RACE 1 : JAMESTOWN CONCRETE / CLARE VALLEY RACING CLUB / JOINER'S ARMS HOTEL / KERIN LANDMARK RURAL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

KING RODNEY (C. Forrest) shifted out on jumping away and bumped CHARLIE'S PRINCESS (K. Brooks).

SHE'S ON FIRE (R. Bell) shifted out on jumping away and bumped DATS A LASS (T. Zanker).

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Brooks, the rider of the second placegetter CHARLIES'S PRINCESS, to view the official photo for first.

RACE 2: MT REMARKABLE HOTEL / CALTOWIE CRANE HIRE & CALTOWIE SHEDS / RYNNES HARDWARE & SPORTS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

BIAN BRAVE (C. Forrest) jumped away awkwardly.

SPINNING CROWN (T. Zanker) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

Approaching the 200 metres MAGIC MESSIAH (B. Hoppo), which was inclined to lay in, had to be steadied to avoid the heels of ALWAYS ABOUT ELLIE (E. Finnegan).

R. Bell, the rider of PARUNA MISS, reported that his mount had began well and travelled comfortably, however, finished the race off in a disappointing manner and in his opinion, may have jarred up on the Fast 1 racing surface. PARUNA MISS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MAGIC MESSIAH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SPINNING CROWN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be sore across the back.

RACE 3: TOYOTA MOTOR COMPANY & KELLY TOYOTA / MURRAY PEST CONTROL JAMESTOWN / JAMESTOWN CONTAINER DEPOT RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1340 metres

CLAY PAVER (T. Zanker) was slow into stride.

RACE 4: BUNDALEER WINES /JAMESTOWN HOTEL / JAMESTOWN COUNTRY RETREAT CARAVAN PARK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1340 metres

On arrival on course I WANT TO BELIEVE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare had sustained a laceration to its off foreleg when being unloaded from the float and was unfit to race. Acting on that advice Stewards withdrew I WANT TO BELIEVE at 12.35 pm.

After COME ON KAROL was loaded into the barriers, its barrier gate opened prematurely. COME ON KAROL was immediately restrained. COME ON KAROL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to start.

To avoid the possibility of further malfunction, COME ON KAROL which had drawn the widest barrier of the field, was loaded into the barrier stall outside the malfunctioning stall.

Approaching the 1200 metres PIERREMONT MAGIC (R. Bell) brushed YOULLNEVAWALKALONE (C. Forrest).

YOULLNEVAWALKALONE (C. Forrest) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn.

ZANONI (P. Denton) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. ZANONI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have sustained speedy cuts to the near hind leg.

RACE 5 : RAILWAY HOTEL JAMESTOWN / CARLTON UNITED BREWERY JAMESTOWN CUP - 1800 metres

SPANISH HALO (NZ) (K. Brooks) and ETERNAL HEART (T. O' Donnell) bumped on jumping away.

BLAKELEY (D. Tootell) and RETAIN BELIEF (R. Mayers) were inclined to over-race in the early stages of the event.

In the straight RETAIN BELIEF (R. Mayers) shifted out and away from PELEKUNU VALLEY (NZ) (C. Forrest), which was inclined to lay out under pressure. PELEKUNU VALLEY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

BELLCHUCA (E. Finnegan) laid in over the concluding stages.

RACE 6 : JOSLIN CHIROPRACTIC / REDDEN BROS / QUALITY RURAL / SWAN PHARMACIES / WEBB TYRE SERVICE RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

METRO CAT (A. Doyle) was tightened for room on jumping away between LIMBO QUEEN (D. Tootell) and WARRASIDE (P. Denton), which both shifted ground.

Rounding the home turn ORDYNSKI'S HILL (T. O' Donnell) was inclined to lay out.

A. Doyle, the rider of METRO CAT, explained that rounding the home turn he was obliged to momentarily steady his mount as ORDYNSKI'S HILL (T. O' Donnell) was inclined to lay out

and he had elected to wait until he had fully established himself to the inside of that gelding prior to committing to the run.

MORE PLEASE, ORDYNSKI'S HILL and ZIAZAN were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Following the running of Race 4, remedial work was undertaken on the barrier stalls and all barrier gates were subsequently found to be operating satisfactorily.
