RACE 1 : SCHWEPPE HANDICAP - 2500 metres

TUNES (C. Lindop) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the off fore heel. First Aid administered.

EIGELSTEIN (GB) (J. Holder) – rider reported the gelding was inclined to hang out over the concluding 800m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GRUMPY GURU (Z. Spain) – rider reported the gelding laid in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Z. Spain pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$200.

RACE 2 : EXELSUPER HANDICAP - 1000 metres

BURST AWAY (J. Holder) – shifted out on jumping away onto ASCENDANCE.

ASCENDANCE (M. Neilson) – inconvenienced on jumping away. Laid out over the concluding 600m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be moderately tying up.

PUNTER'S LASS (J. Toeroek) – rider reported he had become concerned with the filly's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : NESPRESSO BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP - 2014 metres

GRAVITATIONAL (E. Finnegan) – jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MARTIAN (IRE) (J. Cartwright) – rider reported the gelding failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure inside the 800m and he had become concerned with its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a lower than expected heart rate.

YOU ROCK (D. Caboche) – D. Caboche pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that he used his whip on consecutive occasions prior to the 100m and was reprimanded. He also pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$200.

RACE 4 : MEDALLION HOMES HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ALASKAN JADE (J. Maund) – shifted out on jumping away onto KIRONA, which was taken out onto SPIRITED MATCH. Inside the 500m became held up until the entrance to the straight. Shifted out near the 400m onto KIRONA.

HAZY LANE (E. Boyd) – held up from the vicinity of the 600m to the entrance to the straight. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MANHATTAN LIGHT (J. Kah) – shifted out on jumping away, contacted HEARTZ ABLAZE and became unbalanced. Rider explained the filly had never travelled and when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 400m, failed to respond to her riding and she became concerned with its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly had choked down.

HEARTZ ABLAZE (J. Toeroek) – shifted in on jumping away and contacted MANHATTAN LIGHT.

SHEANNA (E. Finnegan) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

KIRONA (T. Pannell) – unbalanced near the 400m when contacted by ALASKAN JADE.

SPIRITED MATCH (Z. Spain) – lost its position on jumping away.

RACE 5 : FARMERS UNION ICED COFFEE HANDICAP - 1600 metres

GENEROUS BEAU (D. Caboche) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. D. Caboche pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$200.

CAVALOCE (Z. Spain) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Had to be steadied in the vicinity of the 200m off the heels of SWINGING SOLDIER, which shifted out and away from MISS MARGARITA. Lost off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had suffered a bi-lateral bleeding attack during the race. Co-Trainers Messrs L. Macdonald & A. Gluyas advised the mare now suspended from racing for three months in accordance with AR53A.

WHERE'S TIM (M. Neilson) – jumped away awkwardly.

MISS MARGARITA (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, inconveniencing CAVALOCE. Shifted out to improve in the vicinity of the 200m onto CAVALOCE, which shifted out and away and had to be steadied. E. Boyd severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

BOYS GETAROUND HIM (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LOTION (C. Lindop) – Mr. B. Papazaharoudakis, representing Co-Trainers Messrs D. Hayes & T. Dabernig, advised Stewards he would instruct the rider to settle further back in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the off hind leg. First Aid administered.

MARYORE (T. Pannell) – shifted in approaching the finish onto CAVALOCE, which had to be steadied. T. Pannell reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

SWINGING SOLDIER (J. Kah) – slow to begin.

RACE 6 : WAYNE HENSON'S 70TH HANDICAP - 1200 metres

ALABAMA MISSILE (J. Cartwright) – lost near fore plate during the event.

CLARIFY (S. Cahill) – slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6 : WAYNE HENSON'S 70TH HANDICAP - 1200 metres (Cont'd)

DAUNTING DANCER (E. Boyd) – became awkward on the heels of NIMASAEL, which shifted in as it slowed the pace in the vicinity of the 500m, and shifted out, contacting VIOLETS ARE BLUE. E. Boyd was advised in similar circumstances in future she should attempt to restrain her mounts when in receipt of pressure so as to not place other riders in awkward situations.

TIDY PROPHET (M. Neilson) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m.

MISS ADELE (J. Holder) – slow to begin. Held up from the entrance to the straight until near the 150m.

FAMOUS JAYNE (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

NIMASAEL (Z. Spain) – in the vicinity of the 500 metres shifted in onto DAUNTING DANCER at the same time as it slowed the pace. Z. Spain severely reprimanded.

VIOLETS ARE BLUE (C. Lindop) – hampered near the 500 metres when tightened onto BARELY A BEAT by DAUNTING DANCER.

BARELY A BEAT (W. Kerford) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 7 : RITE PRICE HEATING & COOLING HANDICAP - 1100 metres

PRINCE ALBERT (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GIGABYTE (C. Jones) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DUCKWORTH (J. Cartwright) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

SEGREGATION (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly.

BOLDACIOUS GIRL (Z. Spain) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr. J. Hickmott advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

RACE 8 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING CHRISTMAS HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately three minutes.

ESSAY RAIDER (C. Lindop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WHITLAM (S. Cahill) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer Ms. D. Wilson was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

KARACATIS (C. Jones) – stepped a section of the track approaching the 1100m for no apparent reason.

LORD ASPEN (M. Neilson) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VATICAN (Z. Spain) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SILENT WHISPER (C. Parnham) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

RACE 9 : JOY STAR OF CHRISTMAS SERIES FINAL - 1400 metres (Run on Morphettville Parks Track)

CAPODECINA (C. Jones) – shifted out on jumping away, contacting PEPPER THE PIN.

MARCO POLO (D. Caboche) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

USTINOV'S FURY (C. Parnham) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

PEPPER THE PIN (Z. Spain) – contacted on jumping away.

LIVING LARGE (NZ) (J. Holder) – sprung its near hind shoe on exiting the mounting yard. A pre-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg and unfit to race. **LIVING LARGE (NZ)** was withdrawn by Stewards at 5.40 pm.
