Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 30 August 2014

RACE 1: THE BANNER CREW HANDICAP - 2000 metres

SPANISH HALO (NZ) (C. Lindop) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1700 metres SPANISH HALO (NZ) (C. Lindop) got its head up and raced ungenerously for a number of strides when being restrained, shifted in and hampered LITTLE AKIE (S. Price).

BELGIETTO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SPANISH HALO (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : IRISH STEEPLE BROUGHT TO YOU BY "SHINZIG" (AUS v IRE) - 3500 metres (Run on Morphettville Parks Track)

RED EYE SPECIAL (NZ) (B. Cawley) jumped the steeple in the vicinity of the 700 metres on the first occasion very awkwardly.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres, after negotiating the steeple near the 700 metres, RED EYE SPECIAL (NZ) (B. Cawley) commenced to lay out.

MALDIVES (P. Gallagher) contacted the second of the double in the straight on the final occasion, fell and dislodged P. Gallagher. P. Gallagher was examined by the First Care medical personnel and declared fit to fulfil his remaining engagement.

MALDIVES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

REDEVELOP (K. Sexton) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the horse to be lame in the near fore leg with a suspensory ligament strain. First aid was administered. Mrs F. Houlahan and Mr B. Johnston, the co-trainers of the horse, were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required before this horse's next trial or race start.

RACE 2: IRISH STEEPLE BROUGHT TO YOU BY "SHINZIG" (AUS v IRE) - 3500 metres (Run on Morphettville Parks Track) (Cont')

RED EYE SPECIAL (NZ), KING TRITON, GROENENBOOM and SWNEY'S BANJO (NZ) were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: SPORTINGBET HANDICAP - 1500 metres

SUBMARINE (C. Lindop) and MOLTO VIVACE (L. Stojakovic) contacted at the start.

STROBES (J. Matthews) began awkwardly.

Approaching the 200 metres STROBES (J. Matthews) was obliged to alter course to the outside of EQDAAM (J. Hill) as that horse rolled in. Thereafter STROBES laid in for the remainder of the event and between the 200 metres and the 100 metres shifted out when being corrected.

- L. Stojakovic, the rider of MOLTO VIVACE, reported that she had no luck in the early part of the event and was obliged to race wide and settle further back than intended. She added the filly laid out during the event. MOLTO VIVACE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
- J. Toeroek, the rider of DEIHEROS, explained his instructions were to lead in this event but added that when EQDAAM (J. Hill) applied pressure to his outside in the early stages he elected to allow this horse to lead. He added that from in the vicinity of the 600 metres the gelding was under pressure, never travelled, was disappointing in its performance and did not finish the race off in its usual manner. DEIHEROS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a poor post-race recovery with injected oral mucus membranes.
- B. Claridge, the rider of RAINBOW ROOM, explained his mount was reluctant between runners in the early stages of the event, was off the bridle from the vicinity of the 800 metres, raced in a flat manner and was disappointing. RAINBOW BOOM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
- J. Toeroek, the rider of DEIHEROS, was questioned regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres. J. Toeroek pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) for using his whip in a forehand manner on more than the permitted times prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

STROBES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: IRISH DAY HURDLE BROUGHT TO YOU BY "SHINZIG" (AUS v IRE) - 3200 metres

COMPELLED (NZ) (M. Kelly) became held up for clear running for a short distance inside the 500 metres.

TAKE OUT (N. O'Shea), which weakened from inside the 1000 metres, was eased out of the event by its rider in the vicinity of the 400 metres and did not jump the final two hurdles in the straight. TAKE OUT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

DOWNES (NZ) (B. Cawley) landed awkwardly after jumping the first of the double in the straight on the final occasion.

RACE 5: PETER ELBERG FUNERALS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

WAADOO (A. Herrmann) shifted out at the start and contacted CASHED (A. Patterson).

JESSE 'N' JAMES (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly.

RAINBOW REFLECTION (C. Forrest) and DAKASHA'S PRIDE (M. Vance) were slow to begin.

Approaching the 800 metres TORI'S GIFT (J. Holder) became ungenerous, got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance and shifted out inconveniencing HEIDI STAR (S. Price), which was taken wider.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres MOONIES CHOICE (R. Stewart), which was inclined to lay in, shifted in and inconvenienced ULTRA VIRES (L. Hopwood), which was obliged to be steadied. As a consequence, ULTRA VIRES shifted in and tightened JESSE 'N' JAMES (J. Toeroek) for a number of strides.

JESSE 'N' JAMES (J. Toeroek) which was initially held up for clear running behind MOONIES CHOICE (R. Stewart) and WAADOO (A. Herrmann) from in the vicinity of the 400 metres was only able to obtain clear running over the concluding stages and as a consequence was untested to the line.

RACE 6: SYD MCDONALD'S 90TH HANDICAP - 1100 metres

HIGH VALUE, which had not raced since August 2013, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon after arrival on course and passed fit to race.

Mr. J. Macmillan the trainer of DAUNTING DANCER advised Stewards prior to the event he would instruct his rider to be positive in the early stages and attempt to obtain a forward position in running.

KOODA DAWN, which was kicked by another runner after arrival at the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race.

OUR MISS BOSSY (A. Patterson) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted the hind quarters of OUR BELVOIR (J. Kah) and as a consequence was slow to begin.

MAGLISSA (C. Lindop) pulled hard in the early stages.

AZZCOOL (K. Cross) became held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 300 metres when racing behind KOODA DAWN (K. Bishop) and DAZZLING LILLY (T. Baker) and thereafter was unable to gain clear ground from inside the 300 metres until near the 100 metres when held up behind DAZZLING LILLY (T. Baker), which rolled out, and to the inside of MAGLISSA (C. Lindop).

E. Boyd, the rider of DAUNTING DANCER, reported her saddle slipped back in running.

OUR MISS BOSSY, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

OUR BELVOIR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: AFTER PARTY AT THE HIGHWAY HOTEL HANDICAP - 1200 metres

EMMOOKI'S DASH (L. Hopwood) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

LIGHT IT UP was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: MAC JUST OVER? DON'T DRIVE HANDICAP - 1600 metres

UMALUKA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon after arrival on course at the request of its trainer Mr K. Buick. UMALUKA was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards at 3.18 pm acting on veterinary advice that the horse had injured its head in the float en route to the course. First Aid was administered.

CHONDRA (A. Herrmann) pulled hard in the early stages and brushed the running rail in the vicinity of the 700 metres.

IRISH HIGH KING (A. Patterson) was held up for clear running for a number of strides in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

SNIP 'N' RUN, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. MOST HUSBANDS and CHONDRA were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

GENERAL:

16 riders were breathalysed prior to taking their first ride and all tests returned negative.
