Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 29 November 2014

RACE 1 : THE LITTLE MICK YELLAND HANDICAP - 1500 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

BEAU'S MY BOY (M. Vance) jumped away awkwardly.

NEW BALLS PLEASE (M. Neilson) pulled very hard in the early stages and was difficult to restrain and thereafter raced wide without cover throughout and was eased out of the event from in the vicinity of the 200 metres. M. Neilson explained the colt had pulled very hard in the early stages and was then inclined to hang out throughout the event. NEW BALLS PLEASE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Toeroek, the rider of SHEEZE HECTIC, reported the filly laid in over the concluding stages.

RACE 2 : ALF GARD MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1600 metres

TENERE (D. Tourneur) jumped away very awkwardly, shifted in and contacted QADIR (J. Holder), which was severely hampered.

At the entrance to the straight QADIR (J. Holder) shifted out to improve and contacted the hindquarters of TENERE (D. Tourneur), resulting in both horses becoming unbalanced for several strides. J. Holder was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

J. Cartwright, the rider of BALIGARI, explained he was disappointed with the gelding's performance and when asked for an effort at the entrance to the straight, it failed to quicken as expected and raced flat in its manner. BALIGARI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr. L. Kennewell, the Trainer of BALIGARI, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

RACE 3 : SPORTINGBET HANDICAP - 2500 metres

SUDDEN MOMENT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

D. Holland, the rider of ROWLAND, explained that owing to a lack of pace in the event he had elected to improve his position in the vicinity of the 600 metres, however, stated that after entering the straight, the gelding commenced to weaken and failed to finish the event off.

RACE 4 : HAIGH'S HANDICAP - 1100 metres

DUCKWORTH (S. Westover) jumped away awkwardly.

KAPAULENKO (H. McKechnie) dwelt at the start and was awkward to begin, losing one to two lengths.

TARCO (M. Neilson) was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 metres, when racing behind ORIDANE (T. Baker) and ANAMIKA (A. Herrmann) and to the inside of DEIHEROS (J. Cartwright), and was obliged to alter course in the vicinity of the 150 metres to obtain clear ground. Thereafter, approaching the 100 metres, TARCO rolled in and when being corrected, shifted out and tightened THE KUNUNURRA KID (J. Toeroek), which had to be steadied. M. Neilson was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

H. McKechnie, the rider of KAPAULENKO, reported that as a consequence of the colt not beginning on terms, she was unable to take up a forward position as intended.

DEIHEROS and DUCKWORTH were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

ORIDANE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a poor respiratory recovery with injected oral mucous membranes.

RACE 5 : PARTY AT THE TRACK TWILIGHT 19/12 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

SPUN DRY (D. Dunn) raced keenly in the early stages.

ROBOCOP (J. Maund) raced wide without cover in the early stages.

J. Toeroek, the rider of DISCO BELLE, reported the mare was inclined to lay in, in the straight.

D. Dunn, the rider of SPUN DRY, explained that in his opinion the gelding may not have been suited to the extra distance of today's event. SPUN DRY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

M. Neilson, the rider of ZAYAK, explained his instructions were to take up a forward position in running but as a consequence of the gelding not beginning as well as expected, he was obliged to settle midfield with cover. He added that whilst the gelding travelled well in the first half of the event, inside the 800 metres, when asked for an effort, the gelding was off the bridle and did not respond to his riding and inside the 700 metres he attempted to improve to the outside of WICKED TYCOON (S. Carr) but was unable to do so owing to ROBOCOP (J. Maund) racing to his immediate outside. He also stated that ZAYAK was inclined to lay in, in the straight and raced in a flat manner.

RACE 6 : DARLEY HANDICAP - 1200 metres

QUICK LOVER (J. Toeroek) and MARBLE RYE (A. Herrmann) were slow to begin.

RACE 6 : DARLEY HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

GOLD BUNDLE (M. Neilson), jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and tightened BURNRO (S. Carr) onto DOUBLE POCKETS (D. Tourneur), resulting in BURNRO being inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 900 metres BURNRO (S. Carr) shifted into the running line of COUNTER SPIN (C. Lindop), which had to be steadied. S. Carr was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

COUNTER SPIN (C. Lindop) raced keenly in the middle stages of the event and was inclined to lay out in the straight.

QUICK LOVER (J. Toeroek) became held up over the concluding stages between PISTOLIER (K. Cross) and OH GEORGE (D. Tootell), which rolled out slightly.

GOLD BUNDLE and DOUBLE POCKETS were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : BACK TO BACK WOSFC DRAGONS HANDICAP - 1100 metres

MISS WRITTEN (S. Carr) jumped away awkwardly, was slow to begin and then over-raced and raced ungenerously for some distance in the early stages of the event.

MACCY FIELDS (A. Patterson) was awkward to begin.

RAKS MCLAREN (J. Holder) was slow to begin.

MOLLY THE SNIP (J. Kah) knuckled at the start.

SLIPPERY NINJA (A. Herrmann) was slow into stride.

RAKS MCLAREN (J. Holder) was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 metres when racing behind VIOLETS ARE BLUE (D. Holland) and approaching the 300 metres shifted out to improve and contacted KATE'S DREAM (M. Neilson), which maintained its line. As a consequence both horses became unbalanced and M. Neilson became unbalanced in his seat shortly thereafter. J. Holder was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

Approaching the 200 metres KATE'S DREAM (M. Neilson), which was inclined to lay in, shifted in, taking RAKS MCLAREN (J. Holder) in onto SHELBY APPLES (J. Toeroek), which was momentarily inconvenienced.

RACE 8 : MAC JUST OVER? JUST DON'T DRIVE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Mr J. O'Connor, the Trainer of HEART REEF, advised Stewards prior to the event he would instruct Jockey R. Hurdle to attempt to obtain cover in the event.

SHEEZ ON TOP, which was presented in a lugging bit and not in a bit lifter in accordance with the recorded gear for the mare, was permitted to race with a lugging bit. Mr. T. Dansie, the Co-trainer of SHEEZ ON TOP, was fined \$100 for presenting the mare in the incorrect gear.

On arrival at the barriers FASTCAR, which was kicked by another runner, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race.

SAGABELLA (R. Bell) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8 : MAC JUST OVER? JUST DON'T DRIVE HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

FASTCAR (J. Cartwright) became held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight.

AZZCOOL (J. Toeroek) laid in, in the straight.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres SAGABELLA (R. Bell) was obliged to be steadied and altered course to the inside of RUSTY RULER (D. Tourneur).

Approaching the 100 metres HEART REEF (R. Hurdle) was obliged to be steadied when racing in restricted room between ISLAND BEACH (M. Neilson) and SHEEZ ON TOP (K. Cross), which both shifted ground.

SANDHILL FLASH, which hung out throughout the event, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a slow post-race recovery.
