Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 27 October 2013

RACE 1 : HOLCIM / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1900 metres

LOVERS RULES (J. Frew) was slow to begin.

DOUBLESIX (D. Tourneur) commenced to give ground approaching the 400 metres. DOUBLESIX was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

VALIK (C. Lindop) laid in, in the straight. VALIK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GEE I'M GOOD, which returned to the mounting enclosure with blood in its mouth, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no other visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : XXXX GOLD BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

SANDHILL PRINCE (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SACRED SNAADEE (M. Neilson), taking that gelding out across the running of OFF THE MAP (J. Kah), which was obliged to steady away from the heels of SACRED SNAADEE.

Approaching the 100 metres SANDHILL PRINCE (D. Tourneur) rolled out resulting in SACRED SNAADEE (M. Neilson) becoming momentarily inconvenienced and obliged to alter course to the inside of SANDHILL PRINCE to obtain clear running.

Following the running of this race, the Stewards upgraded the track to Good 3 at 1.50 pm, retrospective to Race 2.

RACE 3 : BARRETT DISTRIBUTORS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to HIGH CRESCENDO, which made contact with the mounting yard fence en route to the start, being examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the filly fit to race. The start was also delayed owing to SANDHILL FLASH becoming fractious behind the barriers.

RACE 3 : BARRETT DISTRIBUTORS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

MURSADIE (C. Forrest) jumped away awkwardly.

MISS TORY (P. Marks) stood flat-footed and missed the start several lengths. Mr. L. Cadzow, the Trainer of MISS TORY, was advised a repetition of the mare's behaviour may lead to action being taken.

MURSADIE (C. Forrest) laid out making the turn in the vicinity of the 900 metres.

Approaching the 50 metres DUBAILATION (C. Lindop) rolled out and momentarily inconvenienced MURSADIE (C. Forrest).

CHESTNUT CHARLIE, which laid out throughout the event, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be exhibiting signs of shin soreness.

RACE 4 : RAY WHITE BORDERTOWN / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres

MR DUPLESIS (J. Frew) stood flat-footed and missed the start by four lengths. Mrs. M. Harrison, the Trainer of MR DUPLESIS, was advised the gelding would be required to prove it can jump away with the field in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

ELINES (C. Forrest) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, contacting MISS YOU JOHNNY (L. Hopwood).

ELINES (C. Forrest) laid out throughout the event. ELINES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a speedy cut to the near hind fetlock.

Approaching the 400 metres and until the 300 metres SANDHILL DANCER (A. Herrmann) became held up on the heels of NICKS 'N' CUTS (D. Tourneur) and to the inside of JETMAKER (C. Lindop).

Approaching the 100 metres NICKS 'N' CUTS (D. Tourneur) laid out and inconvenienced JETMAKER (C. Lindop).

RACE 5 : WISE FORD & FARM EQUIPMENT RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1900 metres

On arrival on course DUBAI KING was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Acting on that advice DUBAI KING was withdrawn by Stewards at 2.07 pm.

The start of this race was delayed approximately one minute to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

NAVAN LASS (L. Hopwood) was slow to begin.

CERTAIN DEE (J. Maund) made the turn approaching the 1600 metres awkwardly and shifted wider on the track, inconveniencing POTLUCK (D. Tourneur), which was taken wider on the track.

In the vicinity of the 1400 metres A. Herrmann, the rider of STORM BREWING, was obliged to take hold when the gelding shifted out and across the heels of CERTAIN DEE (J. Maund).

STORM BREWING (A. Herrmann) continued to lay out for the remainder of the event, despite the efforts of its rider and on entering the straight the gelding's bridle shifted and A. Herrmann was unable to assist the gelding for the remainder of the event. STORM

RACE 5 : WISE FORD & FARM EQUIPMENT RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1900 metres (Cont'd)

BREWING was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CERTAIN DEE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr. D. Dodson, the Trainer of CERTAIN DEE, was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its tractability.

RACE 6 : S C IRLAM SHEARING CONTRACTORS CLASS 2 HANDICAP – 1100 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

VINTAGE BELLE (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, bumping JACK'S A TIGER TOO (C. Forrest).

Approaching the 200 metres ICONSEEFRAARAWAY (J. Kah) laid in and momentarily inconvenienced GO NINNY GO (S. Price).

RACE 7 : WOOLSHED INN BORDERTOWN RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

SHE'S GOT SOUL (C. Forrest) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres JESTA TIGER (M. Neilson) rolled in and inconvenienced HOTDEAL (L. Hopwood).

Approaching the 100 metres MILD MANNERED (A. Herrmann) became momentarily held up on the heels of SERIOUS DANGER (J. Frew).
