Report on Race Meeting held at Murray Bridge Racecourse

RACE 1 : MARSHALL MULTISPREAD / SABOIS 2YO MAIDEN PLATE - 1006 metres

MAGNUM PE I (S. Price) jumped away awkwardly.

FATE (M. Neilson) raced greenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

REDEEM BOUNTY (J. Toeroek) was slow into stride.

REDEEM BOUNTY, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : HOTELIERS' RACE DAY WEDNESDAY 22 MAY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1006 metres

On arrival at the barriers SMART JESTER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to start.

FOREST CAT (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted YOU ROCK (M. Neilson).

In the vicinity of the 800 metres EXALTED WILLIAM (P. Gatt) shifted in slightly onto LE SAMER (D. Tourneur), which shifted in and away, inconveniencing PANTHER'S RUN (A. Herrmann), which was tightened onto ZARANKA (S. Cahill).

EXALTED WILLIAM (P. Gatt) laid out rounding the home turn inconveniencing LE SAMER (D. Tourneur), which was taken wider on the track.

Inside the 200 metres FOREST CAT (C. Lindop) was forced to race in restricted room for a short distance when PANTHER'S RUN (A. Herrmann) shifted in slightly.

LE SAMER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had suffered a bi-lateral bleeding attack during the race. Ms. M. Smith, the Trainer of LE SAMER, was advised that as this was the gelding's second bleeding attack, it was now banned from racing for life in accordance with ARR.53A.

RACE 3 : BETFAIR / SABOIS FILLIES AND MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1206 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to LEMERIO proving difficult to load. Mr. B. Bogarts, the Trainer of LEMERIO, was advised the filly was suspended from racing until it can gain approval to race in an Official Barrier Trial or an Approval Jump Out.

BETTER THAN BRONZE (NZ) (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly.

CHEERS RIHANNA (B. Hoppo) was slow to begin and shortly after was hampered by EXIT NOW (L. Hopwood), which shifted out abruptly on jumping away.

On jumping away KAAPRICOSA (J. Bowditch) shifted out onto LADY LUSH (D. Tourneur), which was taken out, contacting the hindquarters of YALE (V. Colgan), which was inconvenienced.

LEMERIO (A. Herrmann) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event and had to be restrained off the heels of GENEROUS BELLE (P. Gatt).

LEMERIO (A. Herrmann) dipped on two occasions over the final 100 metres.

V. Colgan, the rider of YALE, which performed below expectations, explained the filly had raced flat throughout the event and when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres had failed to respond to his riding and he was disappointed with how it had finished off the event. YALE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

B. Hoppo, the rider of CHEERS RIHANNA, which performed below expectations, explained his intention had been to settle in a forward position, however, after receiving pressure at the start he was unable to obtain that position. He added the filly had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event and when placed under pressure in the straight, in his opinion, had finished the event off well. CHEERS RIHANNA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a small laceration to the off fore foot.

RACE 4 : CARLTON DRAUGHT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1406 metres

LET HIM BE (L. Hopwood) was slow to begin.

In the early stages MAKE THE TIME (V. Colgan), NATIVE RHYTHM (C. Lever) and NAME THE DAY (M. Neilson) raced in restricted room and came together and brushed on a number of occasions.

In the vicinity of the 250 metres NAME THE DAY (M. Neilson) shifted out to improve and bumped OUR SECOND CHANCE (J. Potter).

V. Colgan, the rider of MAKE THE TIME, explained the filly had commenced to give ground from the vicinity of the 600 metres and had dipped on a number of occasions. He added he had become concerned with the filly's action and for that reason did not ride MAKE THE TIME in his normal manner in the straight. MAKE THE TIME was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported speedy cuts to the near hind pastern.

RACE 5 : SAMBEC SHEDS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1206 metres

HAPPY SYMBOL (J. Bowditch) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto LASTING IMAGE (C. Lever), which was taken in, tightening CAPTAIN SHARP (NZ) (P. Gatt) onto SET ON STONE (J. Potter).

RACE 5 : SAMBEC SHEDS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1206 metres (Cont'd)

HAPPY SYMBOL (J. Bowditch) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

Inside the 1000 metres SHEEZ ON TOP (W. Kerford) had to momentarily steady when tightened between MEADOWS MIST (L. Hopwood), which shifted in slightly at the same time as USTINOV'S FURY (K. Bishop) shifted out.

SHEEZ ON TOP, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CAPTAIN SHARP (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a laceration to the off hind pastern.

RACE 6 : ALBANESI CONCRETING SERVICES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP – 1206 metres

OUR RUBY (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, contacting MORCHOWIE MISS (D. Tourneur), which lost its position when tightened onto WILDER WILDER (J. Bowditch).

DELPHERE (J. Toeroek) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres until near the 400 metres PRESTIGE GLEN (C. Lever) became held up when it improved and had to be restrained off the heels of CALYPSIAN (S. Price).

At the entrance to the straight CALYPSIAN (S. Price) shifted out to improve and contacted ROAD TO FINNISS (T. Baker).

In the vicinity of the 300 metres CALYPSIAN (S. Price) had to be steadied when MYLADY CAROL (J. Holder) shifted out to improve.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres DELPHERE (J. Toeroek) shifted in slightly onto LADY AKATAK (C. Lindop), which shifted in and away and had to be steadied off the heels of WILDER WILDER (J. Bowditch), which shifted out slightly.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres WILDER WILDER (J. Bowditch) had to steady momentarily when MORCHOWIE MISS (D. Tourneur) shifted out to improve.

RACE 7 : MARSHALL PANNELL MEMORIAL RATING 0-71 HANDICAP - 1406 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately one minute to avoid a clash with an interstate race.

AL JUMAN (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly.

JEUNEALISTIC (P. Gatt) was slow to begin.

MOON DEVIL (T. Pannell) shifted out on jumping away and brushed LOVE A GIGGLE (A. Herrmann).

Shortly after the start AL JUMAN (J. Holder) shifted out and away from RA IKANE (S. Price) onto MOON BRICKS (A. Patterson), which was taken out, making heavy contact with SWIFT SHAMROCK (J. Bowditch). These runners continued to race tight for some distance, resulting in MOON BRICKS and AL JUMAN making contact on a number of occasions.

RACE 7 : MARSHALL PANNELL MEMORIAL RATING 0-71 HANDICAP - 1406 metres
(Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres RICH PRIDE (J. Matthews), which laid in throughout the event, shifted in onto LOVE A GIGGLE (A. Herrmann), which had to be steadied.

Inside the 1000 metres NADAKA (C. Lindop) shifted in onto SPARTAN EAGLE (C. Lever), which had to be momentarily steadied.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres HENNY (M. Neilson) shifted out to improve, to the outside of AL JUMAN (J. Holder), onto NADAKA (C. Lindop), which had to be steadied when tightened onto MOON DEVIL (T. Pannell). M. Neilson was severely reprimanded and advised to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground in future.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres SPARTAN EAGLE (C. Lever) was inconvenienced when it attempted to shift out to improve at the same time as RICH PRIDE (J. Matthews), which continued to lay in, shifted in, resulting in SPARTAN EAGLE becoming held up and shortly after having to be restrained when it improved onto the heels of MOON DEVIL (T. Pannell), which had commenced to weaken.

T. Pannell, the rider of MOON DEVIL, explained the gelding travelled well in the early stages of the event, however, from the vicinity of the 800 metres he had become concerned that it was not handling the going. He added after placing MOON DEVIL under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, it failed to respond to his riding and he was disappointed with how it finished off the event. MOON DEVIL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Kah, the rider of SUPREME RULER, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, after being placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres failed to respond to her riding and she was disappointed with how it had finished off the event. SUPREME RULER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a slower than expected recovery. Mr. J. MacMillan, the Trainer of SUPREME RULER, was advised the results of an endoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness to race would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

RICH PRIDE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : CUTTING EDGE ENGINEERING RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1606 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately one minute owing to CARBON HUNTER proving difficult to load. Mr. S. Burford, the Trainer of CARBON HUNTER, was advised the gelding would be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

FOXTROT NOVEY (C. Lindop) was slow to begin.

Shortly after the start SIR READY (J. Holder) shifted in and contacted MOTZART (D. Tootell), which was inconvenienced.

HEURIGER (K. Bishop) raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres ELOISE THAT'S ME (V. Colgan) had to steady and alter course to the outside of MONTEFALCO (J. Bowditch), which had commenced to give ground.

At the entrance to the straight FOXTROT NOVEY (C. Lindop) shifted out onto ELSEWHERE (J. Kah), which was inconvenienced when tightened onto SIR READY (J. Holder).
