Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 8 February 2014

RACE 1 : SCHWEPES HANDICAP - 1950 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to an interstate delay.

RACE 2 : SPORTINGBET HANDICAP - 1400 metres

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres TOKEN ONE (D. Tootell) was taken out by SHADE OF GREEN (D. Tourneur), which rolled out. As a consequence TOKEN ONE contacted BORISTAR (S. Cahill), resulting in the hindquarters of TOKEN ONE being turned.

RACE 3 : CITY OF MARION HANDICAP - 1000 metres

BLACK CAESAR (J. Holder) was slow to begin.

TIGER RUBY (D. Stra) jumped away awkwardly, then pulled hard in the early and middle stages of the event and was difficult to restrain.

PATCH HERO (J. Toeroek) got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance inside the 700 metres.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres WOTZINTHEBAG (S. Price) was unable to improve into a run between PATCH HERO (J. Toeroek) and JUST DEMANDING (A. Herrmann) and became held up for clear ground until near the 100 metres.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres D. Stra, the rider of TIGER RUBY, was obliged to stop riding and straighten her mount as it commenced to shift ground inwards.

HERE COMES THEBOOM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : TATSBET ADELAIDE CUP 10TH MARCH HANDICAP - 1250 metres

At the entrance to the straight WHITE SAMBUCA (NZ) (D. Tourneur) was disappointed for clear ground for a short distance when racing between WISE AND HAPPY (K. Bishop) and GOLD BUNDLE (M. Neilson).

D. Tourneur, the rider of WHITE SAMBUCA (NZ), reported the gelding hung out during the event. WHITE SAMBUCA (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

C. Forrest, the rider of TEEN SPIRIT, reported the mare hung out during the event. TEEN SPIRIT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : ANGELAKIS BROS PLATE – 1000 metres

CALIANCO (M. Neilson) and ARDERE (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly and contacted.

NOVATOR (L. Hopwood) jumped away very awkwardly.

MIRACLE BID (O. Ay) raced greenly throughout the event.

ASH ROAD (J. Frew) was inclined to lay in, in the early part of the straight.

ARDERE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. R. Balfour, Co-Trainer of the ARDERE, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the filly for a future trial or race.

MAASAI JUSTICE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : 14TH FEB MEMBERS ROAST @ THE JUNCTION HANDICAP - 1400 metres

FLASK (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted GEORDIE'S SECOND (S. Price).

FLASK (A. Herrmann) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

Approaching the 400 metres STACK THE TRUCK (J. Frew) improved into a tight run between GEORDIE'S SECOND (S. Price) and MAASAI WARRIOR (S. Westover) and contacted MAASAI WARRIOR, turning that colt's hindquarters. As a consequence STACK THE TRUCK was obliged to be steadied and became awkwardly placed on the heels of GEORDIE'S SECOND for a short distance before obtaining clear running in the vicinity of the 200 metres. J. Frew was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when attempting runs in future.

J. Toeroek, the rider of TYPHOON, reported his mount was inclined to lay away from runners in the straight. TYPHOON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GEORDIE'S SECOND was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : BOAG'S DRAUGHT HANDICAP - 1400 metres

MARBLE RYE (A. Herrmann) and CRYSTAL ICON (W. Kerford) jumped away awkwardly.

Over the concluding stages GENEROUS BEAU (S. Westover) rolled out and became awkward on the heels of CELLARMASTER (NZ) (J. Childs) as that gelding rolled in marginally. As a consequence GENEROUS BEAU was obliged to race in restricted room between CELLARMASTER (NZ) and MAGICAL PEARL (S. Cahill), which rolled out.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow S. Westover, the rider of the fourth placegetter GENEROUS BEAU, the gelding's Co-Trainer Mr. R. Balfour, and a part owner of the gelding, to view the official vision in the straight.

CELLARMASTER (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : MEDALLION HOMES HANDICAP - 1000 metres

BRIMARVI PRINCE (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly.

From in the vicinity of the 800 metres STRIDING SUCCESS (C. Forrest) was obliged to race in restricted room to the inside of OGUNDE (O. Ay) for a short distance, as that gelding shifted in. O. Ay was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.
