ADDITIONAL STEWARDS' REPORT

MOUNT GAMBIER, THURSDAY, 15 MAY 2014

MOUNT GAMBIER - THURSDAY, 27 MARCH 2014

RACE 1 : SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1550 metres

Stewards concluded an inquiry adjourned on Thursday, 27 March 2014 into Kate Walters, the rider of SPARE ONE, being dislodged from her mount in the vicinity of the 900 metres where it appeared to clip the heels of MONICA'S MACHINE (D. Tourneur). After considering the evidence from both riders, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, it was established that MONICA'S MACHINE rolled out marginally as SPARE ONE commenced to improve to its outside resulting in SPARE ONE clipping the heels of MONICA'S MACHINE. As a consequence Kate Walters was dislodged. As Stewards could not be satisfied that any one rider was at fault, they took no action.

RACE 7 : AUSTRALIAN HOTELIERS ASSOCIATION SA RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Stewards concluded an inquiry adjourned on Thursday, 27 March 2014 into Amy Herrmann's riding of KIRVIC in this event. Stewards took evidence from Amy Herrmann, Mr L Creek, the Trainer of KIRVIC, and viewed the official footage. After doing so Amy Herrmann was found guilty of a charge under AR135(b) in that she failed to attempt a run to the outside of HE'LL TELL US (D. Tourneur) and to the inside of GAV'S GIFT (J. Potter) from the vicinity of the 250 metres until the vicinity of the 100 metres that in the opinion of Stewards was available to her and both reasonable and permissible for her to attempt thereby not giving KIRVIC a full opportunity to win or obtain the best possible place in the field. Amy Herrmann was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 25 May and to conclude at midnight on Wednesday, 25 June 2014; a period of one (1) month. In determining penalty, Stewards also considered betting records from this event, which showed no apparent abnormalities.
