Report on Race Meeting held at Quorn Racecourse
by the Quorn Jockey Club on Saturday, 15 June 2013

**RACE 1 : CRITERION HOTEL/ALINTA ENERGY/QUALITY LIVESTOCK/
SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres**

ZIGZAG STREET and CRYING TIME were withdrawn by Stewards at 8.00 am when there were no riders available.

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to a number of horses proving difficult to load.

On jumping away PAGANINI'S BROTHER (M. Henderson) and BUXOM (J. Frew) came together and brushed.

W. Kerford, the rider of OUR SECOND CHANCE, explained he was comfortable with his position throughout the event, however, after placing the gelding under pressure in the vicinity of the 300 metres, it did not finish the event off as he had expected. OUR SECOND CHANCE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 2 : MYLES FINLAY MEMORIAL/AUSTRAL INN HOTEL/
TRANSCONTINENTAL HOTEL HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

SIDE TO SIDE (D. Tootell) jumped away awkwardly.

SHIMANO MISS (NZ) (T. O'Donnell) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**RACE 3 : CARLING FUEL/LKM HAIR DESIGNERS/SPENCER GULF SECURITY/ GULF
GETAWAYS/CROMBIES BULK HAULAGE 0-59 HANDICAP – 1400 metres**

PHOENIX MISS and DELSHAR were withdrawn by Stewards at 8.00 am when there were no riders available.

The start of this race was delayed approximately one minute owing to DOOLAM RIVER breaking through the front of its barrier stall. DOOLAM RIVER was quickly restrained by its rider, K. Shepherdson, and returned to the start. DOOLAM RIVER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race.

ROAD TO DANTREE (D. Stra) raced wide without cover in the middle stages of the event.

**RACE 3 : CARLING FUEL/LKM HAIR DESIGNERS/SPENCER GULF SECURITY/ GULF
GETAWAYS/CROMBIES BULK HAULAGE 0-59 HANDICAP – 1400 metres
(Cont'd)**

R. Bell, the rider of SO MANY PENNIES, explained he had intended to go forward in the race but as the mare did not have enough speed he elected to settle back in the field. He added that the mare raced greenly and in his opinion may have resented the racing surface and from the 200 metres he did not persist with his riding of the mare. SO MANY PENNIES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Frew, the rider of TONI'S CONNECTION, reported in his opinion the gelding had not handled the turns on the tight track and had slipped behind in the vicinity of the 700 metres. TONI'S CONNECTION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a small scalp mark to the inside of the near hind leg.

RACE 4 : EMANUELE BROS QUORN CUP - 1900 metres

PACINO (W. Kerford), OUT DO ME (D. Stra) and ELEGIDO (D. Tootell) were slow to begin.

ELEGIDO (D. Tootell) raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres KINGNADIM (NZ) (T. O'Donnell) and PELEKUNU VALLEY (NZ) (L. Hopwood) came together and brushed.

RACE 5 : QUORN HOTEL/SA BREWING CO RATING 0-59 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

RAMSGATE (D. Tootell) and RETAIN BELIEF (P. Roff) were slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres LOVE A SEQUALO (M. Henderson) rolled out, tightening MONSTARHIT (T. O'Donnell) onto MISS CUTHBERT (L. Hopwood). As a result, MONSTARHIT was obliged to steady and lost its position.

**RACE 2 : MYLES FINLAY MEMORIAL/AUSTRAL INN HOTEL/
TRANSCONTINENTAL HOTEL HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

Ms. K. McKerlie, the Trainer of SHIMANO MISS (NZ), reported on Monday, 17 June 2013 the mare had bled from both nostrils on return to her stable following this race and will now be retired from racing. Ms. McKerlie was advised SHIMANO MISS (NZ) was now suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with ARR.53A.
