THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 5 June 2013

RACE 1: RODNEY RUDE LIVE AT GAWLER MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

Near the 800 metres HOLLYWOOD GOTHIC (T Baker) shifted in and slackened the pace marginally resulting in LEMERIO (A Herrmann) becoming awkward between the heels of HOLLYWOOD GOTHIC and CALIFORNIA KING (J Bowditch) resulting in LEMERIO having to be restrained and being inconvenienced. T Baker, the rider of HOLLYWOOD GOTHIC was shown the video of the incident and advised of his obligations when slowing the pace in future. HOLLYWOOD GOTHIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have low grade tying up.

P Gatt, the rider of FINLEY PIG, explained the gelding commenced to labour approaching the 600 metres and failed to respond to his riding and as he was of the view something may be amiss with the gelding, he elected to ease FINLEY PIG out of the event shortly after the entrance to the straight. FINLEY PIG was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had suffered a bi-lateral bleeding attack during the event. D Jolly, the Trainer of FINLEY PIG, was advised the gelding was suspended from racing for a period of three (3) months in accordance with ARR. 53A.

RACE 2: JACOB'S CREEK / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MADEN PLATE - 1200 metres

LA CONCIERGE (A Herrmann) was slow to begin.

BOOTH (V A Colgan) got its head up shortly after the start and raced very ungenerously for some distance in the early stages of the event and thereafter raced greenly for the remainder of the event, and shifted ground both ways at various stages in the straight.

RACE 3 : COOPERS / SABOIS MADEN PLATE – 1700 metres

On arrival on course, BARRIER BOYS (T. Baker) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon by order of Stewards. The Club's Veterinary Surgeon declared the horse fit to race.

TREASURE SON (C. Lindop) commenced to over-race in the middle stages of the event and raced ungenerously for some distance.

RACE 3: COOPERS / SABOIS MADEN PLATE - 1700 metres (Cont'd)

C. Lindop, the rider of TREASURE SON, pleaded guilty to a charge under ARR. 137A(5)(a) (ii) for using the whip on more than five (5) occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

BARRIER BOYS was again examined post-race and the Club's Veterinary Surgeon reported no visible abnormalities.

Stewards advised Mr. C. Curtis, the Trainer of BARRIER BOYS, that in view of the gelding's action in respect to its near foreleg, the gelding is now suspended from racing and may not be accepted for a future trial or race until Stewards advise to the contrary. Mr. Curtis was advised that Stewards would view all race starts in which BARRIER BOYS participated and consider whether the action of its near foreleg posed a risk to either itself or other horses in the event.

RACE 4 : COOPERS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

FEEL THE ENERGY, which was fractious in its tie up stall, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon, who reported the gelding to have a minor laceration to its mouth, and declared FEEL THE ENERGY fit to race.

HEZA HUSSLER (P Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in into ZIPNOTIZED (J. Toeroek) making contact with that filly which was tightened onto ZANDERCAN (K. Bishop) as that horse shifted out on jumping away. As a consequence, ZANDERCAN was inconvenienced.

DECAFFINATO (J. Kah) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and inconvenienced FEEL THE ENERGY (T. Pannell).

DUKE OF THE CASTLE (J. Potter) jumped way awkwardly.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres MAGIC NIELLO (A Patterson) became awkwardly placed between the heels of LI'L NINA (J. Holder) and ZIPNOTIZED (J. Toeroek), got its head up and raced ungenerously when being restrained.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres ZIPNOTIZED (J Toeroek) which commenced to hang out, rolled out onto THREE LITTLE PIGS (J Frew), which was taken out slightly onto GENIALITY (L. Stojakovic), which was tightened onto LORD CAPUCHIUS (J Maund) as that gelding commenced to give ground resulting in GENIALITY clipping the heels of LORD CAPUCHIUS, losing its position. As a consequence, FEEL THE ENERGY (T Pannell) which was following, was hampered.

ZANDERCAN (K. Bishop) raced very greenly in the straight and shifted ground abruptly both ways at various stages. ZANDERCAN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GENIALITY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : THE WOLF BLASS RASCAL CLUB / SABOIS 3YO RATING 0-68 HCP - 1500 metres

D. Tourneur, the rider of ECLAIR SAMBA, explained the gelding was off the bridle at an early stage in the event, performed disappointingly, and failed to respond in the manner he expected until reaching the concluding stages of the event where the horse appeared to let down. ECLAIR SAMBA, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : THE WOLF BLASS RASCAL CLUB / SABOIS 3YO RATING 0-68 HCP - 1500 metres (Contd)

MEADOWS MIST (J. Kah) over-raced for a short distance in the vicinity of the 1100 metres.

RACE 6 : FRED VELLA TYRE AND CRASH RATING 0-62 HCP - 2100 metres

GOLDEN SCHNAPS (J. Maund) raced wide without cover in the middle stages of the event.

E. Boyd, the rider of WEEKEND DAZZLER, explained her instructions were to take up a position off the pace, but in view of the fact there was an apparent lack of pace in this event, if she found herself in a forward position, to take up the lead if no other horse wanted to lead. She added, she ended up being a reluctant leader in the event and despite slowing the pace in the vicinity of the 1700 metres, was unable to force any other runner to take up the lead.

RACE 7: THE TERRACE RATING 0-62 HCP (Division 1) - 1100 metres

STAKE YOUR CLAIM, which had not raced since August 2011, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival on course and declared fit to start.

STAKE YOUR CLAIM, which pulled its near hind plate in the parade ring, prior to entering the mounting yard, was attended to by the Course Farrier and the Club's Veterinary Surgeon. STAKE YOUR CLAIM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the near hind leg. Acting on that advice STAKE YOUR CLAIM was withdrawn by order of Stewards at 2.43 pm.

Inside the 200 metres CASH JOB (D. Stra) laid in for a number of strides, unbalancing its rider when being corrected.

RACE 8 : SANDERS FODDER/MITAVITE/GAWLER TRAINER OF THE YEAR RATING 0-62 HCP (Division 2) - 1100 metres

The start of the race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to KOODA DAWN becoming fractious after being loaded into its barrier stall and having to be removed and examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon, who passed it fit to race.

NOIR RASOIR (J. Toeroek) and DELPHERE (J. Holder) contacted at the start when both horses began awkwardly and shortly thereafter, NOIR RASOIR shifted out and away from DEFAMATORY (A. Patterson) which shifted out, resulting in NOIR RASOIR contacting DELPHERE which was tightened onto the hindquarters of LAST PARDEE (P. Gatt) which was inconvenienced.

Over the concluding stages, LAST PARDEE (P. Gatt) shifted in and contacted NOIR RASOIR (J. Toeroek) which was inclined to lay out.

NOIR RASOIR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: WOLF BLASS WINES CLASS 2 HCP - 1500 metres

IRON FOCUS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race.

AMBUSH AL (S. Price) required resaddling on arrival at the barriers.

MIME (C. Lever) lost its near hind plate during the event.

RACE 9: WOLF BLASS WINES CLASS 2 HCP - 1500 metres (Cont'd)

- Mr T. Day, the Trainer of SOCIAL FINALE was questioned in respect to the apparent improved performance of the gelding. He advised that during its previous preparation, the gelding was found to have a back problem which was attended to by a chiropractor. In addition, he had altered the training regime of the gelding in recent months. He also added that the underfoot conditions at Murray Bridge on Wednesday, 22 May 2013 did not appear to suit SOCIAL FINALE. Stewards also confirmed aspects of Mr. Day's report with K. Bishop, who rode the gelding at Murray Bridge and J. Maund who rode SOCIALE FINALE today. Mr. Day's attention was drawn to the provisions of ARR.140(a).
- J. Potter, the rider of LADY LUSH pleaded guilty to a charge under ARR.137(4)(b) for using his whip over the concluding stages in a manner that raised his arm above shoulder height and was fined \$400.00.
- J. Frew, the rider of IRON FOCUS, reported the gelding performed disappointingly and failed to respond in the manner he expected. IRON FOCUS was examined post-race by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormality
