Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse

RACE 1 : M & M TREE & EARTH REMOVAL / SABOIS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

SHOP FRAAR'N WIDE, which was kicked by another runner in the mounting yard and was examined on arrival at the barriers by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race.

LEWIS STREET, which struck a perimeter fence on leaving the mounting yard was examined on arrival at the start by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to race.

STRAVINSKA (K. Brooks) reared on jumping away and was slow into stride.

On jumping away LEWIS STREET (E. Boyd) shifted in onto LITTLE MISS MEXICO (A. Patterson), which was taken in onto BLACK DANCER (T. O' Donnell), which was tightened onto PACIFIC JOURNEY (L. Hopwood), which lost its position when tightened onto GEORDIE'S LASS (M. Nielson), which had been taken out by CAPTAIN PEDRILLE (D. Tourneur).

STRAVINSKA (K. Brooks) jumped a section of the track in the vicinity of the 800 metres and became unbalanced.

LITTLE MISS MEXICO (A. Patterson) laid out rounding the home turn and was inclined to lay in under pressure over the concluding 200 metres.

SHOP FRAAR'N WIDE (R. Bell) laid in under pressure in the straight.

Stewards questioned R. Bell, the rider of SHOP FRAAR'N WIDE, into his riding of this gelding over the concluding 100 metres, who explained the gelding was laying in severely and he was concerned with the heels of LEWIS STREET (E. Boyd), which was racing to his inside. After considering his explanations, R. Bell was reminded of his obligations in relation to riding his mounts out to the finish in accordance with AR137(b).

RACE 2 : TOWN & RURAL FENCING SERVICES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to maintenance work taking place on the track in the vicinity of the 800 metres.

RACE 2 : TOWN & RURAL FENCING SERVICES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

BREAKING BAD (K. Bishop) shifted out on jumping away and contacted AL MU'TAZZ (A. Doyle).

ACE OF SPADES (J. Potter) shifted out on jumping away contacting WAADOO (M. Vance), which was inconvenienced when taken out onto ABALONE WARS (D. Tourneur), which shifted in slightly.

ACE OF SPADES (J. Potter) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres WHITE JADE (M. Neislon) improved onto the heels of ABALONE WARS (D. Tourneur) as WHEN LOVE IS GONE (T. Baker) improved to its outside, resulting in WHITE JADE becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ABALONE WARS and having to be steadied.

ARTFUL MONTY (L. Hopwood) laid in throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted in onto NIPEX (R. Bell), which had to be steadied. Shortly after ARTFUL MONTY rolled back in, resulting in NIPEX being forced to race in restricted room for the remainder of the event. ARTFUL MONTY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding required attention.

ACE OF SPADES (J. Potter) laid in under pressure over the final 200 metres. ACE OF SPADES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : OCTOBER 5TH LONG WEEKEND RACE DAY CG&E RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to HE'LL TELL US, becoming fractious in its barrier stall after being loaded. HE'LL TELL US was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race.

CHLOBOROUGH (K. Bishop) was slow to begin and shortly after inconvenienced by THE JUDDERNAUT (A. Doyle), which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

HEIDENBERG (T. Pannell) raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

THE JUDDERNAUT (A. Doyle) dipped on a number of occasions in the vicinity of the 600 metres for no apparent reason.

BRAWNY HUNTER (D. Tootell), THE JUDDERNAUT (A. Doyle) and CHLOBOROUGH (K. Bishop) all had difficulty obtaining clear ground over the concluding stages.

HE'LL TELL US, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : GLOBAL BARRIER SYSTEMS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

PROPSHAFT (J. Potter) shifted in on jumping away and contacted MEADOWS STORM (T. O' Donnell).

HEY BIG BENDER (D. Tourneur) was slow to begin.

RACE 4 : GLOBAL BARRIER SYSTEMS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1390 metres (Cont'd)

Inside the 1300 metres ARTHURIAN LEGEND (J. Kah) shifted in onto TRESETTE (E. Boyd), which was taken in onto PROPSHAFT (J. Potter), which was obliged to ease and alter course to the outside of that gelding. J. Kah was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

MEADOWS STORM (T. O' Donnell) improved into a tight run to the inside of VALIK (A. Patterson) in the vicinity of the 200 metres and then raced in restricted room for the remainder of the event. T. O' Donnell was advised in future to ensure that there was sufficient room prior to attempting runs.

RACE 5 : CITY MOTORS PORT LINCOLN / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately one minute owing to RUBY JUBES proving difficult to load. Ms A. Cornell, the Trainer of RUBY JUBES was advised a warning had been placed on this mare in relation to its barrier manners.

At the entrance to the straight IMPERIAL FURY (R. Mageean) shifted out onto EASY MISS (T. O' Donnell), which was inconvenienced when taken out onto KOODA DUCHESS (K. Bishop).

M. Neilson, the rider of LADY PHOENIX, explained the mare was reluctant to stretch in the early and middle stages despite his efforts and became awkward in its actions in the vicinity of the 600 metres and for this reason he had not persisted with riding out in his normal manner for the remainder of the event. LADY PHOENIX was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare had a lower than expected heart rate. Mr J. Dunn, the Trainer of LADY PHOENIX, was advised the mare would be required to perform competitively in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

RACE 6 : DK QUARRIES BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

EXTRACEED (T. O' Donnell) was slow to begin.

PERIDUKI (A. Doyle) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

R. Mageean, the rider of ACHENAR, accidentally dropped his whip in the vicinity of the 200 metres. R. Mageean was reprimanded and advised that future carelessness may result in a penalty being imposed.

Over the concluding stages BLACK BARRA (E. Boyd) shifted in under riding onto EXTRACEED (T. O' Donnell), which was forced to take hold when taken in onto GET PRONTO (K. Bishop), which had to be steadied when tightened onto ACHENAR (R. Mageean), which rolled out. Shortly after the hindquarters of ACHENAR were turned in, resulting in that horse shifting out, placing GET PRONTO and EXTRACEED at a further disadvantage. E. Boyd was severely reprimanded and advised in future that she would be required to stop riding and straighten her mounts when they commence to shift ground.

M. Neilson, the rider of ROLL ON BAI, explained the gelding had not travelled during the event and when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres had failed to respond to his riding and in his opinion had finished the event off poorly. ROLL ON BAI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : WALLER BUILDING SOLUTIONS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

MILD MANNERED (D. Tootell) was slow to begin.

Approaching the 1000 metres STRATHISLA (M. Neilson) shifted in and became awkwardly placed on the heels of MONEYBALL (J. Kah) and had to be steadied.

HERO TO VILLIAN (A. Patterson) was reluctant when attempting a tight run to the inside of MONEYBALL (J. Kah)
