Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 10 June 2015

RACE 1 : EX AUSSIE CRICKETERS / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE – 1500 metres

MATERIALISED (P. Gatt) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres BELLEZZA NERO (A. Herrmann) improved onto the heels of MOONIES CHOICE (T. Pannell) and had to be steadied for a number of strides.

PIPER'S WAIT (S. Price) laid in under pressure in the straight and approaching the 200 metres had to be steadied momentarily as it continued to shift in at the same time as EMMA'S HURRICANE (J. Frew) shifted out.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Potter, the rider of the second placegetter COBBY GIRL, and that filly's Trainer, Mr B. Dunn, to view the official photo for first.

P. Gatt, the rider of MATERIALISED, reported in his opinion the filly had raced flat. MATERIALISED was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : PENFOLDS BIN 9 / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2100 metres

LOCOMOTION LUCY (T. Baker) jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

LOCOMOTION LUCY (T. Baker) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CLAREMONT KID (A. Doyle) laid out under pressure over the concluding 200 metres and made contact with MISS ELLA JAY (S. Price) on a number of occasions, inconveniencing that filly.

RACE 2: PENFOLDS BIN 9 / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2100 metres (Cont'd)

Z. Spain, the rider of LOLOTEA, explained the mare had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 500 metres, failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly. LOLOTEA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: WOLF BLASS RASCALS CUP - 1500 metres

BIG BOY BLEV (T. Baker) stood flat-footed and was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1100 metres SPEEDALLA (K. Bishop) shifted in slightly onto KIPROTICH (A. Herrmann), which was forced to race in restricted room for a short distance.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres SPEEDALLA (K. Bishop) shifted in onto KIPROTICH (A. Herrmann), which was forced to take hold to avoid the heels of SPEEDALLA, resulting in KIPROTICH losing its position. K. Bishop pleaded guilty to a charge of Careless Riding under AR137(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Sunday, 14 June and to conclude at midnight on Wednesday, 24 June 1015; a period of four (4) meetings.

Inside the 100 metres BIG BOY BLEV (T. Baker) shifted in abruptly, resulting in KIPROTICH (A. Herrmann) having to take hold when tightened onto RED DAZZLE (J. Maund). In reviewing the incident Stewards believed that T. Baker reacted immediately to correct his mount, when it shifted in, and took no further action in relation to the incident.

In the vicinity of the 50 metres KINETIC ENERGY (P. Gatt), which was inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight, shifted out, inconveniencing BIG BOY BLEV (T. Baker).

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow T. Baker, the rider of the second placegetter BIG BOY BLEV, and that gelding's Trainer Mr J. Maddigan, to view the official vision over the concluding 100 metres.

BIG BOY BLEV was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : BARBADOS AT DUCATOON PARK / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-68 HANDICAP - 1500 metres

In the vicinity of the 300 metres TUNISIA TRAVELLER (T. Baker) was disappointed when attempting a run between the heels of BON ELISE (J. Maund), which rolled out slightly at the same time as MAGISUE (T. Brooks) laid in.

MAGISUE (T. Brooks) continued to lay in under pressure in the straight. MAGISUE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: ADELAIDE HILLS EQUINE CLINIC / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute owing to GRAYSON breaking through its barrier stall after being loaded. GRAYSON was quickly restrained, returned to the start and examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon, who ruled the gelding fit to race.

SINAWEH (A. Doyle) reared on jumping away and was slow into stride.

WILLIE'S GIRL (P. Gatt) lost its position on jumping away when tightened between THEATRE BOY (S. Price), which shifted in at the same time as LAST MOMENT (T. Pannell) shifted out.

RACE 5 : ADELAIDE HILLS EQUINE CLINIC / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

SINAWEH (A. Doyle) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres LILY'S PRIDE (E. Boyd) was hampered when tightened between ALYSIANA (J. Holder), which shifted in at the same time as BUYMEBYCHANCE (M. Neilson) shifted out.

WILLIE'S GIRL (P. Gatt) commenced to race fiercely from the vicinity of the 1000 metres, made the turn near the 800 metres awkwardly and shifted out, hampering LILY'S PRIDE (E. Boyd).

Approaching the 200 metres BUYMEBYCHANCE (M. Neilson) shifted out abruptly onto GOING NOWHERE (J. Matthews), which was tightened onto THEATRE BOY (S. Price), which shifted out and away, taking WILLIE'S GIRL (P. Gatt) out onto the heels of DYFIELD (B. Claridge). As a result WILLIE'S GIRL clipped the heels of DYFIELD and knuckled severely, unbalancing P. Gatt.

Approaching the 100 metres GOING NOWHERE (J. Matthews) improved onto the heels of RUN CHARLIE RUN (K. Brooks), which commenced to give ground, resulting in GOING NOWHERE becoming awkward on that filly's heels and shifting out, contacting THEATRE BOY (S. Price).

K. Brooks, the rider of RUN CHARLIE RUN, reported the filly laid out under pressure in the straight. RUN CHARLIE RUN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : COOPERS CLEAR RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1700 metres

Mr D. Jolly, the Trainer of DARCI'S MONEY (NZ), advised Stewards he would instruct Jockey J. Holder to attempt to obtain a position mid-field with cover if possible in today's event.

PADLOT (IRE) (M. Neilson) was slow to begin.

BEST OF MINX (P. Gatt) was slow into stride.

Approaching the 200 metres MARYORE (B. Claridge) shifted out and away from the whip of T. Pannell, the rider of PIERREMONT, onto DARCI'S MONEY (NZ) (J. Holder), which was inconvenienced.

- P. Gatt, the rider of BEST OF MINX, explained the gelding had not travelled well throughout the event and when placed under pressure, failed to respond to his riding and he had become concerned with its action in the vicinity of the 500 metres. BEST OF MINX was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.
- J. Holder, the rider of DARCI'S MONEY (NZ), which performed below expectations, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages, however, when placed under pressure inside the 400 metres, had failed to respond to his riding. He added that after being inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres, he had become concerned with the gelding's action. DARCI'S MONEY (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : SPORTSBET – WATCH LIVE RACING ON YOUR MOBILE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2100 metres

D. Caboche replaced D. Tourneur as the rider of MILKWOOD in this event as there was no senior rider available at the weight.

RACE 7 : SPORTSBET – WATCH LIVE RACING ON YOUR MOBILE RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2100 metres (Cont'd)

WIZZA'S MAGIC (B. Claridge) got its head down in its barrier stall prior to the start being effected, resulting in the gelding standing flat-footed, missing the start and taking no part in the race.

A. Herrmann, the rider of JUNIOR, accidentally dropped her whip in the vicinity of the 150 metres. A. Herrmann was reprimanded and advised that future carelessness may result in a penalty being imposed.

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow the Stewards to view the start in relation to WIZZA'S MAGIC. Mr J. Searle, the Trainer of WIZZA'S MAGIC, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners.

RACE 8: WOLF BLASS WINES CLASS ONE HANDICAP- 1100 metres

THE NIGHT SKY (B. Claridge) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, contacting MIDNIGHT SONG (Z. Spain).

In the vicinity of the 800 metres SWINGITLIKESAYERS (J. Potter) shifted out, inconveniencing PENDLEBURY (S. Cahill), which was taken wider on the track.

THE NIGHT SKY (B. Claridge) was inclined to lay in behind the heels of TIGER RUBY (S. Price) in the early part of the straight and approaching the 100 metres, when able to improve to the outside of that filly, laid in and made contact with TIGER RUBY for a number of strides.

Approaching the finish THE NIGHT SKY (B. Claridge) shifted out onto BENGAL TIGER (T. Pannell), which was inconvenienced.

E. Boyd, the rider of MRS MARIELLA, reported the mare hung in throughout the event. MRS MARIELLA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

THE NIGHT SKY and TIGER RUBY were examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.
