Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse by the Kimba Racing Club on Sunday, 23 March 2014

RACE 1 : IRONCLAD MINING & TRAFFORD RESOURCES / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD HANDICAP - 1200 metres

GAIVERENTE (S. Cahill) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in brushing with RUBY AMOUR (K. Brooks) and as a result shifted out and bumped with FLIGHT OF TERROR (J. Potter).

Shortly after the start WHITE JADE (K. Bishop) was taken out by GLENROSS (M. Pegus) onto the heels of RUBY AMOUR (K. Brooks) and was obliged to check.

RUBY AMOUR (K. Brooks) raced wide without cover in the middle stages.

WHITE JADE (K. Bishop) hung out rounding the home turn.

RUBY AMOUR (K. Brooks) was inclined to shift in under pressure in the straight.

Ms. A. Cornell, the Trainer of JESTWIN, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to it being difficult to load.

RACE 2 : DARKE PEAK HOTEL, PORT HUGHES TAVERN, COWELL COMMERCIAL HOTEL & COWELL FRANKLIN HARBOUR HOTEL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

SON OF A GUN which kicked out in its barrier stall after being loaded was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding was fit to race.

R. Bell, the rider of SON OF A GUN, accidently dropped his whip in the vicinity of the 250 metres. R. Bell was reprimanded and advised future carelessness may result in a penalty being imposed.

DOUBLE DEALING (S. Cahill) raced greenly in the straight.

WEATHER: Overcast

RACE 2 : DARKE PEAK HOTEL, PORT HUGHES TAVERN, COWELL COMMERCIAL HOTEL & COWELL FRANKLIN HARBOUR HOTEL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres – Cont'd

M. Neilson, the rider of VINARD, explained he was comfortable where he had settled in the race but in his opinion, the pace had not suited VINARD and the gelding had not responded to his riding when placed under pressure in the straight. VINARD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

KAMPKOOKER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : HARDER TRANSPORT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

JAWANNA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and was found to be lame in the near foreleg. Acting on that advice Stewards withdrew JAWANNA at 1.15pm. Mr. D. Carrison, the Trainer of JAWANNA was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres NASTRADA (D. Dunn) raced keenly for some distance when awkwardly placed inside the heels of MISS BELLARAE (T. Baker).

RACE 4 : IRONCLAD MINING & TRAFFORD RESOURCES HANDICAP- 1200 metres

Acting on confirmed advice from Trainer Ms. A. Morrison that SPIRIT OF FLATLEY was lame in the near foreleg, Stewards declared SPIRIT OF FLATLEY a late scratching at 10.15 am.

HANK'S NEPHEW (K. Brooks) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres HANK'S NEPHEW (K. Brooks) was inclined to race keenly when being restrained.

M. Neilson, the rider of ROLL ON BAI, reported that the gelding felt uncomfortable in its action when placed under pressure. ROLL ON BAI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : ELDERS INSURANCE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1360 metres

BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (D. Dunn) raced keenly in the early stages.

From the vicinity of the 300 metres to the entrance of the straight, STRAWPEDO (R. Bell) was held up for clear running between the heels of HIGHEST NOTE (M. Pegus) and BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (D. Dunn) and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (D. Dunn) was obliged to ease off the heels of HIGHEST NOTE (M. Pegus) which rolled in marginally.

HIGHEST NOTE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : LIENERT ENGINEERING RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

Mr. S. Drewitt, the trainer of MIGHTY MOMENT, advised Stewards he would instruct T. Pannell to attempt to obtain a position forward of mid field on MIGHTY MOMENT in this event.

LAMU LAD which got its leg up in the barrier stall after being loaded and was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding fit to race.

RACE 6 : LIENERT ENGINEERING RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1750 metres - Cont'd

MILLIGANS (R. Bell) was inclined to rear on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1450 metres MILLIGANS (R. Bell) brushed the inside running rail.

From the vicinity of the 1400 until the 1200 metres SOCIAL ASSASSIN (M. Neilson) raced keenly on the heels of ESCHOLIDO (IRE) (D. Dunn).

In the vicinity of the 400 metres VOODOO BLACK MAGIC (J. Potter) rolled in momentarily inconveniencing SHADY JADE (T. Baker).

In the vicinity of the 100 metres ESCHOLIDO (IRE) (D. Dunn) and TERRAPINNA (L. Hopwood) came together and brushed.

Mr. J. Dunn, the trainer of SOCIAL ASSASSIN, which was fractious in the gates, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow T. Baker, the rider of the second placegetter, SHADY JADE and the mare's Trainer Mr. T Doudle, to view the official footage in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

RACE 7 : THE WUDINNA HOTEL MOTEL KIMBA CUP - 1950 metres

In the early stages of the event PRETTY BLONDE (J. Potter) raced keenly on the heels of JAPAN (P. Roff) for a short distance.

In the vicinity of the 1500 metres MEADOWS STORM (K. Brooks) was obliged to be restrained off the heels of MISS ABERDEEN (T. Baker) which shifted in. T. Baker was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

In the vicinity of the 1300 metres TESTATE (S. Cahill) raced keenly on the heels of OCSMEPOP (K. Bishop) for a short distance.

RACE 8 : MARINA HOTEL RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to HARLEY'S MATE getting its leg up in the barriers after being loaded. HARLEY'S MATE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding fit to race.

From the vicinity of the 400 metres to the entrance of the straight AIR COMET (J. Potter) was held up for clear running on the heels of GOD'S VALLEY (K. Bishop).

In the vicinity of the 200 metres AIR COMET (J. Potter), became held up for clear running on the heels of CHLOBOROUGH (M. Neilson), and in obtaining clear ground, shifted out and brushed with GOD'S VALLEY (K. Bishop). J. Potter was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres, P. Roff the rider of HEZAFRAAR had his whip accidently knocked out of his hand by the whip of M. Neilson the rider of CHLOBOROUGH.

K. Brooks the rider of BUDDY FANTASTIC reported that the gelding was inclined to lay in throughout the event. BUDDY FANTASTIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CHLOBOROUGH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
