Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse
by the Kimba Racing Club on Sunday, 22 March 2015

RACE 1 : COWELL COMMERCIAL / DARKE PEAK RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to VOODOO BLACK MAGIC proving difficult to load. Trainer J. Branford was advised the gelding would be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

ALERT THE WORLD (B. Hoppo) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

The saddle of FREIGHT QUEEN (T. O'Donnell) shifted to the off side in the vicinity of the 400 metres, placing that rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.

ETERNAL HEART (A. Doyle) made the home turn awkwardly and shifted wider on the track.

RACE 2 : FRANKLIN HARBOUR HOTELS AND THE PT HUGHES TAVERN RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

LEWIS STREET (A. Doyle) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres BURN SO BRIGHT (NZ) (Z. Spain) improved onto the heels of ABALONE WARS (J. Kah), had to be restrained and in doing so got its head up for a number of strides and shifted out onto FANTASTIC REIGN (K. Bishop), which lost its position when tightened onto MISTAKEN VALUE (T. O'Donnell), which shifted in slightly.

K. Bishop, the rider of FANTASTIC REIGN, which performed below expectations, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early stages of the event, however, after losing her position in the vicinity of the 1000 metres, had dropped the bit and despite her efforts had not improved into the race from that point on and finished the race off poorly. FANTASTIC REIGN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : ELDERS INSURANCE RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

BOURBONDETTA (G. Willoughby) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting STRAVINSKA (R. Hurdle).

ARTFUL MONTY (A. Herrmann) slipped behind on jumping away and was slow into stride.

RACE 3 : ELDERS INSURANCE RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1390 metres (Cont'd)

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres ARTFUL MONTY (A. Herrmann) improved onto the heels of HEZA HUSSLER (T. Pannell), had to be steadied and in doing so got its head up and raced ungenerously for a number of strides.

S. Carr, the rider of DAL ROMMEL (NZ), reported the gelding was inclined to lay out throughout the event. DAL ROMMEL (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a minor laceration to the near side of the face.

ARTFUL MONTY, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : MARINA HOTEL RATING 0-62 HANDICAP- 1210 metres

CHLOBOROUGH (K. Bishop) jumped away awkwardly.

MORCHOWIE MISS (T. O'Donnell) lost its position on jumping away when tightened between DON'T CALL ME MISS (Z. Spain), which shifted out at the same time as KIPROTICH (R. Hurdle) shifted in.

In the vicinity of the 600 metres DON'T CALL ME MISS (Z. Spain) had to be steadied when it improved onto the heels of BELUGA GOLD (E. Boyd) as MORCHOWIE MISS (T. O'Donnell) improved quickly to its outside.

BELUGA GOLD (E. Boyd) made the home turn awkwardly and shifted wider on the track inconveniencing MORCHOWIE MISS (T. O'Donnell).

BELUGA GOLD (E. Boyd) laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto ALL KRUPT (S. Carr), which was obliged to alter course to that mare's outside. E. Boyd was reprimanded and advised in future to make an attempt to straighten her mounts when they commenced to shift ground.

MORCHOWIE MISS (T. O'Donnell) laid in under pressure in the straight.

R. Hurdle, the rider of KIPROTICH, which performed below expectations, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 400 metres, failed to respond to his riding and he had become concerned with its action and for this reason had not ridden KIPROTICH out in his normal manner. KIPROTICH was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Ms A. Cornell, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

RACE 5 : LIENERT ENGINEERING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

Mr B. Clark, the Trainer of LOS RIOS, advised Stewards he would instruct that filly's rider T. O'Donnell, to attempt to obtain a position mid-field with cover if possible, in today's event.

SCENIC MINT (R. Hurdle) shifted in on jumping away onto MAPPINGA PRINCE (K. Bishop), which was taken in across the running of CARBON STORM (D. Tootell), which lost its position. MAPPINGA PRINCE continued in contacting LOS RIOS (T. O' Donnell), which was taken in bumping ANOTHER FAIRYTALE (J. Potter).

KICK ME NOT (S. Price) raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

LOS RIOS (T. O' Donnell) raced wide without cover throughout the event and made the home turn awkwardly, shifting wider on the track.

RACE 5 : LIENERT ENGINEERING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres (Cont'd)

Inside the 200 metres KICK ME NOT (S. Price) shifted in under riding onto ANOTHER FAIRYTALE (J. Potter), which was taken in onto HOT COCO (S. Carr), which was forced in tightening HEAVENS FLIGHT (T. Pannell) onto SUMITEE (J. Kah).

RACE 6 : BUD WOOLFORD MEMORIAL RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

MY BOY BRANDO (R. Hurdle) and MINAVILLA (A. Doyle) were slow to begin.

BLACK JUGAH (S. Carr) jumped away awkwardly.

FATHER TONY (A. Herrmann) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres HEZAFRAAR (T. Pannell) shifted out and contacted the hindquarters of MY BOY BRANDO (R. Hurdle) turning that gelding in. MY BOY BRANDO then commenced to shift in under riding until the vicinity of the 100 metres where T. Pannell was forced to stop riding for a short distance when racing in restricted room. R. Hurdle was reprimanded and advised in future that he would be required to stop riding and straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

RACE 7 : AGSAVE MERCHANDISE HANDICAP - 1210 metres

SUPERBAD (A. Doyle) was inclined to rear on jumping away and was slow into stride.

BLACK BARRA (T. O' Donnell) improved onto the heels of SPIRIT OF FLATLEY (Z. Spain) in the vicinity of the 400 metres and became held up until the entrance to the straight.

DEBEERSONUS (T. Pannell) laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in onto IMPERIAL FURY (J. Potter), which was momentarily inconvenienced. DEBEERSONUS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported minor lacerations to the off fore heel.

RACE 8 : WUDINNA HOTEL MOTEL KIMBA CUP - 1960 metres

JAPAN (T. Pannell) knuckled on jumping away.

OCSMEPOP (K. Bishop) was slow to begin.

EXTRACEED (D. Tootell) and TESTATE (T. O' Donnell) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres FORESHORE MAK (S. Carr) improved onto the heels of TESTATE (T. O' Donnell), which commenced to give ground and altered course to that gelding's inside momentarily inconveniencing EBONY ROCK (R. Hurdle).

TESTATE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

EBONY ROCK, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer D. Carrison was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

J Kah, the rider of VALUE AS, reported the gelding had over-raced throughout the event.

RACE 8 : WUDINNA HOTEL MOTEL KIMBA CUP - 1960 metres (Cont'd)

S. Price, the rider of MONTALTO, which performed poorly, explained that he had obtained a position in the race behind NOMIS (NZ), which he was comfortable with, and felt that gelding would take him into the race, however, in the vicinity of the 800 metres was unable to maintain his position behind NOMIS (NZ) despite his efforts. He added MONTALTO has been disappointing to the finish. MONTALTO WAS examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

S. Carr, the rider of FORESHORE MAK dismounted that gelding on pulling up as she had become concerned with its action. FORESHORE MAK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr B. Cozamanis was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

RACE 9 : HARDER TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

PROPSHAFT (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting HARD AT IT (J. Kah)
