**RACE 1 : PETER KITTLE TOYOTA MOTOR COMPANY / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES**  
**MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to GRACE VONFIRE proving difficult to load. Trainer J. Hickmott was advised a warning had been placed on this filly in relation to its barrier manners.

EVERDEEN (T. Pannell) shifted out on jumping away, inconveniencing SO RESILIENT (M. Neilson), which was tightened onto STELLA CARINA (C. Lindop).

NEXT NELLY (M. Vance) jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was inconvenienced by ONE PERCENTA (S. Price), which shifted in resulting in NEXT NELLY being tightened onto GRACE VONFIRE (R. Stewart).

In the vicinity of the 800 metres NEXT NELLY (M. Vance) became awkwardly placed on the heels of GRACE VONFIRE (R. Stewart) and had to be steadied momentarily.

Inside the 300 metres COOMA MISS (S. Carr) shifted in and away from ONE PERCENTA (S. Price) and became awkwardly placed on the heels of GOLDEN CLASS (J. Kah) for a short distance and altered course abruptly to obtain clear ground, inconveniencing GRACE VONFIRE (R. Stewart), which was taken out onto NEXT NELLY (M. Vance).

M. Neilson, the rider of SO RESILIENT, which performed below expectations, explained the filly had travelled well in the early stages of the event, however, in the vicinity of the 600 metres had dropped the bit and when placed under pressure near the 400 metres, had failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly. He added SO RESILIENT was inclined to lay out throughout the event. SO RESILIENT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

COOMA MISS, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported atrial fibrillation. Mr. J. Smith, the Trainer of COOMA MISS, was advised the results of an ECG is to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the mare performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

GOLDEN CLASS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

## **RACE 2 : COOPERS CARLSBERG / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres**

SCOOTER HOOTER (O. Ridge) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1300 metres SCOOTER HOOTER (O. Ridge) attempted to improve to the inside of MOMENTARY SONG (J. Matthews), and shifted in and away, made contact with the running rail and became unbalanced for a short distance. In being unbalanced SCOOTER HOOTER shifted out abruptly hampering LOVE MOSCHINO (E. Boyd).

Approaching the 400 metres LIQUID COURAGE (J. Frew) became held up when awkwardly placed between the heels of EMAIL (J. Maund), which commenced to give ground and MONOPOLE (R. Stewart) until the entrance to the straight when it shifted out inconveniencing LAUDJOE (E. Finnegan), which was tightened onto SET LANE (J. Potter).

LIQUID COURAGE (J. Frew) continued to shift out and in the vicinity of the 200 metres, shifted onto SET LANE (J. Potter), which was taken out onto PHOENIX EAGLE (NZ) (S. Price), which was inclined to lay in, resulting in PHOENIX EAGLE (NZ) having to steady momentarily.

PHOENIX EAGLE (NZ), which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MOLTO VIVACE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the filly to have mild heat stress. First aid was administered.

## **RACE 3 : ADELAIDE WEIGHING EQUIPMENT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to THE PINCHER being fractious in its barrier after being loaded and becoming cast. THE PINCHER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards ordered the withdrawal of THE PINCHER at 2.09 pm. Trainer, Mrs S. Hayes was advised the filly would be required to load tractably in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

SHOUT DE BEERS (M. Neilson) was slow to begin.

LUCKSA (D. Tourneur) shifted in on jumping away inconveniencing VANQUISHED CHOICE (J. Holder).

EXALTED LILY (E. Finnegan) hang out throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 600 metres shifted out and contacted JESSIES'S OWN (S. Carr) on a number of occasions.

Approaching the 400 metres DYFIELD (R. Hurdle) improved onto the heels of EXALTED LILY (E. Finnegan), which had commenced to give ground and had to be checked.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres BELLOTTO'S SON (K. Connor) was forced to take hold when tightened between MOOSEM (J. Kah), which shifted in under pressure and JESSIES'S OWN (S. Carr), which improved into restricted room to the outside of PITCH DARK (R. Stewart), which then rolled out slightly. S. Carr was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure that there was sufficient room prior to attempting runs. J. Kah was severely reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight.

EXALTED LILY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 4 : ULTRA TUNE / KINGSFORD HOTEL / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-68  
HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

MOLLY THE SNIP lost its off hind plate in the mounting yard and required Farrier attention. Acting on a report from the Farrier, that MOLLY THE SNIP had lost its composure and it was unlikely that he would be able to re-plate the mare in the timeframe required, Stewards gave permission for the mare to race bare behind after receiving a request from Trainer, Mr K. Matson. MOLLY THE SNIP was examined on arrival at the barriers by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the mare fit to race.

A SAUCY SNITZEL (D. Tourneur) shifted in on jumping away and inconvenienced ULTRA VIRES (E. Boyd).

MITFORD GIRL (Z. Spain) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MOLLY THE SNIP (R. Hurdle) was held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight when racing between the heels of DREAMTIME BABY (R. Stewart) and I GOT A TURBO (E. Finnegan) and when it improved into the run between those two horses was accidentally struck on the head by the whip of R. Stewart.

**RACE 5 : ELDERS REAL ESTATE GAWLER RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 2100 metres**

Mr W. Hughes, representing Trainer Mr T. McEvoy, advised Stewards they would instruct D. Tourneur, the rider of SIX FOOT, to attempt to settle in a more forward position in today's event, if possible.

CALIGO lost its off fore plate in the mounting yard and required Farrier attention.

HIGH VALUE (J. Kah) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SIX FOOT (D. Tourneur) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

J. Holder, the rider of FLYING CASINO, explained that he had tracked GREAT MEMORIES (T. Baker) into the event, however, in the vicinity of the 600 metres had made the election to improve to the outside of that gelding, however, his mount had not responded despite his efforts, until it was able to balance upon straightening and finished the race off strongly.

J. Kah, rider of HIGH VALUE, reported the mare was reluctant to stretch out from the vicinity of the 700 metres and upon entering the straight had become concerned with its action. HIGH VALUE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to have strained its near fore flexor tendon. First aid was administered. Trainer Mr K. Sweeney was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

SIX FOOT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have mild heat stress.

**RACE 6 : CENTURY 21 ASSET MANAGEMENT CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1700 metres**

In the vicinity of the 1500 metres NOMIS (NZ) (Z. Spain) shifted out and away from CHOISELLE (J. Potter) onto WHERE'S THAT (E. Finnegan), which had shifted in slightly, resulting in the hindquarters of WHERE'S THAT being turned out and that gelding shifting in, hampering NOMIS (NZ) (Z. Spain), which was taken in onto CHOISELLE, which lost its position.

FATE (J. Kah) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**RACE 6 : CENTURY 21 ASSET MANAGEMENT CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1700 metres**  
**(Cont'd)**

WHERE'S THAT (E. Finnegan) was inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight and inside the 100 metres shifted out at the same time as NOMIS (NZ) (Z. Spain) rolled in marginally, resulting in E. Finnegan becoming awkwardly placed on that gelding's heels and shifting out towards STYRIA'S GEM (J. Holder), which shifted out and away.

T. Pannell, the rider of PIERREMONT ROCKS, reported that after being placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 700 metres, the mare had failed to respond to his riding and had become concerned with its action upon entering the straight. PIERREMONT ROCKS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Holder, the rider of the fourth placegetter STYRIA'S GEM, to view the official footage in the straight. After doing so J. Holder lodged an objection against WHERE'S THAT (E. Finnegan), the third placegetter alleging interference inside the 100 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* J. Holder's objection.

**RACE 7 : SA BUNG FRITZ APPRECIATION SOCIETY CUP RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1500 metres**

J. Frew, the rider of RIGHT AND READY, was dislodged en route to the barriers. RIGHT AND READY galloped riderless for a short distance prior to being recaptured. J. Frew was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to ride. RIGHT AND READY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled gelding fit to race.

STONEHAVEN, which was kicked by another runner en route to the barriers, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the start and passed fit to race.

CHOSEN FRIEND (J. Holder) was slow to begin.

SAMZERO (R. Hurdle) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ANURADHA (T. Pannell) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Shortly after entering the straight RED DAZZLE (S. Carr) was forced to race in restricted room to the inside of CAPTAIN PERCY (S. Westover) and only obtained clear ground when able to ease across that gelding's heels in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

Inside the 100 metres INCANDESCENT (C. Lindop) shifted in slightly, under riding onto CHAUTAUQUA GIRL (R. Stewart), which was forced to stop riding momentarily. Stewards considered that C. Lindop stopped riding and corrected her mount immediately upon commencing to shift ground and took no further action.

J. Holder, the rider of CHOSEN FRIEND, reported the gelding was making excess respiratory noise on pulling up. CHOSEN FRIEND was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RED DAZZLE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow R. Steward, the rider of CHAUTAUQUA GIRL and that mare's Trainer, Mr S. Padman, to view the vision in the straight.

**RACE 8 : SPORTSBET – DOWNLOAD THE APP NOW RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1100 metres**

ANYTHINGTHATMOVES lost its near hind plate in the mounting yard and required Farrier attention.

ANYTHINGTHATMOVES (K. Connor) jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

HOSTABLE (R. Hurdle) was slow to begin.

WANNA DECISION (M. Neilson) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

J. Kah, the rider of RICH RUPPEE, reported the colt made excess respiratory noise on pulling up. RICH RUPPEE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported abnormal respiratory noise. Mr D. Clarken, the Trainer of RICH RUPEE was advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

WHITE PIRANHA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
