RACE 1: BUNG FRITZ CUP 9 DECEMBER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1715 metres

ROAD WISE (Z. Spain) - On arrival on course a pre-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding showing signs of colic and would be unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards ordered the withdrawal of ROAD WISE at 11.30 am.

CLASSY BET (M. Neilson) - held up from the 600 metres to the entrance to the straight when racing behind RUN FORREST and inside ONE PERCENTA.

THAT COOL TIGER (K. Bishop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ONE PERCENTA (S. Price) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

ZIP HOP (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

RUN FORREST (E. Finnegan) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and near the 1000 metres shifted out and contacted SIXTEEN AGAIN. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

RACE 2 : WELCOME TO ALL THE TRADIES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1111 metres

BRIMARVI EQUIADA (M. Neilson) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

TIME TO ORDER (C. Lindop) – rolled in near the 800 metres and bumped SCENTED ROSE.

ANABELLA (P. Gatt) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed upper respiratory noise and the filly was slow to recover. Results of laryngoscopic examination and Veterinary Certificate of fitness required.

GARNACHA (D. Caboche) - hampered on jumping away.

RACE 2: WELCOME TO ALL THE TRADIES / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1111 metres (Cont'd)

GASOLINE ALLEY (NZ) (D. Tourneur) – lost near fore plate during the event.

SCENTED ROSE (J. Potter) – contacted near the 800 metres.

SHES GOT THE GOODS (E. Boyd) - was slow to begin and raced greenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ZIP STRYKER (J. Toeroek) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

GRAND MARTINI (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting GARNACHA.

RACE 3: ADELAIDE GALVANISING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1211 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately six minutes owing to a stable employee becoming ill and requiring medical attention.

ABLE STRIKER (J. Maund) – rider became concerned with its action shortly after entering the straight and for this reason did not ride out in his normal manner over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOUBTFUL BILLY (J. Frew) – rider reported the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

SPRINGFIELD LEW (J. Potter) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto COERCED WITNESS, which was taken out onto HEIDI STAR, which shifted out onto A LOTTA ROSIE, which was hampered and lost its position.

A LOTTA ROSIE (P. Denton) – hampered and lost its positon on jumping away. Was obliged to alter course in the vicinity of the 300 metres when HEIDI STAR laid in under pressure.

HEIDI STAR (M. Neilson) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 4: PEPPERJACK SHIRAZ / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1211 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes due to the delay in the previous event.

BIRCHMORE BULL (A. Doyle) - stood flat footed and was slow to begin, warning issued.

TICKLE ME ERNIE – (S. Price) – difficult to load, warning issued.

ZOLOTOI (S. Cahill) - was slow to begin.

PRINCESS COSTA (T. O' Donnell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BEST FORTUNE (R. Hurdle) - fractious in barrier, warning issued.

FRENCH AMOUR (C. Lindop) – had difficulty in obtaining clear ground approaching the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of WHISPERING WILLOW.

RACE 5 : COOPERS CLEAR RATING 0-62 HANDICAP (Apprentice ride only) - 2115 metres

MONS ABILA – late scratching at 9.55 am (refer General)

SIR DYLAN (E. Boyd) – hung out over the concluding 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor bruise to its near side cheek.

PILOT'S LANE (T. O' Donnell) - was slow to begin.

RACE 6: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1715 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute owing to SAVANERO (NZ) kicking out after being loaded.

PROUD EAGLE (E. Finnegan) – held up from the 400 metres until near the 200 metres when racing behind SAVANERO (NZ) and inside INTOSSICARE.

SAVANERO (NZ) (S. Price) – kicked out in its barrier stall after being loaded. A pre-race veterinary examination ruled the gelding fit to race. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SHAABAM (D. Caboche) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until near the 300 metres when awkwardly placed between the heels of INTOSSICARE and FIGURE THIS. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a lower than expected heart rate.

RACE 7 : SCHWEPPES RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1511 metres

SHADE OF GREEN (J. Frew) – laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider reported he was concerned with its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZIPALANG (R. Vigor) – was held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until inside the 300 metres.

IT'S FRED (S. Price) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SHA LA LA (S. Cahill) – rider explained the mare had only travelled fairly in the early and middle stages and when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: KINGSFORD HOTEL CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1111 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes owing to TRAFFIC DODGER losing its off fore plate en route to the barriers and requiring Farrier attention.

SEGREGATION (D. Caboche) – became held up at the entrance to the straight and had difficulty in obtaining clear ground until inside the 200 metres.

PERUVIAN POWER (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting SOCIAL LANE. Was inclined to lay in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COMMANDING DIVA (S. Cahill) – laid in under pressure in the straight bumping SOCIAL LANE in the vicinity of the 50 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOCIAL LANE (T. Pannell) – hampered on jumping away. Laid out under pressure in the straight and bumped COMMANDING DIVA in the vicinity of the 50 metres.

GEORDIE'S LASS (T. Zanker) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 9: SPORTSBET - CASH CARD RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1211 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to TRIMENSA becoming fractious in its barrier after being loaded. A pre-race veterinary examination ruled the mare fit to race.

EXPORT QUALITY (J. Potter) – raced keenly in the early stages whilst being restrained.

PHOENIX ARIZONA (NZ) (A. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A. Doyle pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip in a forehand manner on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: SPORTSBET - CASH CARD RATING 0-62 HANDICAP - 1211 metres (Cont'd)

TRIMENSA (K. Bishop) – knuckled on jumping away and raced wide without cover throughout the event.

WRITTEN BIRCH (J. Holder) – was slow to begin.

On the morning of Wednesday, 18 November 2015, Stewards visited a number of stables inspecting horses with engagements at this meeting. It was discovered that MONS ABILA was not stabled at Mr Nick Smart's Morphettville stable as he had notified via his stable return and was in fact at his Oakbank property. As Stewards were unable to inspect the horse, they ordered the withdrawal of MONS ABILA at 9.55 am. Mr N. Smart was advised that an inquiry into the reasons the gelding was not located at his Morphettville stable as notified would be held at a date to be fixed.
