THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Balaklava Racecourse by the Balaklava Racing Club on Wednesday, 29 May 2013

Stewards: A. Hayles (A/Chairman), P. Matthews (HT), C. Deakin (M) & S. Callanan (F)

(Stewards), A. Quinton (Deputy Steward) & Dr. P. Horridge (Veterinary

Surgeon).

TRACK: Good 3 WEATHER: Overcast

Rail: Out 5 metres 850m to 400m.

RACE 1 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1058 metres

IL DIECI (C. Lever) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing LA CONCIERGE (A. Herrmann), which as a result was slow into stride.

TYCOON CELEBRITY (J. Holder), GOODFUN GIRL (C. Lindop) and IL DIECI (C. Lever) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

TYCOON CELEBRITY (J. Holder) laid in under pressure in the straight.

POLKAMP, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 2 : SAGLE CONSTRUCTIONS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1215 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to TO TURN AROUND becoming fractious in the barriers after being loaded. TO TURN AROUND was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race.

FEEL THE ENERGY, which also proved fractious in the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had a laceration to the near fore pastern and ruled the gelding unfit to race. Acting on that advice, Stewards withdrew FEEL THE ENERGY at 12.24 pm.

ZALLOVA (J. Bowditch) jumped away very awkwardly.

KING PARROT (A. Herrmann) and TO TURN AROUND (S. Price) were slow to begin.

TO TURN AROUND was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be suffering atrial fibrillation. Mrs. S. Hayes, the Trainer of TO TURN AROUND, was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 3: BIRNIE SANDERS HOTEL BROKERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1058 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately three minutes when HOSTABLE refused to load. HOSTABLE was withdrawn by Stewards at 1.01 pm. Mr. G. Richards, the Trainer of HOSTABLE, was advised the gelding would be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 3 : BIRNIE SANDERS HOTEL BROKERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1058 metres (Cont'd)

RIPPLE EFFECT, which struck its hip whilst being loaded into the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race.

EXALTED ANGEL (S. Price) and GINDRINKA (K. Bishop) jumped away awkwardly.

CLAREMONT KID (J. Maund) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.

RIPPLE EFFECT lost its near hind plate during the event.

NUN'S ESPRIT lost its off fore plate during the event.

CLAREMONT KID and RIPPLE EFFECT were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

YOU ROCK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the colt to be shin sore.

RACE 4 : JACOBS CREEK RESERVE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1415 metres

EMILY BELLE (P. Gatt) knuckled on jumping away.

TERRAPINNA (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out at the same time as STONEHAVEN (T. Pannell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, inconveniencing SWING ALONG (K. Bishop) and PETIT SOEUR (C. Lindop).

In the vicinity of the 900 metres SMOKY DUBAI (S. Price), when racing ungenerously, shifted out and momentarily inconvenienced MEADOWS CHIP (L. Hopwood).

In the vicinity of the 400 BETTER THAN BRONZE (NZ) (J. Bowditch) shifted out to improve around the heels of EMILY BELLE (P. Gatt) and bumped THE SECRET BUZZ (J. Frew).

SWING ALONG lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 5: WOODSTOCK BOURBON RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1615 metres

ASSO BELLO (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing AFRICAN MAMA (E. Boyd).

ASSO BELLO (T. O'Donnell) was inclined to lay out throughout the event. ASSO BELLO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

UMALUKA lost its near hind plate during the event.

RACE 6: THE FONZ SPINIELLO COOPERS MEMORIAL CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1215 metres

PRESTIGE GLEN (C. Lever) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing BUSH GEM (S. Westover).

In the vicinity of the 700 metres MOUNT NANCY (A. Herrmann), which was awkwardly placed on the heels of SATURDAY'S CHILD (C. Lindop), shifted in, inconveniencing SET ON STONE (J. Potter). Shortly after MORCHOWIE MISS (D. Tourneur), which was racing on the heels of SET ON STONE, was obliged to steady for a short distance.

RACE 6: THE FONZ SPINIELLO COOPERS MEMORIAL CLASS 1 HANDICAP – 1215 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 300 metres until approaching the 200 metres PRESTIGE GLEN (C. Lever) was held up for clear running when racing tight between SATURDAY'S CHILD (C. Lindop) and BUSH GEM (S. Westover), which both shifted ground.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow M. Neilson, the rider of the second placegetter NOBLE SUCCESS, and that gelding's Trainer Mr. D. Jolly, to view the official photo for first.

BUSH GEM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: AUSSIE CIDER / SABOIS + RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2215 metres

Approaching the winning post GIMME SOME SAVINGS (D. Tourneur) laid in under pressure brushing WEEKEND HUSSY (S. Price).

DOWN THE MIDDLE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: MY BUTCHER-MEAT WITH CARE / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1415 metres

STELLA GRACE (J. Bowditch) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres GLENARIFF (J. Toeroek) shifted out marginally taking POTLUCK (M. Neilson) wider and as a result FIDESDI (J. Matthews), was contacted and became unbalanced for a short distance.

BICKER lost both hind plates during the event.
