Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 7 October 2015

RACE 1 : GOLDIN FARMS MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes owing to RICCONE losing its near fore plate en route to the barriers and requiring attention. RICCONE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to start.

RICCONE (M. Neilson) over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

Approaching the 1000 metres MONS ABILA (S. Cahill) shifted out whilst over-racing hampering CATCH ME LATER (C. Jones). S. Cahill was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future. CATCH ME LATER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : SCHWEPPES / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 metres

ULTIMATE THRILL (P. Gatt) was slow to begin losing three lengths. Trainer J. Hickmott was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to being slow to begin.

RUBY FOR HENRY (T. Pannell) laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: SANDERS FODDER / MITAVITE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

GOLDEN CENTURY was fractious in its barrier after being loaded, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and passed fit to start. Trainer J. Stephens was advised a warning would be placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners

SLOW PROCESS (J. Frew) was hampered on jumping away after ONE PERCENTA (J. Toeroek), which began awkwardly, shifted in and ROCK STATUS (M. Neilson), which also began awkwardly and shifted out.

ROCK STATUS (M. Neilson) over-raced throughout the event.

In the vicinity of the 300 metres ROCK STATUS whilst racing greenly shifted out abruptly and when approaching the finish line shied at the winning post and ran out.

RACE 4 : TREVU HOUSE AT GAWLER / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

Approaching the 600 metres WITH GRAVY (J. Holder) shifted out and bumped SALTARELLO (J. Toeroek), which was hampered.

SALTARELLO (J. Toeroek) over-raced when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 200 metres, ducked in and proved difficult to ride.

S. Carr, the rider of MEADOWS CADDY, reported her mount raced greenly throughout the event.

R. Hurdle, the rider of AMERITAR, reported his mount raced greenly throughout the event.

SALTARELLO was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

DAMOCLES was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported minor lacerations to the near hind fetlock.

RACE 5: KINGSFORD HOTEL RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

OVERSTREET (J. Maund) began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped OUR ROYAL ROSE (G. Willoughby), which was hampered.

SEPTEMBER STORM (C. Lindop) shifted out on jumping away onto IT'S LUMSDEN (J. Maund), which was hampered.

SUPER SILKS (NZ) (T. Pannell) over-raced in the early stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres SCARLET LETTR (R. Hurdle) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of OVERSTREET (J. Maund), which was over-racing and hung out. IT'S LUMSDEN (K. Bishop), which was racing behind SCARLET LETTER had to be steadied, resulting in OUR ROYAL ROSE (G. Willoughby) improving onto and clipping that gelding's heels.

BELLA TAHLEE (K. Brooks) was hampered in the vicinity of the 400 metres when URBAN BOURBON (S. Cahill) shifted out to improve. S. Cahill was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

URBAN BOURBON (S. Cahill) shifted in and away from MASTER BLACK (P. Gatt), which shifted in under pressure in the straight.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow S. Cahill, the rider of URBAN BOURBON, to view the official footage in the straight.

RACE 6: GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1500 metres

MIGHTY MAHER (C. Lindop) was slow to begin.

THESPINIS (T. Pannell) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

INTOSSICARE (K. Brooks) was held up for clear running on the heels of THESPINIS (T. Pannell) from the 400 metres until the 100 metres.

S. Carr, the rider of MEADOW'S JOURNEY, reported her mount hung in when placed under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1500 metres (Cont'd)

I'MTELLINGYOUNOW (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

INTOSSICARE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Ms K. Byrnes was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the mare for a future trial or race.

RACE 7: SPORTSBET RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2100 metres

FLIRTY GERTY which became fractious in the tie-up stalls was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported that the mare had sustained some lacerations and would be unfit to start. First aid administered. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew FLIRTY GERTY at 4.17 pm. Trainer Mr S. Burford was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the mare for a future trial or race.

Mr G. Young, the Trainer of OUR MUMMY'S BOY, was questioned regarding his failure to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the gelding as required by the Rules. As Stewards were able to confirm the identity of OUR MUMMY'S BOY from records held by them and its microchip, the gelding was permitted to start and Mr Young was fined \$100 under AR59A.

OUR MUMMY'S BOY (K. Brooks) was slow to begin.

KIPROTICH (S. Carr) began awkwardly, shifted out and hampered PIERREMONT ROCKS (J. Potter).

JASPERS GLEN (D. Tourneur) over-raced in the early stages of the event.

RACE 8: COOPERS CLEAR RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

DESERT LADY (K. Brooks) was awkward to begin, shifted out and bumped SAGABELLA (J. Kah).

STRAVINSKY CODE (J. Holder) began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped LUCKY ON BLACK (S. Price).

I AM RELENTLESS (D. Tourneur) over-raced in the early stages of the event.

Following the running of the race D. Tourneur failed to weigh in as required under AR144. D. Tourneur was reminded of his obligations to weigh in as required under the Rule.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Brooks the rider of DESERT LADY to review the official footage of the start.

FULL SWING, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

I AM RELENTLESS, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.
