Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 7 January 2015

RACE 1 : SANDERS FODDER / MITAVITE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to MISTY RIDGE (K. Bishop) breaking through the front of the barriers after being loaded. MISTY RIDGE was quickly restrained and examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who passed the gelding fit to start.

HERE'S ARCHIE (B. Claridge) jumped away awkwardly and got its head up for a number of strides.

MISS BRANDYWINE (C. Lindop) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

HERE'S ARCHIE (B. Claridge) laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight.

At the entrance to the straight EDIT (M. Neilson) shifted out to improve and in doing so bumped LETHAL LILY (T. Zanker).

HERE'S ARCHIE, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

EDIT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have heat stress. First aid was administered.

RACE 2 : STABLE STARS KIDS CLUB MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

CARAJILLO which struck a perimeter fence on leaving the mounting yard was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the start and passed fit to race.

RACE 2 : STABLE STARS KIDS CLUB MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres (Cont'd)

COME ON KAROL (R. Bell) was slow to begin.

SINAWEH (A. Doyle) raced keenly in the early stages and raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event.

CARAJILLO (D. Tourneur) was held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight when racing behind LAUDJOE (T. Pannell) and inside FIORISTA (S. Carr).

At the entrance to the straight COME ON KAROL (R. Bell) shifted out to improve and in doing so contacted MYSTIC'S FINALE (R. Stewart), which was hampered when tightened onto SCENIC GREY (J. Holder), which was unbalanced momentarily. COME ON KAROL continued to shift out under pressure and approaching the 200 metres inconvenienced MYSTIC'S FINALE, which was again tightened onto SCENIC GREY. R. Bell was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure there was sufficient room prior to shifting ground and to make a greater effort to straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground.

QUESTO E VELOCE (K. Bishop) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

SCOOTER HOOTER lost its off hind plate during the running of the event.

RACE 3 : SPORTSBET – DOWNLOAD THE APP NOW / SABOIS F&M RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1500 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to SATURDAY FIRST, which was fractious while being loaded and struck the barriers structure, being examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who passed the mare fit to race.

SLIPPERY NINJA (A. Doyle) was slow to begin.

CHOISELLE (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay out throughout the event.

D. Tourneur, the rider of WHITE PIRANHA, which performed poorly, explained that the mare had raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event and when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 400 metres, had failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly, and in his opinion, may not have appreciated the distance of today's event. WHITE PIRANHA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CHOISELLE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Following the running of this race, lightning activity commenced in the area and shortly after embers from a nearby bush fire began to fall on the course. Stewards contacted the Bureau of Meteorology who advised that lightning activity would be present in the area until the early evening and also continued to monitor updates from the CFS in relation to the Gawler South fire. Stewards also met with representatives of the Jockey group, Trainer's and Club Official's. After considering all the relevant information available at the time, Steward's cancelled the remainder of the meeting at 2.50 pm.
