Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln Racecourse

RACE 1 : PURE BLONDE / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

FLIGHT OF TERROR (T. Pannell) was awkward to begin and its rider became unbalanced.

DIVADEBEER (R. Bell) was slow to begin and raced wide throughout.

ACE OF SPADES (J. Potter) raced ungenerously in the early stages.

ORIDANE (S. Westover) raced ungenerously while being steadied in the early stages.

Rounding the turn near the 700 metres, DIVADEBEER (R. Bell) was taken wider on the track by SCENIC MINT (P. Roff), which laid out. SCENIC MINT continued to lay out rounding the home turn and DIVADEBEER was further hampered.

DIVADEBEER (R. Bell) was accidentally struck over the nose by the whip of P. Roff (SCENIC MINT) rounding the home turn.

DIVADEBEER (R. Bell) raced greenly in the home straight.

ACE OF SPADES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have lacerations to both cheeks. Trainer Mr W. Drewitt undertook to have that gelding's teeth attended to.

RACE 2 : CARLTON DRAUGHT / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE – 1750 metres

SANS PEUR (S. Cahill) began awkwardly and shifted out on to KAZANJIAN (P. Roff).

BLACK DANCER (T. Pannell) began awkwardly and shifted out hampering KAREN THE SEYIS (M. Neilson).

Passing the winning post on the first occasion MISTAKEN VALUE (K. Bishop) was inclined to race ungenerously and continued to do so for some distance.

Inside the 1300 metres MISTAKEN VALUE (K. Bishop) continued to race ungenerously resulting in KAZANJIAN (P. Roff) becoming awkward on that gelding's heels. Shortly after MISTAKEN VALUE shifted out, KAZANJIAN improved to its inside and was checked when MISTAKEN VALUE shifted back in. K. Bishop was advised that she must ensure she is two lengths clear when shifting ground.

Approaching the 200 metres BLACK DANCER (T. Pannell) was disappointed for a run between MISTAKEN VALUE (K. Bishop) and KAREN THE SEYIS (M. Neilson), both of which shifted ground.

Approaching the 150 metres KAREN THE SEYIS (M. Neilson) was obliged to alter course to avoid the heels of LAMU LAD (S. Westover), which shifted in under pressure.

P. Roff the rider of KAZANJIAN reported that passing the crossing near the 1300 metres his saddle slipped

S. Cahill the rider of SANS PEUR reported that his mount was making an abnormal respiratory noise. SANS PEUR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be displaying poor post-race recovery.

RACE 3 : JANUARY 10TH TWILIGHT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres

SOLDIER OF MERCY (J. Potter) and MINERS KEEPERS (D. Tourneur) were slow to begin.

CACKLE (W. Kerford) began awkwardly and made contact with its offside barrier gate.

SOLDIER OF MERCY (J. Potter) was inclined to overrace in the early stages.

Near the 200 metres JAWANNA (R. Bell) was obliged to steady for a short distance off the heels of LEWIS STREET (P. Roff), which shifted in. P. Roff was advised to ensure he is two lengths clear when shifting ground.

L. Hopwood, rider of ZIGZAG STREET, reported that her mount was inclined to dip throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 4 : MIKE RALEIGH MOTORS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

HOT COCO (L. Hopwood) and SNIP IN TIME (T. Pannell) were awkward to begin.

RACE 5 : CARLTON COLD 3.5 RATING 0-68 HANDICAP – 1360 metres

On arrival at the barriers GOLD VINTAGE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to start.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres CORDUROY (S. Price) was obliged to check his mount when OAKBANK HEIGHTS (K. Bishop) shifted in and slackened the pace in the incident JUST PURE FUN (L. Stojakovic) was also hampered. K. Bishop was reprimanded and advised two lengths clear when shifting ground.

DESTONY HAWK (J. Potter) was inclined to lay in, in the straight.

DESTONY HAWK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported revealed the mare to be displaying no significant abnormalities.

RACE 6 : KEMP REAL ESTATE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

MR KARGER (P. Roff) shifted out at the start, tightening TARVON (K. Brooks) on to THE BIG RED VEE (L. Stojakovic).

RAND AL THOR (S. Price) overraced while being restrained in the early stages.

Passing the 800 metres SHE'S GOT SOUL (J. Potter) was inconvenienced and taken wider on the track by OKAMAN (T. Pannell), which had commenced to overrace.

RACE 7 : YALUMBA BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

Stewards accepted the explanation from trainer D. Carrison in regards to the late notification of L. Stojakovic as the rider of YARTERBERY as there was no rider available at the weight prior to scratching time.

TESTATE (S. Cahill) reared on jumping away and lost ground.

SPIRIT OF FLATLEY (D. Tourneur) was slow to begin.

DOUBLE DEALING (K. Bishop) overraced in the early and middle stages.

SPIRIT OF FLATLEY (D. Tourneur) hung out making the home turn.

RACE 8 : BARBALA CONSTRUCTIONS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

LOVERS ROCKS (L. Stojakovic) and KOMOVI (S. Cahill) began awkwardly, shifted ground and contacted.

Near the 1000 metres KOMOVI (S. Cahill) was inclined to lay in away from other runners. S. Cahill the rider of KOMOVI reported that his mount resented racing in amongst the field.

MEMORY COVE (T. Pannell) got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

ROAD TO DANTREE (K. Brooks) was inclined to lay in in the straight.

ROAD TO DANTREE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

KOMOVI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

YALE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
