**RACE 1 : FINNS FINE FOODS / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE -**  
**1100 metres**

DEFLASH (NZ) (E. Creighton) and DESIGNER EDITION (D. Tourneur) were both slow to begin.

ARMAINE BEAU (J. Kah) raced greenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

From the vicinity of the 400 metres to the entrance to the straight DESIGNER EDITION (D. Tourneur) was held up for clear running when on the heels of DANCER'S DREAM (A. Herrmann) and to the inside of BETTYDEE (H. McKechnie).

At the entrance to the straight DESIGNER EDITION (D. Tourneur) shifted out to improve around the heels of DANCER'S DREAM (A. Herrmann) and as a result bumped BETTYDEE (H. McKechnie).

LOLOTEA lost its near fore plate during the event.

MAGNUS REWARD, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 2 : GAMBIER EARTH MOVERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres**

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres MAJESTIC RIDGE (C. Jokic) had to momentarily steady when racing ungenerously on the heels of SKYE LAIRD (H. McKechnie).

From the vicinity of the 600 metres to approaching the 400 metres SANDHILL FLYER (A. Herrmann) was unable to obtain clear running when racing between the heels of MYSTIC'S FINALE (M. Vance) and SPRINGBANK JACK (C. Puls).

### **RACE 3 : CLASSICBET / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres**

GYALI (A. Doyle) stood flat footed and was slow to begin.

GOLD SEAL (H. McKechnie) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres SANDHILL STAR (A. Herrmann) had to momentarily steady when DECO BAR (E. Creighton) shifted in marginally.

From the vicinity of the 400 metres and for the remainder of the event, SANDHILL STAR (A. Herrmann) was held up for clear running when racing on the heels of WEPT (J. Kah) and to the inside of DECO BAR (E. Creighton).

In the vicinity of the 300 metres of WEPT (J. Kah) shifted out marginally and at the same time DECO BAR (E. Creighton) rolled in marginally under pressure and as a result SANDHILL STAR (A. Herrmann), which was held up for clear running, was awkwardly placed on heels for a number of strides.

DECO BAR, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to have a minor laceration the near hind leg.

### **RACE 4 : PINKERTON, PALM, HAMLYN & STEEN BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1300 metres**

Shortly after the start TONS OF DASH (E. Finnegan) was momentarily inconvenienced when MR DOUGHBOY (J. Potter) shifted out marginally.

From the 400 metres to the entrance to the straight SHADE OF GREEN (D. Tourneur) was held up for clear running when racing on the heels of SKALATOSON (E. Creighton) and to the inside of PHOENIX ARIZONA (NZ) (C. Jones).

CELTIC SWALLOW (H. McKechnie) shifted in under pressure in the straight.

### **RACE 5 : MOGAS REGIONAL RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1100 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to QUIET CHAT proving difficult to load. Mr J. Hickmott, the Trainer of QUIET CHAT was advised a warning had been placed on the mare's loading manners.

Shortly after the start BUNGALALLY BELLE (H. McKechnie) became inconvenienced for a short distance between ON THE REBOUND (Z. Spain), which shifted in and PORTICI (C. Jones), which shifted out.

JIMASSI (D. Tourneur) over- raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

ON THE REBOUND (Z. Spain) raced keenly in the early and middle stage of the event.

CARDINAL MISSION (E. Finnegan) laid out throughout the event.

JIMASSI (D. Tourneur) laid in under pressure in the straight.

Approaching the finish BAHGALLAH BANTAM (J. Frew) had to momentarily ease when racing tight between CARDINAL MISSION (E. Finnegan) and SAKURABA (C. Hall).

**RACE 5 : MOGAS REGIONAL RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)**

Shortly after STATUE OF GLORY (E. Creighton) had to momentarily steady when BUNGALALLY BELLE (H. McKechnie) shifted in under pressure. H. McKechnie was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

JIMASSI, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 6 : COOPERS KALANGADOO CUP (BENCHMARK 72) - 1700 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute due to an interstate delay. The race was further delayed by one minute owing to DANOULI being fractious in the barriers. DANOULI was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race. Mr J. Hickmott, the Trainer of DANOULI was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding's barrier manners.

LIFE'S A BUTTERFLY (E. Finnegan), OFF THE MAP (D. Tourneur) and HENDY (C. Jokic) were slow to begin.

At the entrance to the straight DANOULI (M. Vance) was momentarily inconvenienced and had to ease her mount for a short distance when awkwardly placed between the heels of BACK ON TRACK (C. Jones) and IT'S MARTINI TIME (E. Creighton).

In the vicinity of the 50 metres IT'S MARTINI TIME (E. Creighton) and RICH PRIDE (J. Kah) bumped for a short distance.

HENDY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 7 : GABRIEL ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1400 metres**

WHERE'S PINO (J. Frew) stood flat-footed and was very slow to begin.

From the vicinity of the 100 metres WHERE'S PINO (J. Frew) was unable to obtain clear running when racing on the heels of NIGHT NEWS (M. Munday).

IMAHOFFA, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
