RACE 1 : BALNAVES OF COONAWARRA / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER
MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres

LOCOMOTION LUCY (J. Darose) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto AGEAN SKY (M. Neve), which was tightened onto MOOKY MAN (J. Potter), which was taken out by TRANSFORMING (D. Tourneur).

MUMMAROSE (K. Walters) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MARANEKA (E. Finnegan), bumping that gelding and taking it out onto ATNAS (A. Herrmann).

MOOKY MAN (J. Potter) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres MARANEKA (E. Finnegan) became unbalanced for no apparent reason.

MUMMAROSE, which weakened from the vicinity of the 250 metres, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

TRANSFORMING, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : JOANNE'S EXPRESSO EXPRESS / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER
MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

BAHGALLAH BANTAM (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

On jumping away EUREKA HERO (P. Marks) and TAYLER'S DAISY (J. Potter) brushed.

WOOBINDA KEEP (J. Dertilis) raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

RACE 2 : JOANNE'S EXPRESSO EXPRESS / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 300 metres BAHGALLAH BANTAM (L. Hopwood) laid in across the heels of SPOT THE ENEMY (D. Tourneur) and in doing so had to be steadied. Shortly thereafter BAHGALLAH BANTAM became held up for clear running on the heels of SPOT THE ENEMY.

BAHGALLAH BANTAM (L. Hopwood) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. BAHGALLAH BANTAM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : BARRY MANEY FORD / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 metres

NOWORRYNOHURRY (R. Booth) jumped away awkwardly.

Rounding the home turn UNICAJA (NZ) (K. Walters) was momentarily held up for clear running when racing behind FRANKIE LIGHTFOOT (J. Darose).

RACE 4 : FINNS FINE FOODS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2100 metres

TORRIDON (S. Carr) raced ungenerously in the early stages of the event.

D. Tourneur, the rider of BONYKEAST, was questioned in relation to the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres. He pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$250.

M. Neilson, the rider of CARTHY ROAD, was questioned in relation to the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres. He pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

RACE 5 : KATNOOK ESTATE RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

In the vicinity of the 400 metres ABRAGAMOV (D. Tourneur) shifted out and as a result BOUNCING BEVERLEY (L. Hopwood) had to be steadied. As a consequence DASHING MISS (P. Marks), which was following, was obliged to be checked. D. Tourneur was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

From the entrance to the straight until the concluding stages STATUE OF GLORY (R. Booth) was held up for clear running when racing behind SANDHILL JETT (C. Forrest) and to the inside of JUST A CHAT (S. Carr) and in the vicinity of the 200 metres was obliged to check off the heels of SANDHILL JETT, which rolled out marginally at the same time as JUST A CHAT, which was racing to the outside, was taken in by ABRAGAMOV (D. Tourneur), which was inclined to lay in. D. Tourneur was reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground.

Over the concluding stages SANDHILL JETT (C. Forrest) was hampered as ABRAGAMOV (D. Tourneur) continued to lay in under pressure. D. Tourneur was reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground in future.

A. Herrmann, the rider of SPARTYPANTS, reported the gelding was inclined to hang out from the vicinity of the 800 metres. SPARTYPANTS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : COOPERS BREWERY RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

Acting on confirmed advice from Mr. D. Kolpin, the Trainer of BILLY THE BRAT, that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg and unfit to race, Stewards withdrew BILLY THE BRAT at 8.24 am.

KIORA (M. Neilson) and CAPTAIN SHARP (NZ) (S. Carr) were slow to begin.

BACK ON TRACK (C. Forrest) raced wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7 : PINKERTON, PALM, HAMLYN & STEEN RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

Stewards acceded to a request from Mr. Aaron Peterson, representing Mr. Allan Peterson, the Trainer of CONSCRIBE (NZ), to scratch the gelding due to the track downgrade. CONSCRIBE (NZ) was withdrawn at 3.06 pm.

GO GIRLFRIEND (R. Booth) was slow to begin.

BRINKLEY BULLET (J. Potter) was marginally slow to begin.

MR DOUGHBOY (E. Finnegan) jumped away awkwardly.

SHE BE SMOKIN' (D. Dunn) over-raced in the early stages of the event.

ON THE REBOUND (A. Herrmann) over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

Over the concluding stages D. Tourneur, the rider of SHARBO (NZ), was unable to ride the gelding out when racing on the heels of ON THE REBOUND (A. Herrmann).

E. Finnegan, the rider of MR DOUGHBOY, reported her mount did not feel comfortable in its action when placed under pressure in the straight. MR DOUGHBOY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

M. Neilson, the rider of MACHIAVELLI, explained his mount travelled well throughout but when placed under pressure, failed to respond to his riding. Mr. L. Theodore, representing Mr. S. Theodore, the Trainer of the gelding, undertook to report any abnormalities on return to the stable. MACHIAVELLI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
