THOROUGHBRED RACING AUTHORITY S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at the Mount Gambier Racecourse by the Mount Gambier Racing Club on Sunday, 10 November 2013

TRACK: Dead 5 (Downgraded to Slow 6 at 11.30 am) WEATHER: Overcast/Fine

(Upgraded to Dead 5 at 3.39 pm, retrospective to Race 6)

RAIL: True

RACE 1 : SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 900 metres

SHE BY DEBEERS (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, brushing BLEVACHI (C. Forrest).

SANDHILL HERO (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly.

SANDHILL HERO (D. Tourneur) raced greenly throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres GALLIUMS TABARET (H. McKechnie), which was racing ungenerously, shifted out marginally and had to steady away from the heels of TON OF PRUSSIA (C. Lindop), which was shifting in.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres GALLIUMS TABARET (H. McKechnie) had to be steadied momentarily when QUEEN NEDIYM (A. Herrmann) shifted out and SANDHILL HERO (D. Tourneur) shifted in under pressure.

TON OF PRUSSIA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor speedy cut to the near hock.

RACE 2: CUB RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1550 metres

RAMSGATE (J. Potter) was slow to begin.

RAMSGATE (J. Potter) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

RACE 3: WHITEHEAD TIMBER SUPPLIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1550 metres

SOLACE (D. Tourneur) was slow into stride.

SHARBO (NZ) (H. McKechnie) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres KING OF THE STORM (C. Lindop) had to steady off the heels of SANDHILL DANCER (A. Herrmann) when HERMAN (K. Post) shifted out. K. Post was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

RACE 4: STEELINE ROOFING MOUNT GAMBIER RATING 0-68 HANDICAP – 1400 metres

MUSEE D'MODEL (P. Marks) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, bumping BERNIE'S BOY (H. McKechnie).

RACE 4 : STEELINE ROOFING MOUNT GAMBIER RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 900 metres MUSEE D'MODEL (P. Marks), which was racing keenly, had to steady away from the heels of BERNIE'S BOY (H. McKechnie).

In the vicinity of the 400 metres until the vicinity of the 200 metres RED FELLA (C. Lindop) was held up for clear running when racing on the heels of MY WAY (K. Post).

In the vicinity of the 200 metres FRADEMA (D. Tourneur) had to momentarily steady when racing tight between MUSEE D'MODEL (P. Marks) and WELCOME NED (M. Neilson).

RACE 5 : THE PRODUCE STORE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

On arrival at the barriers SPARE ONE, which struck the mounting enclosure gate en route to the start, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the horse fit to race.

ROYARRA (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

MURSADIE (C. Forrest) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, inconveniencing SPARE ONE (K. Post).

In the vicinity of the 900 metres ROYARRA (A. Herrmann), which was racing ungenerously, hung out, taking MURSADIE (C. Forrest) wider on the track. ROYARRA continued to lay out for the remainder of the event.

Approaching the 200 metres DUBAILATION (J. Potter) and CLASS BEATS (P. Marks) bumped.

DUBAILATION lost its near hind plate during the event.

ROYARRA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: SMB CIVIL BM80 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

SEASON OF FORTUNE (M. Walters) was slow to begin.

RACE 7: DO IT YOURSELF FENCING RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

Mr. W. Walters, the Trainer of LUCKZAT (NZ), advised Stewards he would instruct Apprentice S. Noble to attempt to ride the mare in a more forward position to assist it to finish the race off better.

SIR ANTHONY (A. Patterson), GAUSS (M. Neilson) and LUCKZAT (NZ) (S. Noble) were slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 50 metres LUCKZAT (NZ) (S. Noble), when taking a tight run between GAUSS (M. Neilson) and LOTS OF HEART (A. Herrmann), rolled out marginally and brushed LOTS OF HEART.

Approaching the winning post LUCKZAT (NZ) (S. Noble) shifted in marginally brushing GAUSS (M. Neilson).

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow A. Herrmann, the rider of the third placegetter LOTS OF HEART, to view the official footage in the straight.

RACE 7 : DO IT YOURSELF FENCING RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1800 metres (Cont'd)

GO FOR HOME was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GAUSS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare had bitten its tongue.

RACE 8: THE DISTRIBUTORS MOUNT GAMBIER RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Acting on confirmed advice from Mr. A. Chambers, the Trainer of GRASSMERE MOOKTA, that the gelding had an elevated temperature and would be unfit to race, Stewards withdrew GRASSMERE MOOKTA at 8.47 am.

I'M SMOKIN (H. McKechnie) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, brushing ROYALCONI (M. Neilson).

In the vicinity of the 250 metres ROYALCONI (M. Neilson) shifted out away from the heels of TELASNIP (K. Post), which rolled out marginally.

WORROLONG LAD, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

EARS HENERY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
