**RACE 1 : MCDONALD'S BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

MY WAY (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, bumping SEASON OF FORTUNE (C. Jones).

**RACE 2 : THE NARACOORTE HERALD / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres**

MONDAY'S EXPERT (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, bumping CASINO WIZARD (A. Herrmann).

JUST MY STYLE (C. Forrest) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, COPPER CABLE (J. Frew) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out as a result, GINGA GAL (NZ) (H. McKechnie) was inconvenienced.

AKHAALI (A. Doyle) jumped away awkwardly.

In the vicinity of the 900 metres GINGA GAL (NZ) (H. McKechnie) raced greenly and shifted out, inconveniencing JUST MY STYLE (C. Forrest), which as a result was taken wider.

COPPER CABLE (J. Frew) was inclined to lay in in the home straight.

CASINO WIZARD (A. Herrmann) raced greenly throughout the event. CASINO WIZARD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

### **RACE 3 : NARACOORTE RECYCABLES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1430 metres**

TRANSFORMING (L. Hopwood) was slow to begin.

SPINNING MOMENT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

### **RACE 4 : HANSEN DESIGN & PRINT RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres**

In the vicinity of the 600 metres ETHBAAL (C. Forrest) was forced to steady when FATHER TONY (M. Neilson) shifted in. Shortly thereafter KILL BILL (A. Herrmann), which commenced to hang out when racing in restricted room to the inside of ETHBAAL, rolled out on to the heels of FATHER TONY, resulting in KILL BILL clipping the heels of FATHER TONY and dislodging its rider A. Herrmann. As a result ANGEL DOVE (H. McKechnie) was severely hampered when avoiding the fallen rider. M. Neilson was severely reprimanded and advised in future to shift ground only when entitled to do so.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres ANGEL DOVE was eased out of the event when its rider became concerned with the mares action. ANGEL DOVE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

In the vicinity of the 50 metres JESSIE CANGO (P. Marks) shifted out under pressure, bumping FATHER TONY (M. Neilson)

KILL BILL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

A. Herrmann was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and was stood down from her engagement in Race 5. After considering the report from First Care Medical and observing A. Herrmann's condition, Stewards stood her down from all of her remaining riding engagements.

### **RACE 5 : ENVIRO TEC RATING 0-68 HANDICAP – 2000 metres**

FULLOTRIX (J. Potter) raced ungenerously in the early stages.

SURPRISE US (M. Neilson) raced ungenerously throughout the event.

SURPRISE US was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding was found to have a foreign object in its left eye. First-aid was administered.

### **RACE 6 : HAYNES ENGINEERING RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1430 metres**

TELASNIP (K. Post), MOUNT MEE UP (D. Tourneur), NOTHIN LEICA FLASH (J. Maund) and TONTO'S PRIDE (J. Potter) were all slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres TELASNIP (K. Post) raced ungenerously for a short distance.

Approaching the 200 metres COURTING JUSTICE (S. Cahill) and TIGERKELLY (M. Neilson) bumped, resulting in COURTING JUSTICE being momentarily inconvenienced.

COURTING JUSTICE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 7 : MUNRO & GRIGG AUTO REPAIRS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

As A Herrmann was unable to ride CASINO MISS and as no other senior rider was available to ride at the allotted weight, Stewards permitted A. Doyle to replace A. Herrmann.

KIRVIC (J. Toeroek) was slow to begin.

SERIOUS DANGER (J. Frew) was slow into stride.

Approaching the 600 metres TEEN SPIRIT (D. Tourneur) raced ungenerously for a short distance.
