Report on Race Meeting held at the Port Lincoln Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Sunday, 4 October 2015

RACE 1 : DK QUARRIES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

TRIENEARAGH (T. O' Donnell) was slow to begin.

GRAND MARTINI (Z. Spain) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

S. Cahill, the rider of TASSIE, reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout the event.

SUPER HULA, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : LEADER DISTRIBUTORS / SABOIS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to FILLY OF STEEL rearing in the mounting yard, dismounting T. Zanker. T. Zanker was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to ride. The start was further delayed owing to SAINT VALENTINE becoming fractious in its barrier after being loaded and rearing. SAINT VALENTINE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to start. Trainer Mr S. Drewitt was advised a warning had been placed on SAINT VALENTINE in relation to its barrier manners.

In the vicinity of the 800 metres FILLY OF STEEL (T. Zanker) improved onto the heels of RUBY AMOUR (R. Bell) as the paced eased and shifted out onto WAADOO (Z. Spain), which was hampered and lost ground. As a consequence SUMITEE (E. Boyd), which was racing behind WAADOO had to be steadied off that mare's heels.

FILLY OF STEEL (T. Zanker) dipped in the vicinity of the 600 metres for no apparent reason.

RACE 2 : LEADER DISTRIBUTORS / SABOIS FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

SAINT VALENTINE (T. O' Donnell) laid out from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight. SAINT VALENTINE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Potter, the ride of ACE OF SPADES, which performed below expectations, explained the gelding had not travelled well throughout the event and when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres had failed to respond to his riding and for that reason he had not ridden his mount out in his normal manner. ACE OF SPADES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a lower than expected heart rate.

RUBY AMOUR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported Cardiac Arrhythmia. Trainer Mrs S. Williams was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the mare performing to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial, after which it is to be auscultated by a Veterinary Surgeon.

RACE 3: IMPACT SIGNS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes owing to D. Tootell, the rider of GEORDIE'S SECOND being dislodged en-route to the barrier. GEORDIE'S SECOND galloped riderless for a short distance prior to be being recaptured and then was reluctant to proceed to the start. GEORDIE'S SECOND was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to race. After being loaded GEORDIE'S SECOND became fractious in its barrier and reared on a number of occasions dislodging D. Tootell. D. Tootell was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled unfit to ride in this event. Acting on this advice GEORDIE'S SECOND was a late scratching at 3.00 pm. Trainer Mrs A. Harder was advised the gelding would be required to proceed to the start unassisted in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

GLENROSS (L. Stojakovic) dipped on jumping away and shortly after was inclined to buck for a short distance, shifting out abruptly hampering JESTWIN (Z. Spain), which lost ground. Trainer Mr D. Carrison was advised a warning had been placed on GLENROSS in relation to its racing manners.

In the vicinity of the 200 metres BIG WAVE (D. Caboche) shifted out abruptly onto WILLY THE RABBIT (J. Frew), which was forced to steady momentarily.

Approaching the finish SANDHILL JETT (T. O' Donnell) shifted out under riding towards BELUGA GOLD (E. Boyd), which shifted out and away tightening JUST PURE FUN (J. Potter) onto SOUND ALIBI (R. Bell), which held its line. T. O' Donnell was advised in future to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight when they commence to shift ground.

BIG WAVE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: M&M TREE & EARTH REMOVAL / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

ARWA (E. Boyd) was slow into stride and reluctant to stretch out in the early stages of the event.

T. O' Donnell, the rider of PERFECT YANK, reported that mare was inclined to lay out over the concluding 600 metres.

RACE 4: M&M TREE & EARTH REMOVAL / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

DESTONY HAWK (D. Caboche) had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 200 metres until the finish when awkwardly placed between MAGICAL TYCOON (S. Price) and KOODA DAWN (Z. Spain).

ARWA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

DESTONY HAWK was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported minor laceration to the near fore fetlock.

RACE 5 : VETS ON EYRE COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

HEZA HUSSLER (D. Tootell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping WOTZINTHEBAG (D. Caboche).

LAMU LAD (E. Boyd) was inclined to rear on jumping away.

MY BOY BRANDO (T. Zanker) jumped away awkwardly and raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Approaching the 400 metres GOODDEE (J. Frew) rolled in onto POINT DRUMMOND (L. Stojakovic), which shifted in and away onto LAMU LAD (E. Boyd), which had to be restrained. In being restrained LAMU LAD shifted out contacting TENNESSEE GROOM (NZ) (S. Price), which was forced to check when taken out onto the heels of WOTZINTHEBAG (D. Caboche), which held its line. J. Frew was reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater attempt to keep her mounts straight when they commence to shift ground.

HEZA HUSSLER (D. Tootell) laid in under pressure in the straight. HEZA HUSSLER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

TENNESSEE GROOM (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: BK & BJ SOUTHAM TV & LINE INSTALLATION BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

TERRAPINNA (T. Zanker) shifted out on jumping away onto HOST ESPRIT (J. Potter), which was hampered when tightened onto PROPSHAFT (Z. Spain).

VALIK (E. Boyd) jumped away awkwardly.

PROPSHAFT (Z. Spain) had difficulty in obtaining clear ground from the vicinity from the 400 metres until near the 200 metres when awkwardly placed between the heels of LUCKSA (S. Cahill) and VALIK (E. Boyd).

S. Cahill, the rider of LUCKSA, which performed poorly, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early stages of the event, however, in the vicinity of the 800 metres had dropped the bit and had not improved into the event despite his efforts and for this reason he had not ridden LUCKSA out over the concluding stages. LUCKSA was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: SCHWEPPES BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

GET PRONTO (Z. Spain) shifted out on jumping away onto HIGHEST NOTE (L. Stojakovic), which was inconvenienced when tightened onto DIRE WARNING (E. Boyd).

In the vicinity of the 200 metres DIRE WARNING (E. Boyd) shifted out onto SPIRIT OF FLATLEY (D. Tootell), which had to be steadied momentarily and alter course. E. Boyd was reprimanded and advised in future to ensure she was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground. DIRE WARNING (E. Boyd) then continued to shift out under pressure brushing with GET PRONTO (Z. Spain) on a number of occasions to the finish.

HIGHEST NOTE, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SPIRIT OF FLATLEY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had blood present in one nostril. Trainer Mrs A. Harder was advised that SPIRIT OF FLATLEY would be required to gallop a 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race in accordance with AR53A(7).
