STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Clare Racecourse
by the Clare Valley Racing Club on Sunday, 9 March 2014

RACE 1 : CLARE VALLEY TOYOTA / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

ALL THE TIME (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.

Rounding the home turn BAD MEDICINE (T. Baker) laid in and away from DARK FANTASY (S. Price) onto PURE FINNISS (J. Frew).

A Herrmann, the rider of ALL THE TIME, reported that she was instructed to take up a mid-field position, however, after missing the start was not able to do so. She added with the very slow pace of the race she was unable to take ground off the leaders over the concluding stages. ALL THE TIME was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : SUBWAY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

PHAETON FOX was a late scratching at 1:56 pm on Veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers. Mr R. Moore, the trainer of PHAETON FOX, was advised that the gelding must prove tractable in the barriers in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

Shortly after the start MAGISUE (O. Ridge) got its head up, over raced and shifted onto THE SHADOW DANCER (J. Toeroek). MAGISUE continued to over race for some distance thereafter. MAGISUE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare had sustained a speedy cut to the near hind pastern.

Near the 200 metres DOUBLE GREY (W. Kerford) was obliged to shift to the inside of THE SHADOW DANCER (J. Toeroek) which shifted out under pressure.

J. Toeroek, the rider of THE SHADOW DANCER, reported his mount raced greenly throughout the event.

RACE 3 : MAYORS CUP / SABOIS FILLIES AND MARES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP
- 1200 metres

FRILLY SKURT (C. Forrest) was slow to begin and raced wide throughout the event.

RED BEGONIA (J. Toeroek) made the turn awkwardly near the 800 metres shifted out and made contact with JEST A JILLY (T. Pannell) which was taken wider hampering FRILLY SKURT (C. Forrest).

RACE 4 : MAGIC FM / 5CS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres

On jumping away PURE QUARTZ (T. Pannell) shifted in tightening HURRICANE SONNY (K. Brooks) onto WINSKI (K. Bishop). As a result HURRICANE SONNY lost its position.

HURRICANE SONNY (K. Brooks) laid out under pressure in the straight.

NAMTOUR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to be displaying arterial fibrillation. Mr T. Jolly, the trainer of NAMTOUR, was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and the filly would be required to perform satisfactorily in an Official barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 5 : THE CLARE HOTEL (MIDDLE PUB) RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

CIRCLE OF TRUST (K. Brooks) jumped away awkwardly.

Near the 1000 metres DREAMIN' NINA (W. Kerford) shifted out hampering FACING (K. Bishop).

Near the 100 metres CRUZ'N NOW (J. Frew) shifted to the outside of WHERE'S THAT (T. Pannell) in an attempt to improve into a tight run, however, WHERE'S THAT shifted out slightly. CRUZ'N NOW then continued to shift out taking CIRCLE OF TRUST (K. Brooks) out onto BLEVIC LAD (J. Toeroek). In the incident K. Brooks, the rider of CIRCLE OF TRUST, was obliged to steady her mount. J. Frew was advised to take greater care when his mounts commence to shift ground in future.

WHERE'S THAT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : O'DEA ELECTRICAL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

K. Brooks, the rider of DABAMIRAK, accidentally dropped her whip near the 150 metres. K. Brooks was reprimanded under AR137(a) for carelessness.

ZANDERCAN which weakened in the straight was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr G. Searle, the trainer of ZANDERCAN, reported that the gelding would be spelled.

RACE 7 : MID NORTH AG SERVICES COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ALBANY GREY (W. Kerford) shifted in on jumping away contacting COOL CLASSIC (D. Stra) which reared as the start was effected and was slow to begin.

Approaching the 200 metres OTYLIA (A. Doyle) shifted out to improve taking DOOLAM RIVER (K. Brooks) out onto the heels of MIME (A. Herrmann). In the incident K. Brooks was obliged to check her mount. A. Doyle pleaded guilty to a charge of Careless Riding under AR137(a) and was suspended for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 15 March until midnight on Sunday, 22 March 2014: a period of three (3) meetings. In assessing penalty the Stewards took into account, A. Doyle's guilty plea and his clean good record.

INDEPENDENT AIR (S. Price) was held up for clear running from the entrance of the straight to the winning post and was unable to be fully tested.

**RACE 7 : MID NORTH AG SERVICES COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES RATING 0-58
HANDICAP - 1200 metres – Cont'd**

INDEPENDENT AIR (S. Price) dipped at the entrance to the straight and again shortly after for no apparent reason. INDEPENDENT AIR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
