ADDITIONAL STEWARDS' REPORT – MS E FINNEGAN & MS G WILLOUGHBY

MORPHETTVILLE – MONDAY, 11 JANUARY 2016

Thoroughbred Racing SA Stewards concluded an inquiry into an alleged incident involving Apprentice Jockeys Emily Finnegan and Grace Willoughby, which occurred at Gawler Racecourse on Wednesday, 6 January 2016.

Evidence was taken from both Apprentices, along with two other female riders.

Emily Finnegan was found guilty of a charge under AR83(a) in that following the running of Race 5 at Gawler Racecourse on Wednesday, 6 January 2016 in the Female Jockeys' Room she misconducted herself by directing foul language towards Apprentice Grace Willoughby and was reprimanded.

Grace Willoughby pleaded guilty to a charge under AR83(a) in that following the running of Race 5 at Gawler Racecourse on Wednesday, 6 January 2016 in the Female Jockeys' Room she misconducted herself by directing foul language towards Apprentice Emily Finnegan and was reprimanded.

Grace Willoughby also pleaded guilty to a charge of improper conduct under AR175(q) in that she conducted herself in an improper manner following the running of Race 5 at Gawler Racecourse on Wednesday, 6 January 2016 in the Female Jockeys' Room by making physical contact with Apprentice Emily Finnegan. Grace Willoughby was fined \$1000, of which \$750 was suspended for a period of twelve months on condition she does not breach any conduct related Rules during that period.

Both riders were advised of their rights of appeal.
