**RACE 1 : MGA INSURANCE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres**

**PATCHE** – Trainer Mr. D. Carrison failed to produce Thoroughbred Identification Card as required – Fined \$50 under AR59A.

**PATRIOT CODE** (T. Pannell) – hampered at the start and lost its position. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SHARP THREADS** (L. Stojakovic) – raced keenly in the middle stages whilst being restrained.

**LOS RIOS** (T. O'Donnell) – jumped away awkwardly.

**PIERREMONT MAGIC** (D. Caboche) – jumped away awkwardly and inside the 800m got its head up and raced awkwardly for a short distance for no apparent reason.

**WAADOO** (E. Finnegan) – raced wide without cover throughout. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

**RACE 2 : PORT LINCOLN TIMES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1390 metres**

**DOOPSY DUCHESS**, which kicked out in its barrier stall after being loaded, was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who reported abrasions to the near hind leg and ruled it unfit to race. Withdrawn by Stewards at 1.45 pm. (Start delayed two minutes.) Required to perform satisfactorily an Approval to Race Jump out or an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

**TOBY'S DREAM** (G. Willoughby) – raced greenly throughout the event. Laid out rounding home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**ALL THE TIME** (K. Bishop) – bucked shortly after the start, losing ground. Required to perform satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**FILLY OF STEEL** (E. Boyd) – in the vicinity of the 700m improved onto the heels of EXALTED FEATURES and had to be steadied. Rider reported her saddle had slipped back on jumping away, placing her at a disadvantage throughout the event.

**TRIENEARAGH** (T. O'Donnell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

**RACE 3 : SOUTH AUSTRALIAN THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS INC. BENCHMARK 72  
HANDICAP - 1390 metres**

**VALIK** (E. Boyd) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

**BOSSA NOVA (NZ)** – Trainer Mr. D. Carrison failed to produce Thoroughbred Identification Card as required – Fined \$100 under AR59A. As this was the second occasion that the TIC had not been produced, Mr. Carrison was advised the gelding would not be permitted to start until the TIC was presented.

**RACE 4 : LEADER DISTRIBUTORS RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1390 metres**

Start delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate race.

**DO TELLE (NZ)** (M. Neilson) – rider reported the gelding felt short in its action when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations and abrasions to the near foreleg.

**HERO TO VILLIAN** (D. Tootell) – taken out and hampered shortly after the start.

**WILLY THE RABBIT** (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly.

**RACE 5 : LOCAL LIQUID DISPOSAL RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1210 metres**

**HEZA HUSSLER** (D. Tootell) – hampered shortly after the start.

**BELUGA GOLD** (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 400m had to be steadied when SWINGIN' DAZZLER rolled out at the same time as NEW WAVE rolled in. In being steadied, over-reacted, got its head up and lost ground.

**SANDHILL JETT** (T. O'Donnell) – raced fiercely and was awkwardly placed on the heels of DIVADEBEER from the 700m until the entrance to the straight. Approaching the 200m was disappointed when attempting a tight run to the inside of TALE BLAZER and was obliged to alter course. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**TRINKET LADY** (E. Finnegan) – unable to obtain clear ground in the straight and untested to the line when awkwardly placed to the inside of SWINGIN' DAZZLER.

**KOODA DAWN** (K. Bishop) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**RACE 6 : COATES HIRE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres**

**TINTAGEL ROCKER** (M. Neilson) – performed poorly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor recovery.

**MORCHOWIE MISS** (M. Poon) – Slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**ALL KRUIPT** (L. Stojakovic) – dipped for no apparent reason rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the near hind fetlock.

**RACE 7 : DEMPSEY'S SADDLERY & FEED SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP –  
1210 metres**

**HANK'S NEPHEW** (R. Hurdle) – jumped away awkwardly.

**THE HEADLINER** (J. Kah) – inconvenienced on jumping away.

**JAPAN** (S. Carr) – hung out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.
