RACE 1 : THE 17TH ARMY APPRENTICES GRADUATION / SABOIS 3YO MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

OVERSTREET (C. Lindop) was slow into stride.

NEVER POINTLESS (M. Neilson) jumped away awkwardly.

From the vicinity of the 300 metres until the entrance to the straight OVERSTREET (C. Lindop) was held up when racing inside JESSE 'N JAMES (J. Toeroek).

JESSE 'N JAMES (J. Toeroek) was inclined to lay in throughout the straight. JESSE 'N JAMES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding pulled its off fore plate during the race and the toe clip and a nail had become embedded in the sole of the hoof.

M. Neilson, the rider of NEVER POINTLESS, reported that the gelding did not stretch out throughout the event. NEVER POINTLESS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : MIDORI CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 2050 metres

FIGURE THIS (A. Herrmann) raced ungenerously in the early stages of the event.

LITTLE AUDREY (A. Patterson) raced ungenerously and was inclined to throw its head up in the middle stages of the event.

MARRIED FOR MONEY (C. Lindop) travelled wide without cover throughout the event.

Approaching the 600 metres SEDUCTION COUNSEL (M. Neilson) shifted out inconveniencing MARRIED FOR MONEY (C. Lindop).

RACE 3: TINTARA ESTATE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

AERONUT was reluctant to proceed to the barriers. Mr S. Whittle, the Trainer of AERONUT, was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its pre-race behaviour.

CLUB DIGGER (A. Patterson) shifted out on jumping away taking FAN THE BREEZE (J. Maund) out onto CHILLICONI (D. Tourneur).

COMMAND THE SUN (S. Price) shifted out taking CHAMPAGNE KRIS (A. Herrmann) onto FOND MEMORIES (R. Stewart), which was taken wider on the track and as a result was slow into stride.

DUNDEVY (W. Kerford) was slow to begin.

From in the vicinity of the 600 metres FOND MEMORIES (R. Stewart) was taken wider when BELLA GIULIETTA (J. Holder) shifted out to improve.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres ONWARD (J. Frew) was held up for clear running inside FAN THE BREEZE (J. Maund), which was inclined to lay in under pressure until the vicinity of the 50 metres when ONWARD was obliged to shift out across the heels of FAN THE BREEZE to obtain clear running.

AERONUT (A. Doyle) hung out throughout the event. AERONUT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported significant fresh bruising under the tongue, consistent with getting its tongue over the bit.

ONWARD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: WEST END / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to MISS MARIGOLD proving reluctant to proceed to the barriers and difficult to load. Ms M. Hodge, the Trainer of MISS MARIGOLD was advised that the mare would be required to perform to the satisfaction of the Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

MISS MARIGOLD (T. Zanker) was slow into stride.

BONE ELISE (J. Maund) shifted in onto MYSTIC'S FINALE (J. Frew), which was taken in onto JUNKET (R. Stewart), which brushed with LICHELLE (J. Holder). As a result MISS GRUMBLES (A. Doyle), which was racing to the inside of LICHELLE, brushed with that filly and became unbalanced.

In the vicinity of the 900 metres MISS GRUMBLES (A. Doyle) raced greenly and shifted out abruptly of its own accord.

MISS MARIGOLD (T. Zanker) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

From the vicinity of the 700 metres MOMENT OF EXCESS (D. Dunn) laid in for the remainder of the event.

MISS GRUMBLES (A. Doyle) hung out rounding the home turn.

In the vicinity of the 50 metres FRAAR FRAAR AWAY (W. Kerford) became awkwardly placed on the heels of MOMENT OF EXCESS (D. Dunn) and was obliged to shift across heels to obtain clear running.

RACE 4: WEST END / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (cont'd)

Approaching the winning post LUCKY FLIPPER (S. Price) shifted out and away taking BON ELISE (J. Maund) wider on the track.

MISS MARIGOLD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : THE CAITLIN FORREST MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

On arrival on course THREE ROYAL BEES (NZ), which had not raced since July 2013 was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race.

JUST A BOB and READY AGAIN which both brushed the mounting yard gate en route to the barriers were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled both geldings fit to race.

On jumping away TEMPORARY HOME (W. Kerford) shifted in and dipped taking THREE ROYAL BEES (NZ) (J. Frew) in at the same time as READY AGAIN (Z. Spain) shifted out taking FIORISTA (J. Toeroek) out resulting in THREE ROYAL BEES (NZ) becoming tightened.

Shortly after the start TEMPORARY HOME (W. Kerford) shifted in and away from BLITZING (M. Neilson) which improved to its outside, resulting in TEMPORARY HOME taking THREE ROYAL BEES (NZ) (J. Frew) in onto FIORISTA (J. Toeroek), which resulted in THREE ROYAL BEES (NZ) becoming tightened and losing its position.

TEMPORARY HOME (W. Kerford), THREE ROYAL BEES (NZ) (J. Frew), JUST A BOB (D. Dunn) and PIERREMONT MAGIC (M. Vance) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

In the middle stages of the event READY AGAIN (Z. Spain) raced keenly and was obliged to be restrained off the heels of SUPERMOSA (NZ) (S. Price) for a short distance.

Approaching the 600 metres FIORISTA (J. Toeroek) shifted out and brushed with PIERREMONT MAGIC (M. Vance) on a couple of occasions.

RACE 6 : CELLARBRATIONS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes owing to HE'LL TELL US taking charge of its rider and galloping a lap of the track before being recaptured by the Clerk of the Course. Acting on Veterinary advice Stewards withdrew HE'LL TELL US at 4.16 pm. On pulling up, L. Stojakovic, the rider of HE'LL TELL US, was dislodged from the gelding and L. Stojakovic was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel who reported an injury to her left leg. L. Stojakovic was advised that she is stood down from riding in track work, jump outs, trials and races and must provide a medical certificate declaring her fit to resume riding. Mr S. Whittle, the Trainer of HE'LL TELL US was advised that the gelding would be required to perform to the satisfaction of the Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

HIDDEN'S SISTER (D. Tourneur) and JUST TESS (A. Doyle) came together and brushed.

BIG WEEKEND (J. Holder) and METRO CAT (Z. Spain) were slow to begin.

RACE 6 : CELLARBRATIONS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 800 metres LITTLE BUSTER (R. Hurdle) raced keenly when racing in restricted room between MIKAELA (J. Maund) and SILVER SEBRING (D. Dunn).

Approaching the 200 metres MIKAELA (J. Maund), which was laying in, shifted in abruptly taking JUST TESS (A. Doyle) in onto the heels of TOKEN ONE (A. Herrmann), which rolled out slightly. As a result JUST TESS was obliged to be checked. JUST TESS continued to shift in and as a result JETMAKER (C. Lindop) shifted in and away from JUST TESS onto the heels of OUR ROYAL ROSE (S. Price) resulting in JETMAKER having to steady momentarily. Shortly after JUST TESS shifted out taking LITTLE BUSTER (R. Hurdle) out onto CHESTER DOWNS (J. Toeroek), which was tightened onto ALAKAZOO (W. Kerford).

From the vicinity of the 100 metres until the winning post SILVER SEBRING (D. Dunn) was held up inside the heels of OUR ROYAL ROSE (S. Price) resulting in SILVER SEBRING brushing the running rail in the vicinity of the 50 metres. SILVER SEBRING, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: COORS LAGER RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

On arrival at the barriers RORY'S UNION required re-saddling.

In the vicinity of the 1400 metres DOTTY KAY (D. Tourneur) became awkward when racing in restricted room inside ULTIMATE WINGMAN (D. Tootell) and in an attempt to hold its position DOTTY KAY made contact with ULTIMATE WINGMAN and lost its position. As a result ULTIMATE WINGMAN'S hindquarters were turned out.

From the vicinity of the 1200 metres HARRISVILLE TOFF (J. Holder) raced ungenerously for some distance.

ULTIMATE WINGMAN (D. Tootell) made the turn in the vicinity of the 1200 metres awkwardly taking CONSTRUM (J. Toeroek) out onto HARRISVILLE TOFF (J. Holder), which was taken wider on the track.

In the middle stages HARRISVILLE TOFF (J. Holder) continued to race ungenerously and in the vicinity of the 800 metres was obliged to shift out off the heels of CONSTRUM (J. Toeroek).

Approaching the winning post ZAYAK (C. Lindop) rolled out under pressure at the same time as LOOKING THROUGH (D. Dunn) rolled in resulting in LOOKING THROUGH having to be steadied and shifted out to avoid the heels of ZAYAK.

RACE 8 : COOPERS ORIGINAL PALE ALE FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

On arrival at the barriers CASINO EXIT was kicked by another runner. CASINO EXIT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding unfit to race. Acting on that advice Stewards withdrew CASINO EXIT at 5.32 pm.

On jumping away RIP APART (A. Herrmann) shifted in onto ZOVISTA (R. Stewart), which was taken in onto JUST RANGER (D. Dunn), which was hampered.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres HEURIGER (K. Cross) brushed with the inside running rail.

ROCK ON RENNIE, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported an abnormal respiratory noise. Mr S. Oxlade, the Trainer of ROCK ON RENNIE advised Stewards the gelding would be retired.
