RACE 1 : CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP WEDNESDAY 15 OCTOBER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

PTOLEMY (J. Bowditch) shifted out on jumping away, contacting MOMENT OF EXCESS (D. Dunn) unbalancing that rider.

MOMENT OF EXCESS (D. Dunn) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROCKY DIAMOND (A. Doyle) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MISS TORY (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

GREEK PLAYBOY, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate. Mr A. Kallus, the Trainer of GREEK PLAYBOY, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to being competitive.

RACE 2 : CARLTON DRAUGHT / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

WALKA COUNTRY MILE (J. Matthews) jumped away awkwardly.

CLARIFY (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.

Approaching the 600 metres DEVIL'S CHANCE (J. Frew) improved onto the heels of SCATHACH (B. Claridge) and had to be steadied.

CLARIFY (A. Herrmann) raced greenly in the straight.

FLAME QUEEN lost its near hind plate during the running of the event.

THARP TIME, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : BRONTE WINCHESTER MEMORIAL / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

CUPSTER (R. Yetimova) shifted in on jumping away and inconvenienced ROSES FOR SENORITA (W. Kerford).

On jumping away HAPPY LANE (R. Mageean) shifted out slightly onto ALL THE TIME (A. Herrmann), which was forced to steady when tightened onto LAKE BELLA (S. Price), which had been taken in by EMAIL (J. Kah).

CUPSTER (R. Yetimova) raced greenly throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 700 metres shifted in and away from INTOSSICARE (J. Matthews), onto PROMISES (J. Toeroek), which clipped that filly's heels and dipped. As a consequences ROSES FOR SENORITA (W. Kerford), which was racing behind PROMISES, had to be steadied.

HAPPY LANE (R. Mageean) was held up from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 300 metres, when racing behind SWEET DANISH (D. Tourneur) and inside INTOSSICARE (J. Matthews).

In the vicinity of the 300 metres CUPSTER (R. Yetimova) shifted out onto SWEET DANISH (D. Tourneur), which had to be steadied when tightened onto INTOSSICARE (J. Matthews).

CUPSTER (R. Yetimova) continued to shift out and approaching the 200 metres INTOSSICARE (J. Matthews) had to be steadied when tightened onto RED PEPPER (J. Maund). R. Yetimova was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground. RED PEPPER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

D. Tourneur, the rider of SWEET DANISH, reported that after receiving pressure in the vicinity of the 300 metres, that filly was reluctant to race and inclined to lay out over the concluding stages. SWEET DANISH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: GRANDISONS.COM.AU RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 900 metres

GOOD CONDUCT lost its near side winker on jumping away.

On jumping away GOOD CONDUCT (B. Claridge) shifted out onto WRITE NO MORE (J. Frew), which was taken out tightening KOODA DAWN (A. Herrmann) onto DAUNTING DANCER (E. Boyd), which had been taken in by SCENIC LAKE (T. Pannell), which was tightened on jumping away by DON ROBERTO (J. Maund), which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in, resulting in KOODA DAWN (A. Herrmann) stumbling and losing its position and WRITE NO MORE (J. Frew) becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of GOOD CONDUCT (B. Claridge), which continued to shift out.

DON ROBERTO (J. Maund) hung out from the vicinity of the 600 metres and made the home turn wide on the track, resulting in J. Maund having to stop riding and straighten on a number of occasions in the straight. DON ROBERTO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported an elevated heart rate.

RACE 5 : MARCHSPREADERSALES.COM.AU RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2200 metres

FRANKENFURTER (GB) (K. Bishop) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

From the vicinity of the 600 metres and until near the 400 metres KING CADEL (J. Toeroek) was held up when racing on the heels of SIR ANTHONY (M. Neilson) and inside FRANKENFURTER (GB) (K. Bishop).

RACE 5 : MARCHSPREADERSALES.COM.AU RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2200 metres (Cont'd)

CALIGO (R. Mageean) became held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres when awkwardly placed between the heels of SIR ANTHONY (M. Neilson) and TARGET EXPLORER (T. Zanker) and approaching the 200 metres, clipped the heels of SIR ANTHONY, lost ground and was able to ease around that gelding.

Over the concluding 200 metres FRANKENFURTER (GB) (K. Bishop) shifted out under riding and inside the 100 metres, inconvenienced ISAIAH (S. Price) and BEST OF MINX (L. Hopwood). K. Bishop was advised in future to stop riding and straighten her mount when they commence to shift ground.

- T. Zanker, the rider of TARGET EXPLORER, reported that the gelding was inclined to lay out throughout the event.
- M. Nielson, the rider of SIR ANTHONY, explained that due to the pace of the race in the middle stages, and due to his knowledge of the gelding in that it only has a short sprint, he elected to push forward and sit to the outside of TARGET EXPLORER (T. Zanker) to enable the gelding to have the best chance of finishing the event off strongly. SIR ANTHONY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
- R. Mageean, the rider of CALIGO, explained that from the vicinity of the 500 metres, he had become awkwardly placed to the inside of the heels of SIR ANTHONY (M. Neilson) and was unable to ease to the outside of that gelding safely and for this reason had elected to ride for luck and hope that a run eventuated between SIR ANTHONY and TARGET EXPLORER (T. Zanker). He added that at no stage he was able to restrain his mount sufficiently to ease to the outside of SIR ANTHONY until approaching the 200 metres when both runners shifted slightly and he clipped the heels of SIR ANTHONY, lost ground and was able shift safely to the outside of that gelding.

TARGET EXPLORER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: FARM FRESH MARKET BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

On leaving the 1400 metres chute, prior to joining the course proper, CALIFORNIA KING (O. Ay) shifted in taking SHADE OF GREEN (D. Tourneur) inside the line of the course proper running rail, resulting in CALIFORNIA KING shifting out abruptly to give that mare room, onto AFRISKY BUSINESS (T. Zanker), which was forced to steady when taken out onto the heels of PORTICI (R. Stewart).

From the vicinity of the 700 metres BIG LUKA (J. Maund) became awkwardly placed on the heels of AFRISKY BUSINESS (T. Zanker), which was inclined to roll about and was forced to steady on a number of occasions, until approaching the 300 metres.

RACE 7: MKSL ENTERPRISES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

OUR BELVOIR (J. Kah) jumped away awkwardly.

CREON (D. Tootell) made the turn in the vicinity of the 900 metres awkwardly and shifted out onto the heels of RED DAZZLE (J. Maund) and had to be steadied.

ON THE REBOUND (S. Cahill) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 7: MKSL ENTERPRISES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

In the vicinity of the 300 metres CALL ME PENNY (T. O'Donnell) shifted to the outside of THE CONCORDE (J. Bowditch) to improve and in doing so, brushed LADY PHOENIX (K. Bishop), which was taken out into the running line of MADEMOISELLE DENON (J. Potter), which was obliged to alter course back to that mare's inside. T. O' Donnell was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

Correct Weight was delayed to allow J. Potter, the rider of the third placegetter, MADEMOISELLE DENON, to view the official footage in the straight.

S. Cahill, the rider of ON THE REBOUND, which performed below expectations, explained that although caught wide during the event, the gelding had travelled comfortably, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, had failed to respond to his riding and had finished the event off poorly. He added that in his opinion may have held its breath during the run as it made excess respiratory noise when pulling up. As ON THE REBOUND had left the course prior to being examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon, Trainer Mr I. Walker, was instructed to advise Stewards of any abnormalities on return to her stables.

RED DAZZLE, which performed expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

FLIRTATIOUS DREAM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported soreness over the back region. First Aid was administered. Trainer, Mr P. Stokes was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

RACE 8 : SAMBEC SHEDS RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

IRISH CHEER (J. Matthews) jumped away awkwardly.

LATIN HERO (S. Westover) shifted in on jumping away inconveniencing MR LAMBORGHINI (D. Tootell).

DOTTY KAY (J. Toeroek) was slow to begin.

Approaching the 1200 metres SCARPELEENO (D. Dunn) shifted inside the line of the course proper on leaving the chute and had to be checked to avoid making contact with the course proper running rail.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres EXALTED JOURNEY (D. Tourneur) commenced to race keenly when awkwardly placed on the heels of STACK THE TRUCK (R. Stewart) and in being steadied, shifted out inconveniencing SERENA (J. Potter), which was taken wider on the track.

BRINKLEY BLISS (J. Frew) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

- J. Potter, the rider of SERENA, which performed below expectations, explained that after receiving pressure in the vicinity of the 1000 metres, the mare was reluctant to race despite his efforts and finished the event off poorly. He added that the mare, in his opinion, would appreciate a race over a longer journey. As SERENA had left the course prior to being examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon, Trainer Ms S. Kotz, was instructed to advise Stewards of any abnormalities on return to her stables.
- S. Westover, the rider of LATIN HERO, was questioned regarding the use of his whip in the straight. After doing so S. Westover pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

RACE 8: SAMBEC SHEDS RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

T. Baker, the rider of SHADY JADE, which commenced to weaken from the vicinity of the 600 metres, explained that the mare had raced like a tired horse and that in his opinion had come to the end of its preparation. SHADY JADE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr T. Doudle, Trainer of SHADY JADE, advised Stewards that the mare would now be spelled.
