Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse
by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Sunday, 5 October 2014

RACE 1 : KEMP REAL ESTATE RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

DO TELLE (NZ) (M. Neilson) and BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (D. Dunn) raced ungenerously in the middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres DO TELLE (NZ) (M. Neilson) had to be momentarily steadied when attempting a tight run between ALERTNESS (J. Kah) and BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (D. Dunn).

RACE 2 : CARLTON UNITED BREWERY RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

HERO TO VILLIAN (A. Patterson) stood flat footed and was very slow to begin. Ms A. Morrison, the Trainer of HERO TO VILLIAN was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding's starting manners.

IT'S LUMSDEN (K. Brooks) stood flat footed and was very slow to begin. Mr D. Magro the Trainer of IT'S LUMSDEN was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding's starting manners.

STRATHISLA (M. Neilson) raced three wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres HERO TO VILLIAN (A. Patterson) had to momentarily steady when KAREN THE SEYIS (T. Pannell) shifted out. T. Pannell was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

RACE 3 : PORT LINCOLN HOTEL BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to an interstate delay.

GET PRONTO (M. Neilson) pulled hard in the early and middle stages of the event.

From the vicinity of the 400 metres to the vicinity of the 250 metres EXTRACEED (T. O' Donnell) was held up for clear running when racing on the heels of GET PRONTO (M. Neilson) and to the inside of OCSMEPOP (K. Bishop).

GET PRONTO, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : SOUTHERN CROSS AUSTEREO / SABOIS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

GEORDIE'S LASS (T. Pannell) was slow to begin.

Shortly after the start PACIFIC JOURNEY (D. Dunn) had to be steadied away from the heels of CAPTAIN PEDRILLE (E. Finnegan) when that gelding jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres STRAVINSKA (A. Patterson) appeared to shy at a marking on the track and shifted in, bumping SPEEDALLA (M. Neilson).

CAPTAIN PEDRILLE (E. Finnegan) pulled hard in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres SUNFLOWER CLUB (K. Brooks) had to momentarily steady when MUSICAL MISS (C. Forrest) shifted in. C. Forrest was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

RACE 5 : AIT SPECIALISTS PTY LTD / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

JESTWIN (D. Dunn) was hampered at the start when PERFECT YANK (T. O' Donnell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in at the same time as WHITE JADE (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

JESTWIN (D. Dunn) laid in under pressure in the straight.

NIPEX, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a graze to the off hind leg.

RACE 6 : LEADERS DISTRIBUTORS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

DESTONY HAWK (E. Finnegan) jumped away awkwardly and as a result E. Finnegan was unbalanced for a short distance.

LADY PHOENIX (E. Boyd) was slow to begin.

MUMSLAD (J. Potter) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres VINARD (C. Forrest) raced ungenerously when being restrained off the heels of EXTREME VALUE (T. O'Donnell). Shortly after JOKEN JIM (D. Dunn) raced ungenerously for a short distance when being restrained off the heels of KOODA DAWN (K. Bishop).

Approaching the 600 metres JOKEN JIM (D. Dunn) had to be checked when that gelding raced keenly and improved onto the heels of HIGHEST NOTE (R. Bell) and to the inside of KOODA DAWN (K. Bishop).

LADY PHOENIX was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : FAMILY DAY RACES SUNDAY OCTOBER 19TH BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

DIRE WARNING (C. Forrest) was slow to begin.

DIRE WARNING (C. Forrest) was inclined to lay out under pressure from the vicinity of the 400 metres to the entrance of the straight.

**RACE 8 : MCDONALD FAMILY RESTAURANTS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER RATING 0-58
HANDICAP - 1000 metres**

On jumping away HEISENBERG (E. Boyd) was severely hampered and lost its position when ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD (K. Brooks) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out at the same time as DE VILAINE (C. Forrest) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD (K. Brooks) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

From the vicinity of the 400 metres to the entrance of the straight HEISENBERG (E. Boyd) was held up for clear running when racing between the heels of WESTERN BOY (K. Bishop) and LITTLE MISS MEXICO (A. Patterson).

RUBY JUBES (T. O'Donnell) hung out severely rounding the home turn. Ms A. Cornell, the Trainer of RUBY JUBES was advised a warning had been placed on the mare's racing manners.

ONTHEROAD FOR GOLD lost its near fore plate during the event.

R. Bell, the rider of GLENARIFF, pleaded guilty to a charge under AR145 for weighing in half a kilogram over the weight at which he weighed out and was fined \$200.

R. Bell, the rider of NIPEX pleaded guilty to a charge under AR83(a) for misconduct in that whilst returning to scale, he struck his mount's head with his whip. R. Bell's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of one (1) month to commence at midnight on Wednesday, 8 October and to conclude at midnight on Friday, 7 November 2014.
