STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 20 September 2014

WEATHER: Fine

RAIL: Out 3 metres from 1200 metres to 500 metres. True remainder. Sectional 602 metres.

RACE 1 : GUY SEBASTIAN AT MORPHETTVILLE 4/11 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

Approaching the 1200 metres REMORSE (T. Pannell) commenced to race keenly, shifted out and contacted LIFE'S A BUTTERFLY (C. Lindop), which was taken wider.

NISOS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

HIOCTDANE lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 2 : MAC JUST OVER? DON'T DRIVE HANDICAP - 1600 metres

PELEKUNU VALLEY (NZ) had to be re-saddled on arrival at the barriers.

GOLDBYA (D. Dunn) pulled hard in the early and middle stages of the event.

PELEKUNU VALLEY (NZ) (R. Hurdle) became held up for clear running at the entrance to the straight when racing behind LATE NIGHT DRINK (R. Bayliss) and to the inside of UMALUKA (L. Hopwood) and shortly thereafter near the 300 metres, when improving to the inside of UMALUKA, rolled out and contacted the hindquarters of UMALUKA, inconveniencing that gelding.

PELEKUNU VALLEY (NZ) (R. Hurdle) was inclined to lay out over the concluding stages and when being corrected, got its head up and was ungenerous for a number of strides.

D. Dunn, the rider of GOLDBYA, explained that whilst he was comfortable with his position in the early stages, the gelding raced very keenly in the early and middle stages and failed to finish the race off and was disappointing. GOLDBYA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr M. Huxtable, the Trainer of GOLDBYA was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

RACE 3 : ENDEAVOUR HOMES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

SHA LA LA (B. Claridge) was slow to begin.

QUASAR (D.Dunn) jumped away very awkwardly and shifted out abruptly shortly after the start.

SAPPHIRE ZOOM (R. Hurdle) and BLACK CAESAR (M. Vance) contacted shortly after the start.

Inside the 900 metres HUSSON'S SHOUT (D. Tourneur), after initially shifting in, commenced to lay in and tightened NEVER POINTLESS (E. Boyd) for some distance thereafter resulting in NEVER POINTLESS being inconvenienced and having to be steadied. D. Tourneur was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

MARTINE (R. Stewart) raced greenly during the event.

Inside the 400 metres HUSSON'S SHOUT (D. Tourneur) shifted out to improve and tightened RIKISHI (J. Holder), which had to be steadied. D. Tourneur was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

D. Tourneur, the rider of HUSSON'S SHOUT, explained the gelding raced very greenly throughout the event and in his opinion may be better suited to racing over more ground. HUSSON'S SHOUT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : GREG OATES MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1200 metres

SANDHILL WARRIOR (J. Kah) was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 metres when racing behind HEART OF A LION (R. Bayliss) and to the inside of DEBEERSONUS (R. Hurdle) and was only able to obtain clear running inside the 200 metres.

DEBEERSONUS sprung its near hind plate during the running of the event.

EXALTED MOMENT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : JAMES BOAG'S PREMIUM HANDICAP - 1100 metres

DANGER MOUSE (P. Denton) was slow to begin.

Inside the 800 metres AZZCOOL (J. Toeroek) shifted in at the same time as DISAGREE (J. Kah) shifted out, resulting in these horses making contact for several strides and the hindquarters of DISAGREE being turned. As a consequence DISAGREE laid back out onto AZZCOOL, resulting in both horses becoming unbalanced and AZZCOOL being taken wider.

RAKS MCLAREN (J. Holder) laid in, in the straight and had to be steadied off the heels of FLYIN' FOR ME (D. Tourneur) in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

DANGER MOUSE, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RAKS MCLAREN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : PENANG TROPHY (REGISTERES AS TOKYO CITY CUP) - 1800 metres

DETOX (T. Pannell) was slow to begin.

Near the 1500 metres EVANGELIST (GB) (J. Holder) shifted in and tightened RIALYA (M. Neilson) for a short distance. J. Holder was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

In the vicinity of the 700 meters ST GABRIEL (J. Potter) shifted out to improve and brushed COUNT OF LIMONADE (IRE) (J. Mott), which attempted to maintain its position. As a consequence these horses made contact for a short distance thereafter.

A. Herrmann, the rider of AMALGAMATE, reported her mare was a bit slow into stride resulting in her settling further back than intended. She added the mare was disappointing in its performance.

DETOX was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : SPORTINGBET W H WYLIE HANDICAP - 1100 metres

BRILLIANT BISC (R. Bayliss) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and tightened AREGEE MCLAREN (R. Stewart) onto WHITLAM (B. Claridge), which was taken out onto the heels of PLANET VOYAGE (J. Kah), resulting in WHITLAM BEING unable to maintain its position.

Racing to the 700 metres AREGEE MCLAREN (R. Stewart) commenced to race very keenly and became awkwardly placed on the heels of ICONIC (D. Tourneur), which was racing keenly, resulting in AREGEE MCLAREN shifting out contacting ESPRIT DE BULLET (NZ) (J. Holder), which was taken wider.

LIGHT IT UP (A. Patterson) was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 meters until the finish and was untested to the line.

At the entrance to the straight BRILLIANT BISC (R. Bayliss) initially shifted out, contacted the hindquarters of RIZIZ (S. Cahill) and thereafter shifted in to obtain clear running and in the vicinity of the 300 metres, as ACHENAR (E. Boyd) rolled in slightly, BRILLIANT BISC shifted out to improve and again contacted RIZIZ, which was taken out into the running of ESSAY RAIDER (C. Lindop), which was obliged to be checked. R. Bayliss was severely reprimanded and advised to only shift ground when entitled to do so.

RIZIZ was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : FARMERS UNION ICED COFFEE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

BOLD SENATOR (D. Dunn) raced keenly for a short distance in the vicinity of the 800 metres and became awkward on the heels of runners.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres TENNESSEE GROOM (NZ) (J. Holder) rolled in resulting in WRITE NO MORE (S. Price) being obliged to alter course to the outside of that gelding.

EFFCEE (R. Hurdle) had difficulty obtaining clear ground from in the vicinity of the 300 metres until near the 200 metres, when racing behind WHO YOU KNOW (T. Baker) as that horse shifted ground.

RACE 8 : FARMERS UNION ICED COFFEE HANDICAP - 1200 metres (cont'd)

D. Tourneur, the rider of ELECTRIC PUSSYCAT, reported the mare raced greenly throughout the event, was field shy and was inclined to lay out away from runners.
