RACE 1 : GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2122 metres

URANIA BELLE (T. O'Donnell) jumped away awkwardly.

Shortly after the start URANIA BELLE (T. O'Donnell) commenced to race fiercely and in doing so, shifted out and as a result WHINCUP (NZ) (J. Toeroek) was obliged to be checked. Thereafter URANIA BELLE over-raced for some distance.

RACE 2 : THE TERRACE TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1711 metres

BELLOTTOS DAUGHTER (K. Brooks) was slow to begin.

WHERE'S PINO (J. Frew) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MISS INSTINCTIVE (S. Carr) was inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight and approaching the 50 metres rolled out inconveniencing TRESPASSER (J. Holder).

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Holder, the rider of second placegetter TRESPASSER and Mr D. Jolly, the gelding's trainer, to view the official footage in the straight.

WHERE'S PINO, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

BELLOTTOS DAUGHTER, which was reluctant to race in the early and middle stages of the event, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : SANDERS BROS / MITAVITE / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1111 metres

RIGHT AND READY (R. Mageean) was slow to begin.

CHARLIE'S PRINCESS (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting MAPPINGA LAD (A. Herrmann).

MAPPINGA LAD (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

TRIPLESS, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : GAWLER TAXIS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1211 metres

PROMISES (J. Maund) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto COPPER COAST RAIDA (M. Neilson) taking that gelding out onto HAPPY LANE (J. Bowditch), which was taken out contacting FIGURE THIS (A. Herrmann).

JUICY FRUIT (D. Tourneur) was slow into stride.

JUICY FRUIT (D. Tourneur) was held up from the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 200 metres when racing on the heels of PROMISES (J. Maund) and to the inside of HAPPY LANE (J. Bowditch).

FREE FALL (J. Toeroek) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

FIGURE THIS lost its near fore plate during the event.

HOYLAKE (NZ), which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 5 : JACOBS CREEK RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2122 metres

ISAIAH (J. Bowditch) was slow to begin.

CALIBRIUM (J. Potter) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

TARGET EXPLORER (T. Zanker) over-raced throughout the event.

Inside the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight POWER TO POSSESS (A. Herrmann) became held up for clear running when racing behind BARRIERS (J. Maund) and to the inside of REACH OUT (J. Holder).

ISAIAH, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CALIBRIUM, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : COOPERS BREWERY RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1711 metres

STURGIS (NZ) (S. Price) was slow to begin.

KOOKABURRAS (T. Zanker) raced wide without cover and had a tendency to over-race throughout the event.

JUST A SPARK lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 7 : SPORTSBET.COM.AU FIXED ODDS CLASS ONE HANDICAP- 1111 metres

MOLLY THE SNIP (A. Herrmann) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, bumping RHINESTONE RUBY (J. Holder). As a result MOLLY THE SNIP shifted in, contacting WILD RUN (S. Westover).

In the vicinity of the 900 metres WAPPING (S. Price) shifted in and away from MERMAID RUN (K. Brooks) making contact with I GOT A TURBO (M. Neilson) resulting in WAPPING's hindquarters being turned.

MERMAID RUN (K. Brooks) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres WAPPING (S. Price) shifted out and away from MOLLY THE SNIP (A. Herrmann) brushing RHINESTONE RUBY (J. Holder).

HAPPY SYMBOL, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SMART JESTER, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SUPER ESRA, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr D. Halliday, the trainer of SUPER ESRA, was advised a warning had placed on the filly in relation to its competitiveness in this event.

RACE 8 : KINGSFORD HOTEL COLTS, GELDINGS AND ENTIRES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP- 1211 metres

IRISH CHEER (J. Matthews) was slow to begin.

COLLA VOCE (C. Forrest) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto PIERREMONT (S. Cahill) which was taken in onto FEAR THE FAITH (A. Herrmann), which bumped SPOILSPOT (D. Tourneur).

In the vicinity of the 900 metres IRISH CHEER (J. Matthews) rolled out and away from PIERREMONT (S. Cahill) and in doing so, was taken out onto DO TELLE (NZ) (K. Bishop), which was tightened onto ATHLETICISM (J. Holder), which had a tendency to lay in, turning that gelding's hindquarters, resulting in ATHLETICISM shifting back in, obliging DO TELLE (NZ) to be checked.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres SPOILSPOT (D. Tourneur) was inclined to over-race and improved onto the heels of COLLA VOCE (C. Forrest).

J. Maund, the rider of SNAZZY RAY, was questioned in relation to the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres. J. Maund pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$150.

SUTANOC lost its near hind plate during the event.

HOSTABLE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

FEAR THE FAITH, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9 : JARVIS ISUZU CLASS 2 HANDICAP- 1511 metres

LADY LUSH (T. O'Donnell) was slow into stride.

LADY SILHOUETTE (S. Price) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and as a consequence STONEHAVEN (W. Kerford), which was following, was awkwardly placed on the heels of that filly for several strides.

Approach the 400 metres J. Frew, the rider of QUINN'S TURN accidentally dropped his whip. J. Frew was reprimanded for carelessness in dropping his whip.
