RACE 1 : CARLTON DRAUGHT / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1006 metres

Shortly after the start STEVIE GEE (C. Jones) shifted in abruptly bumping MAIL IT IN (S. Carr).

SPRINGFIELD LEW (J. Potter) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

Approaching the 300 metres WINDSOR CUP (J. Matthews) was momentarily inconvenienced and taken wider when SPRINGFIELD LEW (J. Potter) shifted out to improve around the heels of CORE BREACH (S. Price). J. Potter was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future.

DAREBEN HALARO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

POWDERWORKS, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: WWW.RACINGMURRAYBRIDGE.COM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1006 metres

AHEAD OF TIME (T. Baker) jumped away awkwardly, shifted out inconveniencing HEBE (P. Gatt), which was taken out onto SEE ME ROLLIN' (J. Potter), which was in turn taken out onto MAGGIE'S CALL (C. Jones) inconveniencing both those runners.

HEBE (P.Gatt) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 2: WWW.RACINGMURRAYBRIDGE.COM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1006 metres (Cont'd)

CHAMPAGNE JANE (S. Carr) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 300 metres bumped VEEJAY KISS (J. Holder) for a number of strides. CHAMPAGNE JANE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

HEBE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SEE ME ROLLIN' and AHEAD OF TIME, which performed below expectations, were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: SAMBEC SHEDS TWO-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1406 metres

SHOW SET (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shortly after shifted out, inconveniencing COBBY GIRL (R. Mayers), which was taken wider.

COBBY GIRL (R. Mayers) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres SKILLZ THAT KILLZ (J. Bowditch) shifted out to improve and in doing so bumped SHOW SET (J. Potter), which was momentarily inconvenienced.

In the vicinity of the 100 metres ADRENALIN (D. Tourneur) raced ungenerously for a short distance.

TITANIC THOMO, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : CARLTON DRAUGHT HOTELIERS' RACEDAY 20 MAY / SABOIS F&M MAIDEN PLATE - 1206 metres

JELLICLE MISS (J. Potter) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out at the same time as ZIP DELICIOUS (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. As a result BEAUTIFUL GIRL (Z. Spain) was inconvenienced.

MISS MARGARITA (E. Boyd) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out inconveniencing MARYORE (B. Claridge) and POLLYWAGON (S. Price), both of which were taken wider on the track.

SOLSTICE (M. Neilson) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event. SOLSTICE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported an elevated heart rate and the filly to be coughing. Trainer, Mr T. McEvoy was advised the results of a laryngoscopic examination and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the filly for a future trial or race.

RACE 5 : CLARKE GRAIN RATING 0-72 HANDICAP - 1606 metres

D. Caboche, the rider of HEURIGER, was unable to claim down to his minimum riding weight and was granted permission to only claim two and a half a kilograms of his allowance. D. Caboche pleaded guilty to a charge under AR120(b) for being overweight and was fined \$200.

WILLY THE RABBIT (G. Willoughby) stood flat footed and was very slow to begin.

BOLD ZAMOUR (NZ) (S. Carr) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

Mr G. Richards, the Trainer of WILLY THE RABBIT, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding's starting manners.

RACE 6: RIDLEYS EARTHMOVING - CIVIL WORKS - PLUMBING CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1206 metres

BOSSY MISS MOSSY (K. Bishop) was slow to begin.

DON'T CALL ME MISS (Z. Spain) raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 350 metres SHAABAM (M. Neilson) had to be steadied when BENGAL TIGER (T. Pannell) shifted out and away from SEPTEMBER STORM (P. Gatt), which shifted out under pressure. P. Gatt was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

In the vicinity of the 50 metres MAVERICKS (J. Holder) had to be steadied momentarily when STONE SOBER (D. Tourneur) shifted out under pressure. D. Tourneur was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

Z. Spain, the rider of DON'T CALL ME MISS, reported the mare made unusual coughing noises during the run. DON'T CALL ME MISS was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : BATES MECHANICAL – FARM MACHINERY AT ITS BEST STRATHALBYN BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1406 metres

BELEAGUER (D. Tourneur) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping AUSSIE HOST (C. Lindop).

In the vicinity of the 800 metres AUSSIE HOST (C. Lindop) had to be momentarily steadied when racing tight inside the heels of BELEAGUER (D. Tourneur).

NORTH BEACH lost its near side fore plate during the event.

AUSSIE HOST lost both hind plates during the event.

RACE 8: MULCH 'N' MORE JOHN STOCKER MEMORIAL TROPHY RATING 0-82 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

TARCO (J. Holder) jumped away awkwardly.

WANAEA (C. Lindop) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8: MULCH 'N' MORE JOHN STOCKER MEMORIAL TROPHY RATING 0-82 HANDICAP - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

From the vicinity of the 500 metres to the vicinity of the 400 metres MISS JOOLIA (E. Boyd) was held up for clear running when racing on the heels of TARCO (J. Holder) and to the outside of WANAEA (C. Lindop).
