Toeroek) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres DOWN THE MIDDLE (J. Toeroek) improved into restricted room to the inside of FROST DODGER (V. Colgan) and had to be momentarily steadied.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres WEEKEND AT BERNIES (J. Holder), which had commenced to give ground and was laying out, shifted out slightly onto FROST DODGER (V. Colgan) as that gelding was taken in slightly by FAMOUS FIGHTER (S. Cahill), resulting in WEEKEND AT BERNIES having to be steadied and losing its position.

WEEKEND AT BERNIES, which commenced to weaken prior to the 400 metres, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. L. Macdonald, the Co-Trainer of WEEKEND AT BERNIES, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its poor performance.

RACE 5 : LYNAS AUTO GROUP / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

GRACIOUS TARA (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto INSTANT CONVERT (T. O'Donnell), which was forced to steady when tightened onto BARRIER BOYS (T. Baker).

Inside the 1000 metres LEATHER TUSCADERO (P. Gatt) shifted in onto MAKE THE TIME (J. Maund), which was forced to steady momentarily.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres GRACIOUS TARA (C. Lindop) shifted in at the same time as SEARCY (J. Potter) shifted out, resulting in HERE'S ARCHIE (C. Lever), which was racing between these two runners, having to take hold. In taking hold HERE'S ARCHIE got its head up and shifted out abruptly and was forced to steady to avoid the heels of GRACIOUS TARA.

Shortly after entering the straight HERE'S ARCHIE (C. Lever) was disappointed when attempting a tight run between the heels of LOCK IT UP (M. Neilson) and MAKE THE TIME (J. Maund) and became awkwardly placed on the heels of MAKE THE TIME for several strides. As a result HERE'S ARCHIE was unable to obtain clear ground until the vicinity of the 100 metres when it was able to improve to the outside of runners.

INSTANT CONVERT (T. O'Donnell) shifted in under pressure over the final 100 metres and in the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted in onto LOCK IT UP (M. Neilson), which had to be steadied when taken in onto the heels of MAKE THE TIME (J. Maund). T. O'Donnell was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground in future.

KARIZMA MISS, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. W. Smart, the Trainer of KARIZMA MISS, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RACE 6 : COOPERS PALE ALE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2100 metres

RUNALUK (J. Bowditch) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto BLEVIC LAD (J. Toeroek), which was tightened onto MALDIVES (J. Frew), which was taken in and forced to steady off the heels of AUTO PILOT (A. Patterson).

RACE 6 : COOPERS PALE ALE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2100 metres (Cont'd)

FIVE IRON (P. Gatt) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Approaching the 600 metres RUNALUK (J. Bowditch) shifted out to improve onto FIVE IRON (P. Gatt), which was inconvenienced when taken out onto MAJOR DE (M. Neilson), which was hampered when tightened onto OUTRAGIOUS MAN (K. Bishop), which held its line. J. Bowditch was advised of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

AUTO PILOT (A. Patterson) laid in under pressure in the straight.

FIVE IRON, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. R. Balfour, the Co-Trainer of FIVE IRON, advised the gelding would now be spelled.

MAJOR DE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : COOPERS CLEAR CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1500 metres

TROBEN (E. Boyd) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres CARRONADE (J. Bowditch) shifted in onto NOTONMATCHDAY (L. Stojakovic), which was forced to race in restricted room to the inside of that gelding until near the 800 metres.

At the entrance to the straight JUST PURE FUN (J. Potter) attempted to improve into a run between the heels of CARRONADE (J. Bowditch), which shifted out under riding, at the same time as RIVER OF GLORY (NZ) (A. Herrmann) attempted the same run to the inside of the heels of NOTONMATCHDAY (L. Stojakovic), resulting in these two runners brushing. Shortly after CATON (K. Bishop) was taken in onto RIVER OF GLORY (NZ) by IDATRICE (S. Cahill), which shifted in. As a result CATON, RIVER OF GLORY (NZ) and JUST PURE FUN came together and brushed and in consequence JUST PURE FUN had to be steadied off the heels of CARRONADE, which continued to shift out. J. Bowditch was reprimanded and advised in future he would be required to stop riding and straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground.

SUPER SILKS (NZ) (J. Matthews) laid in under pressure in the straight.

J. Matthews, the rider of SUPER SILKS (NZ), pleaded guilty to a charge under ARR.137(c) in that he made a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post and was fined \$200.

RACE 8 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

BRIMARVI DUE FACE (J. Kah) stood flat-footed and missed the start several lengths. Mr. P. Seater, the Trainer of BRIMARVI DUE FACE, was advised a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners.

Shortly after the start CARBON HUNTER (J. Holder) shifted out and inconvenienced MR CRANE (S. Cahill).

At the entrance to the straight MR CRANE (S. Cahill) became held up until the vicinity of the 200 metres when racing behind JUST RANGER (J. Toeroek) and inside DAREBIN (M. Neilson).

After entering the straight BRIMARVI DUE FACE (J. Kah) had difficulty obtaining clear ground until the vicinity of the 100 metres.

RACE 8 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

BISCAYNE BLUE (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn and performed below expectations. BISCAYNE BLUE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported low grade shin soreness on the off foreleg. Mr. P. Moody, the Trainer of BISCAYNE BLUE, advised the filly would now be spelled.

Inside the 200 metres DAREBIN (M. Neilson) and MR CRANE (S. Cahill) came together and brushed.
