STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Thursday, 11 July 2013

TRACK: Slow 6 (upgraded to Dead 5 at 1.20 pm retrospective to Race 2) **WEATHER:** Overcast

RAIL: Out 14 metres 1200m to Winning Post; 11 metres remainder

RACE 1 : PROJECTION GRAPHICS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1600 metres

TIMELYINTERRUPTION (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted ELENA'S JOY (V. Colgan).

GRACIOUS TARA (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly, shifted in, contacted NUN'S ESPRIT (J. Kah), which was tightened onto MR SCHILLER (S. Cahill).

Approaching the 400 metres ELENA'S JOY (V. Colgan) became held up for a number of strides on the heels of MR SCHILLER (S. Cahill).

TREASURE SON (S. Price) raced keenly for a short distance from the vicinity of the 1000 metres.

V. Colgan, the rider of ELENA'S JOY, the beaten favourite, explained he was comfortable with his position in running and the filly travelled well until in the vicinity of the 600 metres where he had taken up a position to follow the eventual winner of the event, but shortly after straightening, the filly failed to quicken in the manner he expected and performed disappointingly. ELENA'S JOY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : SPORTINGBET / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres

THOMASON (M. Neilson), which contacted the mounting yard fence prior to proceeding to the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race.

MCQUEEN (V. Colgan) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, contacted BUDGET BLOWOUT (NZ) (J. Kah), which was then obliged to race in restricted room between MCQUEEN and MAGIC STING (P. Gatt), which was taken in slightly by SERGEANT JAY (S. Cahill), resulting in BUDGET BLOWOUT (NZ) losing its position.

MCQUEEN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : SPORTINGBET / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE
- 1200 metres (Cont'd)

MAGIC STING, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. K. Sweeney, the Trainer of MAGIC STING, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

The Track was upgraded to a Dead 5 at 1.20 pm retrospective to Race 2.

RACE 3 : SCHWEPPEES / SABOIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to the late arrival of horses at the start.

SUBLEE, SONG OF THE SANDS and WAPPING all lost their near fore plates during the event.

HEZA HUSSLER (J. Toeroek) jumped away very awkwardly, shifted in and made heavy contact with WILD RED (T. Pannell), which was tightened onto HE'LL TELL US (J. Maund), at the same time SCENIC LAKE (W. Kerford) shifted out abruptly, resulting in HE'LL TELL US being severely hampered between WILD RED and SCENIC LAKE. As a consequence, HE'LL TELL US had to be checked and lost its position, and WILD RED had to be restrained when inconvenienced.

LUCKY ON BLACK (S. Westover) shifted out abruptly at the start, at the same time SONG OF THE SANDS (J. Potter) was taken in slightly by WAPPING (J. Kah) resulting in QADIR (M. Neilson) being tightened between SONG OF THE SANDS and LUCKY ON BLACK, losing its position.

Inside the 600 metres RED PEPPER (A. Patterson) contacted the running rail.

Inside the 200 metres LUCKY ON BLACK (S. Westover), which laid in, shifted in and became awkward on the heels of SCENIC LAKE (W. Kerford) for a number of strides before being corrected. S. Westover, the rider of LUCKY ON BLACK, reported his mount raced greenly throughout the event.

BRAWNY HUNTER, HE'LL TELL US, HEZA HUSSLER, LUCKY ON BLACK, RED PEPPER and SUBLEE were all examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : TATSBET 0-71 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

OUR BELVOIR (J. Kah) jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and tightened HEART OF A LION (J. Toeroek) onto ELEFThERIA (T. Pannell). As a consequence, HEART OF A LION lost its position.

HEART OF A LION laid in for a short distance inside the 200 metres. J. Toeroek, the rider of HEART OF A LION, explained as a result of suffering interference at the start, he was unable to take up a more forward position in running as intended and was obliged to settle further back without cover. He added that the gelding laid in, in the straight, placing him at a disadvantage. HEART OF A LION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : IRISH RACE DAY 7TH SEPTEMBER 0-71 HANDICAP – 1600 metres

TOY'S OPINION which became fractious and kicked out after being loaded into its barrier stall was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who passed the gelding fit to race.

CORNISH LAD lost its near fore plate during the event.

In the vicinity of the 1300 metres PRESTIGE GLEN (S. Price) raced in restricted room between JEUNEALISTIC (V. Colgan), which shifted out slightly, and POWER BUTTON (P. Gatt), which shifted in, and was obliged to steady off the heels of CALLMEDAN (A. Patterson) as the pace slackened slightly. As a consequence, PRESTIGE GLEN got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres CALLMEDAN (A. Patterson) improved onto the heels of ZOOM (T. Pannell) of its own accord, clipped the heels of that gelding, stumbled and unbalanced its rider. As a consequence, PRESTIGE GLEN (S. Price) and JEUNEALISTIC (V. Colgan), which was following, were hampered and were obliged to be checked.

RACE 6 : DOMINANT / SABOIS F&M 0-68 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ZIPNOTIZED (J. Potter) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Approaching the 200 metres RAKS MCLAREN (K. Bishop) shifted out abruptly for no apparent reason and contacted SCHADUW (P. Gatt), which was severely hampered and taken wider. As a consequence, RAKS MCLAREN's hindquarters were turned. K. Bishop, the rider of RAKS MCLAREN could offer no explanation for her mount's behaviour.

RAKS MCLAREN and EXALTED ANGEL were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

S. Cahill, the rider of SOPHISTICATED LASS, who considered the mare performed disappointingly, could offer no explanation for the mare's performance other than it may not have been suited to the underfoot conditions.

RACE 7 : DISTINCTIVE HOMES 0-62 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

MANGANESE (S. Westover) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres STELLA GRACE (J. Holder), was disappointed for clear ground for a short distance.

IRISH CHEER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CAPTAIN SHARP (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
