THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 24 August 2013

TRACK: HEAVY 8 WEATHER: Fine

(Upgraded to a Slow 7 at 12.18 pm retrospective to race 1)

RAIL: True 1000 metres to Winning Post, 2 meters back to 1600m, true remainder.

RACE 1: KEN YOUELS MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1000 metres

GAMBLIN' GURU (C. Lindop) was slow to begin.

CASH IS COMING (J. Kah) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and inconvenienced GAMBLIN' GURU (C. Lindop).

CASH IS COMING (J. Kah) was inclined to over race in the early stages.

J. Kah, the rider of CASH IS COMING, accidentally dropped her whip near the 200 metres. J. Kah was reprimanded under ARR.137(a) for carelessness in dropping her whip and advised that future occurrences may result in a penalty being imposed.

BALIGARI lost its off fore plate during the event.

GAMBLIN' GURU was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: NATIONAL JOCKEYS TRUST HANDICAP - 2250 metres

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to permit Mr. J. Croucher, the Trainer of DOC HENNESSY, to view the photo for fourth-place.

THE WILD THING (D. Tourneur) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

ANGELOLOGY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: TATTSBET HANDICAP - 1550 metres

Mr. D. Pannell, acting on behalf of Mr. M. Price, the Trainer of HUNGER, advised P. Gatt would be instructed to take up a forward position, if possible, and to either lead or settle off pace.

RACE 3: TATTSBET HANDICAP - 1550 metres (Continued)

Mrs. P. Trenwith, the trainer of LILGIGGLEO, advised A. Patterson would be instructed to take up a position mid-field with cover if possible.

LADY DYNAMO (J. Toeroek) raced keenly in the early stages of the event and was obliged to race wide without cover for some distance and in the vicinity of the 600 metres commenced to lay in.

J. Toeroek reported that his mount commenced to lay in under pressure. LADY DYNAMO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres LILGIGGLEO (A. Patterson) shifted out and inconvenienced OUT OF COOBER (S. Price), which was taken out into the running line of MICKIEM (D. Tourneur), which was momentarily inconvenienced.

A Patterson, the rider of LILGIGGLEO, was spoken to regarding his use of the whip over the concluding stages, with particular reference to using his whip with his arm raised above shoulder height.

RACE 4: SIMONE MONTGOMERIE TRIBUTE RACE - 1000 metres

In the vicinity of the 300 metres ROMAN EYE (C. Lever) shifted out and brushed HEART OF A LION (J. Bowditch), which was taken out onto LOVEMELONGTIME (S. Cahill), resulting in these two horses being inconvenienced.

HEART OF A LION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a slower than expected recovery.

RACE 5 : ELEPHANT AND CASTLE HANDICAP - 1300 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to SHEIK MOH HAND having to be examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and also owing to GOLD FRENZY, which lost its off fore plate en route to the start requiring the attention of the Farrier and also having to be examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon. Both horses were passed fit to race.

MARION TYPE (P. Gatt) was awkward to begin.

Approaching the 1200 metres NIMASAEL (L. Hopwood) shifted in and inconvenienced THORNY DEVIL (J. Frew).

Inside the 100 metres BARELY A BEAT (J. Holder) shifted out to improve, and brushed with ROCK ON RENNIE (J. Potter), which was taken wider over the concluding stages.

P. Gatt, the rider of MARION TYPE, explained that, as a consequence of this mare being awkward to begin, he was unable to take up a more forward position as intended. He added, that the mare had every opportunity at the entrance to the straight, but only finished the race off fairly. MARION TYPE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to permit J. Potter, the rider and Mr. S. Oxlade, the Trainer of the fourth placegetter ROCK ON RENNIE, to view the official footage in the straight. After doing so J. Potter lodged an objection against BARELY A BEAT (J. Holder) being declared the third placegetter on the grounds of alleged interference from the 150 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards dismissed J. Potter's objection.

RACE 6: LUCRF SUPER HANDICAP - 1250 metres

On arrival on course DEHERE HUNTER, at the request of its Trainer, Mr. K. Harris, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to race.

NEAREST TO PIN (C. Lindop) jumped away awkwardly.

DEHERE HUNTER (J. Bowditch) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

J. Bowditch, the rider of DEHERE HUNTER, reported the gelding failed to finish the race off over the concluding stages and, in his opinion, there may have been something amiss with the horse. DEHERE HUNTER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: HYLANDS RACE COLOURS HANDICAP - 1400 metres

JULIET'S PRINCESS (USA) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon after arrival on course and ruled fit to start.

BRINKLEY BULLET was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon after arrival on course at the request of its Trainer, Mr. C. Stewart, who reported the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Acting on that advice, BRINKLEY BULLET was declared a late scratching at 2.23 pm. Mr. C. Stewart, the Trainer of BRINKLEY BULLET was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

GAUSS (J. Holder) became held up for clear running at the entrance to the straight and was only able to obtain clear ground in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

Approaching the 300 metres HALAYR JET (S. Cahill) was disappointed for clear running between AMBROSIA (D. Tourneur) and REGAL HERO (C. Lever), and was obliged to alter course to the outside of AMBROSIA. Shortly thereafter, HALAYR JET became held up for a number of strides between the heels of AMBROSIA and KING USAIN (NZ) (A. Patterson). Thereafter, HALAYR JET was inclined to lay in for the remainder of the event.

SWINGING SOLDIER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

REGAL HERO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a small amount of blood in its mouth.

RACE 8: SPORTINGBET PENNY EDITION STAKES - 1400 metres

JUST DISCREET, which contacted the barrier structure when being loaded, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race.

JUST DISCREET (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly.

ROAD WARRIOR (T. Pannell) became held up for clear running approaching the 400 metres and was only able to obtain clear ground in the vicinity of the 200 metres where it was obliged to alter course to the outside of the field.

D. Tourneur, the rider of JUST DISCREET, explained he was comfortable with the position obtained in running in the early stages, but added the mare never travelled at any stage during the event and in the vicinity of the 600 metres was off the bridle and finished the race off in a disappointing manner. He added, in his opinion, the mare may not have been suited to today's underfoot conditions.

JUST DISCREET, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a small abrasion to the point of its off side hip.
