

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED
STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 29 March 2014

RACE 1 : SCHWEPPE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

DANOULI (J. Bowditch) and STIMULATTE (A. Herrmann) contacted at the start.

THOMASON (D. Tourneur) raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

MURTLE TURTLE (S. Carr) raced wide without cover throughout the event and raced a little keenly in the early and middle stages.

CHOOSE (R. Wheeler) raced greenly in the straight.

DANOULI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : SPORTINGBET HANDICAP - 2500 metres

SOUTHERN INVASION was a late scratching by order of Stewards at 12.38 pm owing to S. Price being overweight and no replacement rider being available to ride the gelding.

In the vicinity of the 450 metres RAWNAQ (S. Cahill) shifted in to improve and tightened BAKLAVA BOY (NZ) (S. Carr), which had to be checked to avoid the heels of RAWNAQ. S. Cahill, the rider of RAWNAQ, pleaded guilty to a charge of Careless Riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Monday, 31 March and to conclude at midnight on Wednesday, 9 April 2014; a period of four (4) meetings.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres UMALUKA (L. Hopwood) was obliged to be steadied when racing between the heels of DOC HENNESSY (T. Pannell), which shifted out, and BREDLIGN (NZ) (J. Toeroek), which shifted in under pressure.

RAWNAQ was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : STAKES FAMILY DAY RACES 12TH APRIL HANDICAP - 1200 metres

QADIR (M. Neilson) laid out in the straight.

LAMPEDUSA and QADIR were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : BIG SCREEN VIDEO BREEDERS' STAKES - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to WHAT'S THE CRAIC requiring the attention of the Farrier after it was established on arrival at the barriers that the colt had lost its off fore plate en route to the start. As the Farrier was unable to fit another suitable plate, Stewards granted permission for the near fore shoe to be removed and the horse was permitted to race without front plates. Prior to taking its place in the barriers WHAT'S THE CRAIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to race.

GO INDY GO (J. Holder) and FRANK HEAVENS (J. Kah) came together at the start and contacted.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres LONDON LOLLY (T. Pannell) shifted in, resulting in HOUSE OF HINGIS (NZ) (L. Meech) being obliged to alter course to that filly's outside.

Subsequent to the event, WHAT'S THE CRAIC was again examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported bilateral foot soreness in front, with no other visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : ANSPACH REMOVALS AND STORAGE HANDICAP - 1600 metres

UNSPUN (M. Neilson) raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

Inside the 400 metres EXCITES ZELADY (S. Carr), which became held up on the heels of EXCITABLE PACKAGE (B. Egan) for a short distance, improved to that gelding's outside into restricted room and contacted with KUSHADASI (J. Toeroek), which was taken out onto ROBOCOP (J. Potter), resulting in the hindquarters of ROBOCOP being turned and KUSHADASI and ROBOCOP becoming severely hampered for a number of strides. S. Carr was advised that in similar circumstances in future she may be better served to not persist with her run into restricted room.

GOLDEN TEO, which weakened inside the 800 metres and lost ground quickly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had bled from both nostrils during the event. First Aid was administered. Mr S. Oxlade, the Trainer of GOLDEN TEO, was advised the gelding is now suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A(4).

WHITE ROE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

TENERE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a small laceration to the off fore cannon. First Aid was administered.

RACE 6 : MITTYS LAELIA STAKES - 1600 metres

SILVER PENNY (NZ), which reared in its race day stall and got both front legs over the side partition, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon prior to the event and ruled fit to race.

On arrival on course SILVER PENNY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the filly fit to race.

RACE 6 : MITTYS LAELIA STAKES - 1600 metres (Cont'd)

Mr P. Stokes, the Trainer of FOREVER DISCREET, advised Stewards he would instruct his Jockey D. Tourneur to attempt to obtain a position on pace in the early stages of the event.

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to STAR FASHION, which proved fractious behind the barriers, rearing and falling over. STAR FASHION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the filly unfit to race. Acting on that advice, the Stewards withdrew STAR FASHION at 3.42 pm. Mr B. Papazaharoudakis, representing Mr. D. Hayes, the Trainer of STAR FASHION, was advised the filly would be required to prove tractable and load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

GOODFUN GIRL (J. Holder) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

IN MASQUERADE (NZ) (L. Meech) raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

Approaching the 700 metres EVERY FAITH (S. Price) shifted out to improve and contacted ASCENDING NIMA (J. Kah), which was hampered and taken wider. S. Price was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

From in the vicinity of the 400 metres until inside the 300 metres FOREVER DISCREET (D. Tourneur) was held up for clear running when racing behind DISCO BELLE (J. Toeroek).

GOODFUN GIRL (J. Holder) was unable to obtain clear running shortly after the entrance to the straight when racing between the heels of SAGABELLA (T. Pannell) and SILVER PENNY (NZ) (R. Wheeler) and was only able to obtain clear running in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

OUR PARADIGM lost its near hind plate and FOREVER DISCREET lost its off fore plate during the event.

J. Toeroek, the rider of DISCO BELLE, reported the filly raced in a dour fashion.

FOREVER DISCREET was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Subsequent to the event STAR FASHION was again examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : MANIHI CLASSIC - 1050 metres

AGISTER (J. Bowditch) jumped away awkwardly.

ESPRIT DE BULLET (NZ) (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly and shortly after the start was tightened when racing in restricted room between AGISTER (J. Bowditch) and ANGELS BEACH (L. Meech).

ANGELS BEACH (L. Meech) was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until near the 200 metres when racing behind MIRACLES OF LIFE (L. Stojakovic) and inside COULDN'T AGREEMORE (D. Tourneur).

COULDN'T AGREEMORE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to the off fore pastern, with no further abnormalities.

AGISTER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Mr. L. Kennewell, the Trainer of AGISTER, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

RACE 8 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING HANDICAP - 1600 metres

Acting on confirmed advice from Mr. D. O'Leary, the Trainer of MAGICAL PEARL, that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg and unfit to race, Stewards withdrew MAGICAL PEARL at 11.40 am.

FAMILY PORTRAIT (S. Price) jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and tightened STEREOSONIC (NZ) (J. Bowditch) onto GAMBLIN' GURU (J. Holder).

STEREOSONIC (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
