RACE 1: SCHWEPPES 0-58 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

DE VILAINE (Z. Spain) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto ETERNAL HEART (J. Potter).

LEWIS STREET (A. Doyle) was slow to begin.

MORCHOWIE MISS (T. O' Donnell) was held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 200 metres until approaching the 100 metres when awkwardly placed between the heels of ACT OF FAITH (J. Kah) and MAGNUM PE I (R. Hurdle).

RACE 2: K&K COOLING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately seven minutes owing to WAADOO becoming very fractious in the mounting yard and dislodging T. Pannell. T. Pannell was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel who ruled him unfit to fulfill this engagement. R. Hurdle replaced T. Pannell as the rider of WAADOO in this event. Mr D. Courtney, the Trainer of WAADOO was advised a warning had been placed on that filly in relation to its pre-race behaviour. The start was further delayed owing to ALL KRUPT being kicked by another runner on arrival at the gates. ALL KRUPT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew ALL KRUPT at 3.45 pm.

MADAME ZARA (E. Boyd) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto STAND BY US (J. Kah).

STAND BY US, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Mr D. Carrison, the Trainer of STAND BY US, was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its competitiveness in this event.

WAADOO, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Following the running of this event T. Pannell was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled fit to fulfill his remaining engagements.

RACE 3: MGA INSURANCE BROKERS BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1960 metres

OCSMEPOP (Z. Spain) was slow to begin.

RACE 4: FOURIER TECHNOLOGIES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

SARCASM (S. Price) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto WINE LOVER (Z. Spain), which lost its position when tightened onto LADY PHOENIX (E. Boyd), which shifted out.

ROULETTE PRINCE (R. Hurdle) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping DESTONY HAWK (E. Finnegan).

B. Hoppo, the rider of SWINGIN' DAZZLER, accidentally dropped his offside rein in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

FREIGHT QUEEN (K. Cross) had difficulty obtaining clear ground over the concluding stages when racing in restricted room between the heels of KAMPKOOKER (J. Kah) and DESTONY HAWK (E. Finnegan).

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Cross the rider of the fifth placegetter FREIGHT QUEEN, and that mare's Trainer Mr A. Page, to view the Official Footage in the straight.

ROULETTE PRINCE lost its near hind plate during this event.

RACE 5 : EYRE GAS & WELDING SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

In the vicinity of the 1300 metres JOKEN JIM (R. Bell) shifted in onto EXTRACEED (Z. Spain), which was obliged to be steadied for a number of strides. R. Bell was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

Inside the 1300 metres THE HEADLINER (B. Hoppo) shifted in onto ROLL ON BAI (E. Boyd), which was obliged to be steadied for a number of strides. B. Hoppo was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

STREET RELATED (J. Potter) was inclined to over-race in the early stages of the event.

RACE 6: PETER TRELOAR RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

HAPPYENDO (E. Finnegan) was slow into stride.

BEE IN HER BONNET (J. Potter) was inclined to over-race throughout the event.

HAPPYENDO (E. Finnegan) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

BEE IN HER BONNET, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to have lacerations to both sides of its mouth. Mr S. Drewitt, the Trainer of BEE IN HER BONNET, was advised the mare's teeth required attending to.

RACE 7: EYRE TRAVEL BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

REVENGEFUL (T. O' Donnell) and EXCLUDED (NZ) (J. Kah) were both slow to begin.

NORTH BEACH (E. Finnegan) was inclined to hang out throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted out contacting ACHENAR (G. Willoughby) unbalancing that horse. As a result, DEBEERSONUS (T. Pannell), which was following these runners, was unable to obtain clear ground until the entrance to the straight.

RACE 8 : FIRE MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENMT GROUP RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute owing to VOODOO BLACK MAGIC proving difficult to load. Ms J. Branford the Trainer of VOODOO BLACK MAGIC, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its loading manners.

VOODOO BLACK MAGIC (J. Potter) raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event until the vicinity of the 1200 metres when it was able to find the lead.

JAILBREAK JIMMY (T. Baker) was inclined to over-race in the middle stages of the event.

- Z. Spain, the rider of MOONLIGHT MADICA, explained that in his opinion, the mare did not travel well during the event and when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, he became concerned with the mares action and therefore elected not to ride MOONLIGHT MADICA out in his normal manner from in the vicinity of the 400 metres. MOONLIGHT MADICA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
- J. Kah, the rider of GLENROSS, explained the filly may not have appreciated the step up in distance in today's event.
