THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown Racecourse by the Bordertown Racing Club on Sunday, 18 October 2015

RACE 1: XXXX GOLD/SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1550 metres

Mr P. Hardacre, the Trainer of BLACK EYE GUY, advised Stewards he would instruct jockey C. Jones to attempt to settle in a more forwards position if possible.

ZIP HOP (Z. Spain) was slow to begin.

From the vicinity of the 400 metres to the vicinity of the 200 metres BETTYDEE (H. McKechnie) was held up for clear running when racing on the heels of SLOW PROCESS (Jemma Frew) and to the inside of JUST A DREAM (R. Hurdle).

RACE 2: RAY WHITE BORDERTOWN / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 metres

Ms E. Hubbard, the Trainer of EIGHT BLACK, advised Stewards she would instruct jockey E. Boyd to attempt to settle in a more forwards position if possible.

EIGHT BLACK (E. Boyd) was slow to begin.

PRIME STATUS (P. Gatt) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping DANZA MOMENT (J. Toeroek), which as a result was slow into stride.

STAR JOURNEY (S. Price) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in brushing MOMENTOUS DAY (S. Cahill).

In the vicinity of the 700 metres MOMENTOUS DAY (S. Cahill), which shifted in marginally was inconvenienced and lost its position when making heavy contact with HASTA LA DUKE (P. Marks), which shifted out marginally. MOMENTOUS DAY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

STAR JOURNEY was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: TATIARA TRUCK & TRAILERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

DELANANN (R. Hurdle) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out bumping CASINO LEGION (K. Bishop).

Shortly after the start ZIP STRYKER (Z. Spain) was inconvenienced when AL SLAMMER (E. Finnegan) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in and LISA'S GEM (T. O' Donnell) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

RACE 3: TATIARA TRUCK & TRAILERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

K. Bishop, the rider of CASINO LEGION, reported her filly was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

E. Finnegan, the rider of AL SLAMMER, reported her gelding was inclined to race greenly in the straight.

RACE 4: FARMERS LEAP WINES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1550 metres

Approaching the finish J. Maund, the rider of RORY'S UNION, accidentally lost his whip after being struck by another runner.

THE FASTNET, which performed below expectations, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

SEPTEMBER STORM was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: WOOLSHED INN HOTEL MOTEL RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

THE HOTZ (NZ) (P. Marks) and CRYSTAL WAVE (K. Bishop) were inconvenienced at the start when SWEDISH BITTERS (J. Kah) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

BELLE OF THE SOUTH (H. McKechnie) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

Shortly after the start GRIGIO NOW (E. Boyd) was inconvenienced for a short distance wwhen racing tight between NO DOUBTFIRE (S. Cahill) and BELLE OF THE SOUTH (H. McKechnie).

STEALTH MODE (D. Tootell) jumped away awkwardly.

LITTLE AUDREY (Jemma Frew) raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

NO DOUBTFIRE (S. Cahill) laid in under pressure in the straight.

E. Boyd, the rider of GRIGIO NOW, reported the gelding felt awkward in its action throughout the event. GRIGIO NOW was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: WILLOW GROVE STUD BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

AKBAR MAHAL (Z. Spain) jumped away awkwardly and shifted in bumping SOUVLAKI (S. Price) and as a result was slow into stride.

CORE BREACH (J. Toeroek) over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

In the vicinity of the 700 metres EXALTED APPEAL (P. Gatt) raced ungenerously for a short distance when racing tight to the inside of SHISO (Jemma Frew) and to the outside of MERRY CHRISTMAS (H. McKechnie).

H. McKechnie, the rider of MERRY CHRISTMAS, reported the gelding was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: WILLOW GROVE STUD BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

P. Gatt, the rider of EXALTED APPEAL, could offer no explanation into the poor performance of the gelding in today's event. EXALTED APPEAL was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: WISE FARM EQUIPMENT RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1300 metres

SMITH 'N' WESTERN (Jordan Frew) jumped away awkwardly.

DAMAGE CONTROL (E. Boyd) was slow to begin.

SCARLET LETTER (D. Tootell) laid in under pressure in the straight.
