STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Streaky Bay Racecourse
by Streaky Bay Racing Club on Saturday, 2 April 2016

RACE 1 : LINCOLN ESTATE WINES SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 metres

OUTLAW (T. Zanker) – fractious in the barriers causing its barrier stall to open prematurely and was immediately restrained by its rider. A pre-race veterinary examination ruled the gelding fit to race.

READY AGAIN (D. Tootell) – on arrival on course, as the gelding had not raced for fourteen months, it was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon and ruled fit to race. A pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers confirmed the gelding fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WARRASIDE EDDY (A. Doyle) – became awkward in its action for a short distance rounding the home turn. Rider reported the gelding had dropped the bit for a short distance. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PIERREMONT MAGIC (B. Griffiths) – slow into stride.

LIVERPOOL STRIKER (Jemma Frew) – hung out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TEGULA SUNRISE (K. Brooks) – Trainer Mr. B. Cozamanis was fined \$50 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the filly. The horse was identified from records held by Stewards and permitted to start.

RACE 2 : LETCHER & MORONEY CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP – 1000 metres

WESTERN BOY (A. Doyle) – hung out and became awkward in its action for a short distance rounding the home turn. Rider stated the gelding did not appreciate racing on the dirt surface.

RACE 3 : STREAKY BAY'S VALUED SPONSOR'S BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP – 1200 metres

COSMIC KHELEYF (C. Davies) – slow into stride.

PARTING SHOT (A. Doyle) – slow into stride.

LEWIS STREET (Jemma Frew) – rider reported the gelding did not appreciate racing on the dirt surface. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : STREAKY BAY HOTEL MOTEL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

BARELY A BEAT (T. O'Donnell) – laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

RACE 5 : XXXX GOLD STREAKY BAY COMMUNITY HOTEL CUP - 1800 metres

MOON DEVIL (B. Griffiths) – jumped away awkwardly.

PROPSHAFT (K. Brooks) – rider reported she was unable to restrain her mount in the early stages and approaching the 1200m elected to allow the gelding to stride forward. She stated, in her opinion, the gelding had capitulated prior to entering the straight and was of the opinion that it had bled. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer Mr. B. Lear was advised PROPSHAFT was now suspended for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A.

JAPAN (T. O'Donnell) – making the turn out of the straight on the first occasion, became awkwardly placed on the heels of DESTONY HAWK.

SHADE OF GREEN (D. Tootell) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

54 HANDICAP - 1800 metres**

HERO TO VILLIAN (K. Brooks) – hampered on jumping away by NANNA KNOWS BEST, which shifted out.

FLYTIR (D. Tootell) – jumped away awkwardly.
