Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse

RACE 1 : M&M TREE & EARTH REMOVAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1390 metres

NANNA KNOWS BEST (B. Claridge) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto ALL THE TIME (A. Herrmann), tightening BLACK DANCER (T. O' Donnell) onto STRAVINSKA (R. Hurdle). As a result BLACK DANCER was obliged to be steadied and lose its position.

ALL THE TIME (A. Herrmann) was inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages of the event.

BLACK DANCER (T. O' Donnell) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SOUND ALIBI (M. Neilson) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. SOUND ALIBI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding required dental work. Trainer, Mr J. Dunn was advised the gelding's teeth needed to be attended too prior to accepting for a future race.

BLACK DANCER, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : JINGLE BELLS TWILIGHT MEETING, 12TH DECEMBER RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

CASINO EXIT (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto JUST PURE FUN (B. Claridge), which was taken in onto LADY PHOENIX (A. Herrmann) as TROBEN (S. Carr) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

RACE 2 : JINGLE BELLS TWILIGHT MEETING, 12TH DECEMBER RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1390 metres (Cont'd)

STRATACHIC (E. Boyd) was held up for clear running from approaching the 200 metres until the vicinity of the 150 metres when racing behind SOUTHERN ALLIANCE (S. Cahill) and inside LADY PHOENIX (A. Herrmann).

ESSENCE'NRESTRAINT (A. Doyle) was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn. ESSENCE'NRESTRAINT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

When questioned regarding the improved performance of CASINO EXIT, Trainer Mr M. Whittle explained that in his opinion, the gelding was down significantly in grade and had benefitted from a firmer track and the addition of a senior rider. He added that he had not changed the gelding's work or feed regime in the lead up to this event.

RACE 3 : VET ON EYRE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

MEADOWS STORM (J. Toeroek) was slow to begin.

DO TELLE (NZ) (M. Neilson) over raced in the middle stages of the event.

At the entrance to the straight MEADOWS STORM (J. Toeroek) was disappointed when attempting a tight run between DO TELLE (NZ) (M. Neilson) and MORCHOWIE MISS (T. O' Donnell), which shifted out and away from LAMU LAD (T. Baker), which improved quickly to that mare's inside. T. O' Donnell was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground in future.

DO TELLE (NZ), which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : SHARPSHOOTING PHOTOGRAPHY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

JEST ANOTHER DAY (E. Finnegan) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in bumping GAIVERENTE (T. O' Donnell).

WHITE JADE (A. Herrmann) was inclined to hang out throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres JUST ANOTHER DAY (E. Finnegan) dipped for no apparent reason.

At the entrance to the straight KALINGA LOCK (T. Baker) rolled in and as a result RUBY AMOUR (D. Tootell) was taken in and became awkwardly placed on the heels of ACE OF SPADES (S. Cahill).

WHITE JADE (A. Herrmann) was held up for clear running from approaching the 300 metres and was untested to the finish when awkwardly placed on the heels of ACE OF SPADES (S. Cahill) and inside RUBY AMOUR (D. Tootell).

RACE 5 : TOWN & RURAL FENCING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

ALERT THE WORLD (A. Doyle) reared as the start was effected.

TERRAPINNA (E. Finnegan) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out brushing BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (A. Patterson).

RACE 5 : TOWN & RURAL FENCING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

In the vicinity of the 200 metres, A. Patterson, the rider of BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ), accidentally dropped his whip. A. Patterson was reprimanded for carelessness in dropping his whip.

CRYSTAL ICON (D. Tourneur) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (A. Patterson), which was obliged to be steadied momentarily.

RACE 6 : AIT SPECIALISTS PTY LTD BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

OCSMEPOP (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.

EMMOOKI'S DASH (D. Tourneur) over-raced in the early stages of the event.

EMMOOKI'S DASH (D. Tourneur) hung out rounding the home turn and shortly after entering the straight was momentarily inconvenienced as A CHILLER (T. Baker) rolled in marginally. EMMOOKI'S DASH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

A CHILLER, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : PORT LINCOLN CITY MOTORS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

WESTERN BOY (S. Carr) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto KOMOVI (T. O' Donnell).

KAMPKOOKER (E. Finnegan) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto BELUGA GOLD (E. Boyd), which was taken in onto ALERTNESS (D. Tourneur), which lost its position when tightened onto MISS BELLARAE (T. Baker).

WESTERN BOY (S. Carr) was inclined to lay out throughout the event.

Approaching the 200 metres JESTWIN (S. Cahill) shifted in onto KOMOVI (T. O' Donnell), which was taken in onto the heels of WESTERN BOY (S. Carr). Shortly after ALERTNESS (D. Tourneur) shifted out onto WESTERN BOY, which was taken out onto JESTWIN, which shifted out and away taking KAMPKOOKER (E. Finnegan) out onto BEARDED DRAGON (M. Neilson), which had to be steadied.

BELUGA GOLD (E. Boyd) was inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

B. Claridge, the rider of CATCH HIM, which was eased out from the entrance to the straight, reported the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action. CATCH HIM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Mr R. King, the Trainer of CATCH HIM, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

RACE 8 : CARLTON MID BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

Mr C. Hansen, the Trainer of DIRE WARNING advised Stewards that Apprentice E. Boyd would be instructed to attempt to ride the gelding in a more forward position than at its previous starts.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres EXCLUDED (NZ) (M. Neilson) rolled out onto the heels of EXCELLENT POINT (D. Tourneur), which had been taken in marginally by HANK'S NEPHEW (D. Tootell), resulting in EXCLUDED (NZ) having to be checked and losing its position.

RACE 8 : CARLTON MID BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1210 metres (Cont'd)

Approaching the 100 metres EXCELLENT POINT (D. Tourneur) improved into a tight run to the outside of TESTATE (T. O' Donnell) and in doing so brushed DIRE WARNING (E. Boyd), which was inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres MOON DEVIL (S. Cahill) shifted in abruptly as BLACK BARRA (A. Patterson) improved quickly to that gelding's outside, resulting in ROLL ON BAI (A. Herrmann) being taken into the running line of SPIRIT OF FLATLEY (R. Hurdle), which was forced to take hold.

M. Neilson, the rider of EXCLUDED (NZ), explained that after taking hold in the vicinity of the 700 metres, the gelding was reluctant to race and for this reason had elected not to ride his mount out in the normal manner. EXCLUDED (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9 : MCDONALD FAMILY RESTAURANTS RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

HEZAFRAAR (S. Carr) jumped away awkwardly shifted out onto HEZA HUSSLER (A. Patterson), which was tightened onto MUMSLAD (B. Claridge).

HIGHEST NOTE (T. Baker) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto PERFECT YANK (J. Toeroek) taking that filly out onto KOODA DUCHESS (A. Herrmann).

In the vicinity of the 200 metres MUMSLAD (B. Claridge) attempted a tight run to the outside of PERFECT YANK (J. Toeroek) and to the inside of SLIDE OF HAND (R. Hurdle), which rolled in marginally, resulting in MUMSLAD and SLIDE OF HAND bumping on a number of occasions.
