**Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse**  
**by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 9 January 2016**

**WEATHER:** Fine

**RAIL:** Out 5 metres 1200m to 400m, 3 metres remainder.

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**RACE 1 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING HANDICAP - 2500 metres**

**CELTIC PRINCE (NZ)** (J. Cartwright) – shifted out approaching the 1600m to improve its position taking ANURADHA wider on the track.

**TUNES** (C. Lindop) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed poor respiratory recovery and heat stress.

**SCELTO (NZ)** (D. Tourneur) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**LONGAVA (NZ)** (T. Pannell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. T. Pannell pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was reprimanded.

**ANURADHA** (Z. Spain) – taken wider on the track approaching the 1600m.

**RACE 2 : EXELSUPER MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres**

**MAIL IT IN** (C. Lindop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**PHIDIAS** (J. Holder) – J. Holder pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was reprimanded.

**RACE 3 : SEATON HOTEL HANDICAP - 1050 metres**

**CASINO WIZARD** (C. Lindop) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted CALIANCO, which jumped away awkwardly.

**DEBEERSONUS** (J. Cartwright) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**CALIANCO** (J. Toeroek) – jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported he had intended to settle more forward but owing to the manner in which the mare began, he was unable to do so.

**NORDIC ECLIPSE** (J. Kah) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### **RACE 4 : UBET ADELAIDE CUP 14 MARCH HANDICAP - 1050 metres**

**BURST AWAY** (J. Cartwright) – Fractious in barriers after being loaded. A pre-race veterinary examination ruled the gelding unfit to race. Acting on that advice, Stewards withdrew BURST AWAY at 2.46 pm. Trainer, Mr. J. O'Connor, was advised the gelding now required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

**SIR CHARLESTON (NZ)** (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**BAG D'AIR** (J. Holder) – Trainer Mr. T. McEvoy advised Stewards he would instruct J. Holder to settle further back in this event. Raced keenly in the early stages. Laid in, in the straight, and when being corrected in the vicinity of the 200m, shifted out onto WINGARD'S MARK, which was inconvenienced. Thereafter BAG D'AIR raced erratically placing J. Holder at a disadvantage as he had difficulty steering his mount over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer Mr. T. McEvoy advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

**ASK ME HOW I KNOW** (E. Finnegan) – lost its near fore plate during the race. Rider explained it was her intention to lead but owing to the filly beginning poorly, she was obliged to settle back with cover.

**WINGARD'S MARK** (D. Tourneur) – inconvenienced in vicinity of the 200m. Rider reported his mount laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### **RACE 5 : NESPRESSO HANDICAP - 2018 metres**

**EIGELSTEIN (GB)** (K. Brooks) – raced wide without cover in the middle stages of the race. In the vicinity of the 400m contacted by COUNTDOWN. Lost near fore plate during the race.

**NOT A ZERPRISE** (C. Jones) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr. M. Huxtable, advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

**HASTA LA THOMAS** (D. Yendall) – in the vicinity of the 400m became awkward on the heels of COUNTDOWN for a number of strides.

**ZERPRISE JOURNEY** (J. Cartwright) – a pre-race veterinary examination ruled the mare fit to race.

**COUNTDOWN** (D. Thornton) – jumped away awkwardly and slow to begin. Raced wide without cover in the early stages. In the vicinity of the 400m shifted in and away from MARYORE, as that mare improved to its outside, and contacted EIGELSTEIN (GB). Laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**MARYORE** (D. Tourneur) – jumped away awkwardly.

Following this race J. Cartwright was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

#### **RACE 6 : HUGHES CHAUFFEURED LIMOUSINES HANDICAP - 1600 metres**

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes owing to VOODOO BLACK MAGIC proving difficult to load.

**BABY BOY** (J. Cartwright) – a pre-race veterinary examination of the gelding, which had not raced since December 2014, ruled it fit to race. Rider reported the gelding felt uncomfortable in its action during the event and when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 600m, failed to respond to his riding and for that reason he elected not to ride it out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**VOODOO BLACK MAGIC** (Z. Spain) – Difficult to load. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the off side of the chest. First Aid was administered.

## **RACE 7 : MOET & CHANDON HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

The start of this race delayed approximately ten minutes owing to GALAXY GAZER breaking through the front of its barrier stall.

**SEGREGATION** (J. Maund) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m.

**KEEP NOT A DAY** (D. Yendall) – in the vicinity of the 900m shifted in, across the running of LIVING LARGE (NZ), which had to be steadied. D. Yendall issued with a severe reprimand. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor respiratory recovery and abdominal discomfort. First Aid administered.

**BOYS GETAROUND HIM** (E. Finnegan) – Trainer, Mr. S. Theodore, advised Stewards he would instruct E. Finnegan to attempt to settle back of mid-field with cover in today's race.

**SPIRITOF ENDEAVOUR (USA)** (T. Pannell) – held up for clear running from approaching the 400m until near the 200m.

**UNSPUN** (D. Tourneur) – performed poorly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**GALAXY GAZER** (C. Lindop) – broke through the front of its barrier stall and galloped riderless for a considerable distance before being captured. GALAXY GAZER was withdrawn by Stewards at 4.42 pm. C. Lindop was examined by the First Care Medical personnel who ruled her uninjured in the incident. Co-Trainers, Messrs. L. Macdonald and A. Gluyas, were advised the gelding would now be required to perform to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

Following this race, D. Yendall was examined by the First Care Medical personnel who ruled him unfit to fulfil his engagement in Race 8.

## **RACE 8 : NATASHA & RYAN'S WEDDING HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

Owing to the delay in the previous race, the start of this race was rescheduled to commence at 5.27 pm. When no other suitable Jockey was available, Stewards permitted D. Caboche to replace D. Yendall as the rider of YEN. D. Caboche was unable to claim any allowance.

**LUCKY FLIPPER** (E. Finnegan) – rider reported her mount hung out rounding the home turn. a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**MODESTY** (D. Thornton) – held up for clear running from inside the 400m until in the vicinity of the 300m.

**MOLLY THE SNIP** (D. Tourneur) – rider reported his mount felt sore during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had jarred up and was showing symptoms of general soreness in its fore and hindquarters. Trainer, Mr. K. Matson, advised Stewards the mare will now be spelled.

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**GENERAL (EXHIBITION GALLOP):**

HUCKLEBUCK and SHADOW OF THE MIST galloped on the track between Races 2 and 3.

Race 5 – NOT A ZERPRISE - Not to race – Vet Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race – Lameness off hind leg. Race 7 – GALAXY GAZER – Suspended – Required to perform to Stewards' satisfaction in Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race – Broke through front of barriers and galloped riderless for a considerable distance.
