RACE 1 : K BRERETON JEWELLERS / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

BONITA ICE (B. Claridge) shifted in on jumping away onto CUPSTER (R. Yetimova), which was taken in onto SHADOWS ABOVE (J. Toeroek), which was tightened onto TIPSY ON RED (T. Pannell) resulting in CUPSTER and SHADOWS ABOVE losing their positions.

BAY ROAD (S. Price) reared on jumping away and was slow into stride.

PERFECT GIVEAWAY (L. Hopwood) and IDATWO (A. Herrmann) were slow to begin.

LORD ASPEN (M. Neilson) laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight.

BONITA ICE (B. Claridge) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 300 metres. Inside the 200 metres BONITA ICE rolled in onto TIPSY ON RED (T. Pannell), which shifted out slightly resulting in BONITA ICE having its hindquarters turned out and becoming unbalanced.

RACE 2: KBL SECURITY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

MR ROSSELLINI (S. Carr) was slow to begin and shortly after was inconvenienced when tightened by MOMENT OF EXCESS (D. Dunn), which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres SOUVLAKI (S. Price) shifted in onto SHIP'S CAPTAIN (J. Bowditch), which had to be steadied. S. Price was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

CLARIFY (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

PALACE LYRIC (L. Hopwood) laid in under pressure over the concluding 500 metres. PALACE LYRIC was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Stewards questioned L. Hopwood, the rider of PALACE LYRIC, into her use of the whip in the straight. After doing so L. Hopwood pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that she used her whip in a forehand manner in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. She also pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

RACE 3 : ATKINS PHOTOGRPH / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

From the vicinity of the 1000 metres BELLOTTOS DAUGHTER (K. Brooks) commenced to hang out making contact with SHE IS RISQUE (D. Tourneur) and shifted out again near the 800 metres contacting the hindquarters of SHE IS RISQUE, unbalancing that filly.

ALL THE TIME (A. Herrmann) had difficulty obtaining clear ground when racing in restricted room between the 400 metres and the 300 metres.

CAVALOCE (J. Holder) laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres, shifted in onto CALL ME PENNY (T. O' Donnell) resulting in J. Holder having to stop riding and straighten his mount. CAVALOCE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

M. Neilson, the rider of SWEET DANISH, reported that in the vicinity of the 800 metres his horse was reluctant between other runners, got its head up and had to be eased.

Stewards questioned B. Claridge, the rider of MISS CHEEKY CHARLI into his use of the whip in the straight. After doing so B. Claridge pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100.

D. Tourneur, the rider of SHE IS RISQUE, which performed poorly, explained that the filly had travelled in its normal manner in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, failed to respond to his riding and he had become concerned with its action. SHE IS RISQUE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MISS CHEEKY CHARLI lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 4: ALL ACTION SPORTS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2204 metres

ALL GUNS BLAZING (R. Yetimova) shifted out on jumping away onto PIERREMONT ROCKS (J. Potter), which lost its position, when tightened onto BLEVIC LAD (J. Toeroek).

ELGIRANA (E. Boyd) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

KING'S DELIGHT (R. Mageean) raced greenly and was inclined to shift about in the straight, resulting in CALIGO (E. Finnegan) which was racing to the inside of that gelding, having difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres. KING'S DELIGHT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

ELGIRANA (E. Boyd) laid out under pressure in the straight, inconveniencing BLEVIC LAD (J. Toeroek), which was taken wider on the track. E. Boyd was reprimanded and advised in future she would be required to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight when they commence to shift ground in future.

BLEVIC LAD lost its near fore plate during the running of the event.

RACE 5 : MID NORTH PARTY HIRE / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

Mr B. Brook, the trainer of CHARLOTTE DANCES, advised Stewards that he would instruct jockey A. Herrmann to attempt to obtain a position mid-field with cover if possible, rather than on pace, as the filly had at its most recent starts.

RACE 5 : MID NORTH PARTY HIRE / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

YOU ARE SO FUNNY (NZ) (M. Neilson) and SWIFT ANGEL (J. Toeroek) were slow to begin.

SHEIK OF TWEAK (R. Stewart) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

JUST A BOB (K. Bishop) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RED PEPPER (J. Maund) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event, and in the vicinity of the 800 metres improved onto the heels of NEVER REVEN (J. Bowditch) and had to be checked.

At the entrance to the straight RED PEPPER (J. Maund) shifted out in an attempt to improve to the inside of CHARLOTTE DANCES (A. Herrmann), and in doing so brushed that filly for a short distance.

FIELLO (T. Pannell) had difficulty obtaining clear ground when awkwardly placed on the heels of EMCEECEE (D. Dunn), until approaching the 200 metres, when it shifted out brushing RED PEPPER (J. Maund), which was inconvenienced.

M. Neilson, the rider of YOU ARE SO FUNNY (NZ), which performed below expectations, explained that the gelding had raced greenly throughout the event and was reluctant to stretch out in the straight when placed under pressure. YOU ARE SO FUNNY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: AUSSIE RIPPER ROAST RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1050 metres

Acting on advice from Mr C. Oxlade, the trainer of GO NINNY GO, that the mare had an abscess on it's off fore hoof and would be unfit to race, Stewards ordered the withdrawal of that mare at 12.38 pm.

MISTLETOE (K. Brooks) was slow to begin.

HIGHLAND HENRY (S. Westover) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

At the entrance to the straight MASTER BLACK (J. Toeroek), shifted out and brushed HIGHLAND HENRY (S. Westover) for a short distance.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres FEAR THE FAITH (A. Herrmann) shifted out slightly onto SUTANOC (S. Carr), which became momentarily held up when awkwardly placed on the heels of MARION TYPE (J. Holder).

J. Holder, the rider of MARION TYPE, explained that the mare had raced comfortably in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 500 metres, had only responded for a short distance and he was disappointed in how MARION TYPE had finished off the event. MARION TYPE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: NEWMARKET INSURANCE BROKERS / EVRIGHT TROPHIES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

THE CONCORDE (J. Bowditch) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

FATHER TONY (D. Dunn) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages despite the efforts of its rider.

RACE 7: NEWMARKET INSURANCE BROKERS / EVRIGHT TROPHIES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1300 metres (Cont'd)

Inside the 600 metres COMSTRUM (S. Carr) shifted out slightly onto RESENDA (O. Ay), which was forced to check to avoid that filly's heels. S. Carr was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure she was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground.

RESENDA lost its near fore plate during the running of the event.

LATIN HERO, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: HYLAND RACE COLOURS RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

Mr G. Young, the Trainer of REACH OUT, was questioned regarding his failure to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the gelding as required by the Rules. As Stewards were able to confirm the identity of REACH OUT from records held by them and its microchip, the gelding was permitted to start. Mr Young was fined \$50 under AR59A.

Ms K. Mooney, the Trainer of BERNADI, was questioned regarding her failure to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the gelding as required by the Rules. As Stewards were able to confirm the identity of BERNADI from records held by them and its microchip, the gelding was permitted to start. Ms Mooney was fined \$50 under AR59A.

The start of this race was delayed approximately three minutes owing to the saddle on BOLD ZAMOUR (NZ) (T. Baker), having to be adjusted on arrival at the start and due to a minor adjustment to the bit on REACH OUT (S. Cahill). The start was further delayed due to JUST A SPARK (J. Frew) and KHAIBAR (A. Herrmann) proving difficult to load. Trainers Mr J. Hickmott and Mr K. Frew were advised that warnings had been placed on their runners in relation to their barrier manners.

KHAIBAR (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, inconveniencing DUNROSSIL (J. Maund).

SERENA (J. Potter) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

NEW CONCEPT (J. Holder) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event, resulting in MANGANESE (C. Forrest) improving onto that gelding's heels in the vicinity of the 1000 metres and having to be steadied, shifting out inconveniencing SERENA (J. Potter), which was taken wider on the track. As a consequence DERWENT (M. Neilson) and REACH OUT (S. Cahill), which were racing behind these runners, had to be steadied.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres FLASH MICK (K. Bishop) rolled in slightly onto JUST A SPARK (J. Frew), which was taken in, contacting the hindquarters of BERNADI (S. Price), which became unbalanced.

TIDY PROPHET (D. Tourneur) had difficulty obtaining clear ground after entering the straight, until the vicinity of the 100 metres.

S. Cahill, the rider of REACH OUT, reported that the gelding had hung out severely from the vicinity of the 800 metres, placing him at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event. REACH OUT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GENERAL:

RACE 6: AUSSIE RIPPER ROAST RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1050 metres

On Thursday, 19 June 2014 Mr A. Justice, the Trainer of HIGHLAND HENRY, advised Stewards the gelding is suffering from an upper respiratory infection. Mr Justice advised the gelding will go for a short spell.

RACE 2: IRISH RACE DAY 30TH AUGUST HANDICAP - 1000 metres

Mr J. Hyam, the trainer of STARLARA advised Stewards, following this race the gelding had a laceration to the off fore tendon which required treatment. Mr Hyam was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.
