**RACE 1: BETTA HOME LIVING KANGAROO ISLAND / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE**  
**- 1008 metres**

ALWEIGHS (B. Hoppo) stood flat footed and was slow to begin.

WINSKI (M. Henderson) jumped away awkwardly.

CUELLEN (Z. Spain) hung in under pressure in the straight. CUELLEN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 2: KILDEA PHARMACY BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP – 1008 metres**

GOLD TILLIE which had not raced since January 2013 was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the mare fit to race.

KALO TAXITHI (C. Davies) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 900 metres CHARLIE'S PRINCESS (A. Doyle) had to be momentarily steadied when CLEAR AZ MUD (M. Henderson) shifted in marginally. M. Henderson was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres GOLD TILLIE (B. Hoppo) had to momentarily steadied when KALO TAXITHI (C. Davies) shifted in under pressure despite the efforts of its rider.

**RACE 3: COOPERS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1360 metres**

PELL MELL (K. Brooks) was slow to begin.

**RACE 4: DUDLEY WINES BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1360 metres**

MR LOWNDES (J. Matthews) was slow into stride.

**RACE 5: INGRAM HOME HARDWARE RATING 0-68 HANDICAP – 1215 metres**

MILD MANNERED (K. Brooks) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres CHAMBRAY (A. Doyle) had to momentarily steadied when racing on the heels of KING RODNEY (J. Matthews). Shortly after KING RODNEY had to be steadied and lost its position when HURRICANE SONNY (M. Henderson) shifted out. M. Henderson was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

**RACE 6: CENTURY 21 RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1750 metres**

FRANK THE RIPPER (J. Matthews) and CRYSTAL ICON (K. Brooks) jumped away awkwardly.

JILLY’S EDGE (R. Bell) was slow to begin.

Shortly after the start JILLY’S EDGE (R. Bell) attempted to buck for a short distance. S. Whittle, the Trainer of JILLY’S EDGE was advised a warning had been placed on the mare’s performance.

CRYSRAL ICON (K. Brooks) laid in under pressure in the straight.
