Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 17 January 2015

RACE 1: CAMP GALLIPOLI HANDICAP - 1250 metres

THE GEE TRAIN (T. Pannell) jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

SURE GONE (M. Vance) jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was inconvenienced by MISS ADELE (L. Meech), which shifted in on jumping away.

ARTFUL MONTY (K. Cross) raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

CAPTAIN PUNCH (J. Toeroek) was inclined to lay out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight.

MANHATTAN PRINCE (C. Lindop) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

SURE GONE (M. Vance) had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres when racing between the heels of CAPTAIN PUNCH (J. Toeroek) and THE GEE TRAIN (T. Pannell).

J. Toeroek, the rider of CAPTAIN PUNCH which performed below expectations, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 300 metres, failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly. CAPTAIN PUNCH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a poor respiratory recovery.

RACE 2 : JIM'S CLEANING HANDICAP - 1550 metres

CIVETTA (C. Lindop) was slow to begin.

MACCY FIELDS (L. Meech) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

From inside the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight TEAR GAS (NZ) (D. Tourneur) was held up when racing behind OUR EXCHANGE (K. Cross) and inside GIRLS ON FILM (NZ) (T. Pannell).

RACE 2: JIM'S CLEANING HANDICAP - 1550 metres (Cont'd)

At the entrance to the straight OUR EXCHANGE (K. Cross) shifted out to improve and in doing so brushed REAL TESS (J. Holder), which was taken wider.

OUR EXCHANGE (K. Cross) was inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.

GIRLS ON FILM (NZ), which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Mr. R. Balfour, the Trainer of GIRLS ON FILM (NZ), was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the mare for a future trial or race.

RACE 3: ADELAIDE GALVANIZING HANDICAP - 1000 metres

OUR EMILY MIA, which was fractious en route to the barriers, was examined on arrival at the start by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to race.

BELFAST BOY (D. Tourneur) was inclined to rear on jumping away.

WHITLAM (B. Claridge) and LAST DAY (NZ) (J. Holder) were slow to begin.

- J. Holder, the rider of LAST DAY (NZ), accidentally dropped his whip inside the 100 metres.
- J. Holder was reprimanded for carelessness under AR137(a).

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to review the official vision of the start in relation to WHITLAM. Stewards took evidence from B. Claridge, the rider of WHITLAM, and the Official Starter and after doing so, determined that the blindfold had been removed simultaneously with the start being effected and declared WHITLAM a starter in accordance with AR134A.

B. Claridge, the rider of WHITLAM, reported he had become concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding stages and for this reason had not ridden WHITLAM out in his normal manner. WHITLAM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had a lower than expected heart rate and was lame in the off foreleg. Ms. D. Wilson, the Trainer of WHITLAM, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

RACE 4: TATTSBET ADELAIDE CUP 9TH MARCH HANDICAP - 2400 metres

TOO COOL TO FOOL (NZ) (C. Lindop) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 1200 metres DISTILLATION (J. Cartwright) shifted out onto ROCMARR (J. Holder), which was inconvenienced when taken wider.

Approaching the 600 metres MAJESTIC MOMENT (J. Toeroek) shifted out to improve and in doing so contacted MOSSEGO (D. Tourneur), which was inconvenienced when taken wider on the track.

TOO COOL TO FOOL (NZ) (C. Lindop) was held up from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight when racing behind DISTILLATION (J. Cartwright) and inside ROCMARR (J. Holder).

J. Cartwright, the rider of DISTILLATION, reported the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres had failed to respond to his riding and had finished the event off poorly. DISTILLATION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: TATTSBET ADELAIDE CUP 9TH MARCH HANDICAP - 2400 metres (Cont'd)

MAJESTIC MOMENT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5 : BOOK YOUR EVENT @ MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1250 metres

On jumping away FASTCAR (J. Holder) and RUNNING BULL (L. Meech) came together and bumped.

PRONTO PRONTO (J. Toeroek) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DR DAPPER (M. Neilson) was obliged to alter course to the outside of CLASSY JACK (J. Cartwright) in the vicinity of the 200 metres to obtain clear ground.

- B. Claridge, the rider of OH GEORGE which performed below expectations, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages, however, was inclined to lay out rounding the home turn and when placed under pressure, failed to respond to his riding in the straight. OH GEORGE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Mr T. McEvoy, the Trainer of OH GEORGE, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.
- J. Cartwright, the rider of CLASSY JACK which performed below expectations, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 300 metres, failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly and he had become concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding stages. CLASSY JACK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: DRINK DRIVING? GROW UP HANDICAP - 1250 metres

THE FASTNET (J. Matthews) was slow to begin.

LATIN HERO (M. Vance) lost its position on jumping away when tightened between LUSTREMAN (R. Hurdle), which shifted in, at the same time as MOLASMO JET (J. Maund) shifted out.

MOLASMO JET (J. Maund) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

MAGLISSA (C. Lindop) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event, made the turn in the vicinity of the 1000 metres awkwardly and shifted out, tightening NADAKA (R. Bell) onto SHEEZ ON TOP (S. Carr), which was taken wider on the track. As a result SHEEZ ON TOP was forced to race without cover for the remainder of the event.

JIMMY THE BUTCH, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

NADAKA, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: SPORTINGBET HANDICAP - 1550 metres

Mr. L. Macdonald, the Co-Trainer of GOODFUN GIRL, advised Stewards he would instruct Jockey C. Lindop to attempt to settle mid-field with cover rather than on pace due to the mare's wide barrier draw.

RACE 7: SPORTINGBET HANDICAP - 1550 metres (Cont'd)

EXODUS (E. Finnegan) knuckled on jumping away.

PRINCE OF CAPERS (R. Hurdle) jumped away awkwardly.

FLOW METER (R. Stewart) shifted out on jumping away, bumping STREETCAR VALOUR (J. Toeroek).

WAR IS OVER (J. Holder) shifted out on jumping away, hampering WOAKWINE (S. Carr), which was tightened onto ECLAIR SAMBA (NZ) (D. Tourneur).

GOODFUN GIRL (C. Lindop) and MR ZOOLANDER (B. Claridge) raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

ECLAIR SAMBA (NZ) (D. Tourneur) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

TANGO'S DAUGHTER (J. Cartwright) was reluctant when attempting a tight run between the heels of ONPICALO (M. Neilson) and DUBAWI GOLD (T. Sadler), and inside the 200 metres became disappointed when ONPICALO shifted out and away from FLOW METER (R. Stewart), which shifted out to improve.

ECLAIR SAMBA (NZ) (D. Tourneur) laid in under pressure in the straight.

ECLAIR SAMBA (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

TANGO'S DAUGHTER, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : PETER ELBERG FUNERALS HANDICAP - 1400 metres

On jumping away SPIRIT OF ENDEAVOUR (USA) (T. Pannell) and NOMIS (NZ) (R. Bell) came together and bumped.

CORPORATE TAKEOVER (T. Sadler) jumped away awkwardly.

CAPODECINA (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly and as a result, J. Toeroek's whip became lodged in the barrier structure, resulting in him not having the use of his whip for the entire event.

Shortly after the start MAGIC NIELLO (B. Claridge) got its head up on a number of occasions and struck B. Claridge in the face. Shortly after MAGIC NIELLO shifted in and contacted the hindquarters of CAVALOCE (C. Lindop) and then lost its position when TIMELYINTERRUPTION (J. Holder) shifted in. MAGIC NIELLO raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event.

WRIST WATCH (R. Stewart) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

CAVALOCE (C. Lindop) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

CORPORATE TAKEOVER (T. Sadler) was held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight when able to shift out and improve to the inside of WRIST WATCH (R. Stewart).

RACE 8: PETER ELBERG FUNERALS HANDICAP - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

J. Holder, the rider of TIMELYINTERRUPTION which performed poorly, explained the mare had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages and in the vicinity of the 500 metres commenced to weaken from the event. He added he had become concerned with the mare's action over the concluding 200 metres and for that reason had not ridden TIMELYINTERRUPTION out in his normal manner. TIMELYINTERRUPTION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

CORPORATE TAKEOVER lost its off fore plate during the running of the event.
