RACE 1 : REQUEST RECRUITMENT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 900 metres

Mr J. MacMillan, the Trainer of HEBE put a submission to Stewards that the mare be permitted to wear a tongue tie in this event as he had inadvertently forgot to provide the gear change prior to acceptance time and was of the opinion that HEBE required this gear to perform at its best. After considering his submission, Stewards acceded to his request, however, Mr MacMillan was fined \$100 under AR140(B)(3).

M. Poon, the rider of MR ROADSTAR, who was dislodged en route to the barriers was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the start and passed fit to ride.

WINGS OF AN ANGEL (K. Bishop) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MR ROADSTAR (M. Poon), which shifted out and away onto JUST LIVE ON (T. Pannell), which lost its position when tightened onto EL DUB (S. Cahill).

ANOTHER NIBBLE (D. Tourneur) was slow to begin.

KICKSTARTER (J. Toeroek) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in bumping WHITE LINE FEVER (J. Kah).

In the vicinity of the 600 metres MR ROADSTAR (M. Poon) checked when approaching the heels of WHITE LINE FEVER (J. Kah) and in doing so MR ROADSTAR shifted out abruptly, severely hampering JUST LIVE ON (T. Pannell), which was forced to check and was taken wider on the course. M. Poon was advised that he would be required to attend the Riding Skills Panel in relation to this incident in accordance with AR92A.

E. Boyd, the rider of SAND CAT, reported the filly raced extremely greenly throughout the event. SAND CAT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 1 : REQUEST RECRUITMENT / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 900 metres (Cont'd)

JUST LIVE ON was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MR ROADSTAR was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported the gelding had abrasions to both hind legs.

RACE 2 : RURAL CITY OF MURRAY BRIDGE – LET'S TALK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately ten minutes owing to PLAYBOY LANE (M. Neilson) being fractious in the mounting yard, dislodging M. Neilson. M. Neilson was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled unfit to fulfill this engagement. D. Caboche accepted the ride and replaced M. Neilson.

TYCOON CHESTER (J. Bowditch) and ARTFUL CHARMER (S. Cahill) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 500 metres SCRUM (Z. Spain) improved onto the heels of THAT COOL TIGER (J. Frew) and had to be steadied. As a result DAPPER ROSSA (A. Doyle), which was racing behind SCRUM, improved onto that filly's heels and was forced to steady.

S. Cahill, the rider of ARTFUL CHARMER, which performed poorly, explained the gelding pulled hard in the early and middle stages of the event and when placed under pressure, had failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly. ARTFUL CHARMER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

D. Caboche, the rider of PLAYBOY LANE, reported he had become concerned with the gelding's action in the straight. PLAYBOY LANE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

OCTOBER DAWN, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

BRIMARVI CUGAT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

THAT COOL TIGER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported a laceration to the near hind heel and hoof, which was consistent with being galloped on. First aid was administered.

Following the running of this event, M. Neilson was re-examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to fulfill his remaining engagements.

RACE 3 : FMG ENGINEERING BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2200 metres

OUR MUMMY'S BOY (D. Caboche) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

From inside the 600 metres until approaching the 300 metres MOONIES CHOICE (J. Kah) was held up when racing behind CALLMEDAN (K. Brooks) and inside OUR MUMMY'S BOY (D. Caboche).

From inside the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight OUR MUMMY'S BOY (D. Caboche) was held up when racing on the heels of JASPERS GLEN (D. Tourneur) and inside JARRVIS (J. Toeroek).

RACE 3 : FMG ENGINEERING BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2200 metres (Cont'd)

T. Pannell, the rider of KEEPAKIWI (NZ), which performed poorly, explained the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event, however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres, had failed to respond to his riding and finished the event off poorly. KEEPAKIWI (NZ) was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

JASPERS GLEN, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

FIVE TO MIDNIGHT was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported an abrasion to its muzzle.

Stewards questioned D. Caboche, the rider of OUR MUMMY'S BOY, into to the reasons that he had entered the mounting yard with the intention of riding OUR MUMMY'S BOY without a safety vest as required by AR87B. After considering his explanation D. Caboche was charged under AR75(k) in that his negligence could have led to a breach of the rules. D. Caboche pleaded guilty and was severely reprimanded.

RACE 4 : BGC INDUSTRIAL CLEANING MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

DE STARSANDCIRCLES (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting ZOVISTA (K. Bishop).

SHAVANO'S IMAGE (M. Neilson) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and was inclined to lay out under pressure over the concluding 600 metres. SHAVANO'S IMAGE was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

JOY FLIPPER, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SHAVANO'S IMAGE lost its off fore plate during the event.

RACE 5 : BRIDGE CARPET COURT CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

FAMOUS JAYNE (J. Potter) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

FIRE THE MUSKET was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

MR PORTER was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : CGU INSURANCE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

PARTING SHOT (J. Potter) was slow to begin.

In the vicinity of the 1200 metres SIMPATICO (J. Kah) was forced to steady when racing in restricted room between the heels of ONEHUNDREDCLICKS (NZ) (C. Jones), which shifted in at the same time as GOLDEN BUCKLEBOO (J. Toeroek) rolled out.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres GOLDEN BUCKLEBOO (J. Toeroek), which was racing keenly, had to be checked to avoid the heels of ONEHUNDREDCLICKS (NZ) (C. Jones), which shifted in. In being checked GOLDEN BUCKLEBOO shifted out onto SIMPATICO (J. Kah), which lost its position when tightened onto IT'S FRED (S. Price). C. Jones, the rider of

ONEHUNDREDCLICKS (NZ) pleaded guilty of Careless Riding under AR137(a) that in the vicinity of the 1000 metres she permitted her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of GOLDEN BUCKLEBOO (J. Toeroek), who was forced to check his mount to avoid the heels of the gelding. C. Jones was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Wednesday, 21 October and to conclude at midnight on Wednesday, 28 October 2015: a period of three (3) meetings.

PARTING SHOT (J. Potter) had difficulty obtaining clear ground over the concluding 300 metres.

SIMPATICO, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

IT'S FRED was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported minor lacerations to the near hind leg.

RACE 7 : BURKE URBAN FLYING HANDICAP - 1000 metres

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres GAV'S GIFT (T. Pannell) became awkwardly placed on the heels of PISTOLIER (J. Toeroek) for a number of strides and had to be restrained.

BRIMARVI PRINCE, which performed poorly, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8 : CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP - 1600 metres

In the vicinity of the 1300 metres LORD ASPEN (M. Neilson) raced keenly for a short distance when awkwardly placed on the heels of BACK ON TARGET (J. Kah).

LITTLE AKIE (K. Bishop) raced wide without cover throughout the event.

LORD ASPEN (M. Neilson) laid out rounding the home turn resulting in STARKIATO (J. Bowditch), which was inclined to lay in, in the straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of that gelding for a short distance. LORD ASPEN was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

Stewards questioned J. Toeroek, the rider of EXCITES ZELADY into his action approaching the finish. After considering his explanation J. Toeroek pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137(c) in that he made a celebratory gesture prior to his mount passing the winning post and was fined \$400.

RACE 9 : FRED VELLA TYRE & CRASH REPAIRS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

Acting on advice from Mrs G. Henderson, the Trainer of SAMSTAG, that the gelding was exhibiting signs of a virus, Stewards ordered the withdrawal of SAMSTAG at 8.18 am.

TANE MAHOUTA (G. Willoughby) jumped away awkwardly.

ROD'S OPINION (J. Bowditch) shifted out on jumping away and contacted GRIGIO NOW (E. Boyd).

PILOT'S LANE (J. Potter) and JUST A BOB (Z. Spain) were slow to begin.

RACE 9 : FRED VELLA TYRE & CRASH REPAIRS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP
- 1600 metres (Cont'd)

HIGHLAND HENRY (D. Caboche) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 1000 metres FRANK HEAVENS (J. Toeroek) got its head up and dipped for no apparent reason.

In the vicinity of the 400 metres JUST A BOB (Z. Spain) shifted out onto DIAPHYSIS (T. Zanker), which was forced to take hold when tightened onto SPRAY TAN (J. Kah). Z. Spain was severely reprimanded and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

K. Brooks, the rider of BARIGAN BOY, reported the gelding was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. BARIGAN BOY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

J. Bowditch, the rider of ROD'S OPINION, reported the gelding had become awkward in its action over the concluding 200 metres. ROD'S OPINION was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : BRIDGESTONE AUSTRALIA HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Mr. N. Smart, the Trainer of MR LIBERTY, advised Stewards on Monday, 12 October 2015, that on return to his stables MR LIBERTY was found to have jarred up in both forelegs, the stable will continue on with the gelding's preparation.

RACE 7 : HILL SMITH STAKES - 1800 metres

Mr. N. Smart, the Trainer of SINGLE BARREL, advised Stewards on Monday, 12 October 2015, that on return to his stables SINGLE BARREL was found to be lame in the near fore leg. An x-ray revealed bone chips in the near fore fetlock, the gelding will undergo an arthroscopic procedure later in the week and then be spelled.
