**RACE 1 : CARAMAR BUS LINES / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE**  
**- 1100 metres**

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to SYMKEL proving reluctant to proceed to the barriers. SYMKEL was a late scratching at 11.57 am. Trainer, Mr M. O' Leary was advised that SYMKEL must perform satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial before being presented for a future race.

SARAH'S WAY (J. Toeroek) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 150 metres SARAH'S WAY had to momentarily steady when SANDHILL RULER (A. Herrmann) shifted out under pressure.

**RACE 2 : INFIGEN ENERGY / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE**  
**- 1700 metres**

GREY STEEL (B. Claridge) knuckled on jumping away.

BACK TO REALITY (J. Potter) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

**RACE 3 : WESTERN UNITED FINANCIAL SERVICES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP**  
**- 1700 metres**

SANDHILL STAR (A. Herrmann) knuckled on jumping away.

IT'SALL ABOUTHARRY was slow to begin.

SANDHILL STAR (A. Herrmann) was inclined to hang out throughout the event. SANDHILL STAR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

IT'SALL ABOUTHARRY, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

**RACE 4 : RAY WHITE KEATLEY RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1100 metres**

From the vicinity of the 900 metres and for a short distance DASHING PEDRILLE (K. Bishop) raced keenly.

**RACE 4 : RAY WHITE KEATLEY RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)**

BUNGALALLY BELLE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to have stripped its near foreleg. First aid was administered.

**RACE 5 : SOMERSET HOTEL FLYING HANDICAP – 1100 metres**

OGUNDE (E. Boyd) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out momentarily inconveniencing CONSOLIDATED GLASS (J. Toeroek), which was taken wider.

MORNIN' SAM (M. Munday) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres TILDY LAD (S. Price) was inclined to hang out severely for a short distance.

Rounding the home turn TILDY LAD (S. Price) hung out severely placing S. Price at a disadvantage for a short distance. TILDY LAD was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr J. Searle was advised TILDY LAD must perform satisfactory in an Official Barrier Trial prior to being presented for a future race.

**RACE 6 : DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1400 metres**

RAMSGATE (A. Herrmann) was slow to begin.

LEAD THE WITNESS (M. Munday) and RAMSGATE (A. Herrmann) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

**RACE 7 : SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES MILLICENT CUP - 2100 metres**

SANDHILL CHIEF (A. Herrmann) slipped on jumping and as a result was slow to begin.

Over the concluding stages BOJANI (E. Finnegan) was momentarily inconvenienced when racing on the heels of WOAKWINE (J. Potter) and to the outside of EVENMOREACTION (J. Frew).

CELTIC SWALLOW, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding to be lame in near foreleg. First aid was administered. Trainer, Ms S. Jaensch was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

**RACE 8 : BOWMANS EARTHMOVERS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP – 1400 metres**

DEVARICH (J. Potter) was slow to begin.

At the entrance to the straight DESIGNER EDITION (E. Finnegan) was inconvenienced and had to momentarily steady when MISS WAIROA (J. Toeroek) shifted in to improve around the heels of MANNY (NZ) (K. Walters). J. Toeroek was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres, for a short distance, CASH JOB (S. Price) and DADDY'S LITTLELADY (E. Boyd) bumped on a number of occasions.
